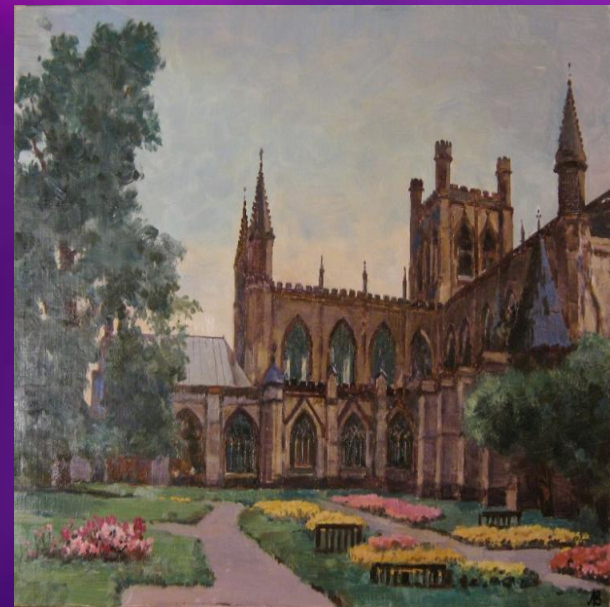

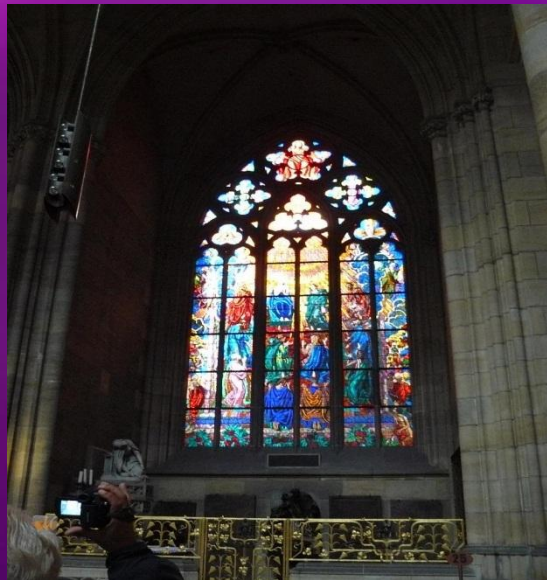
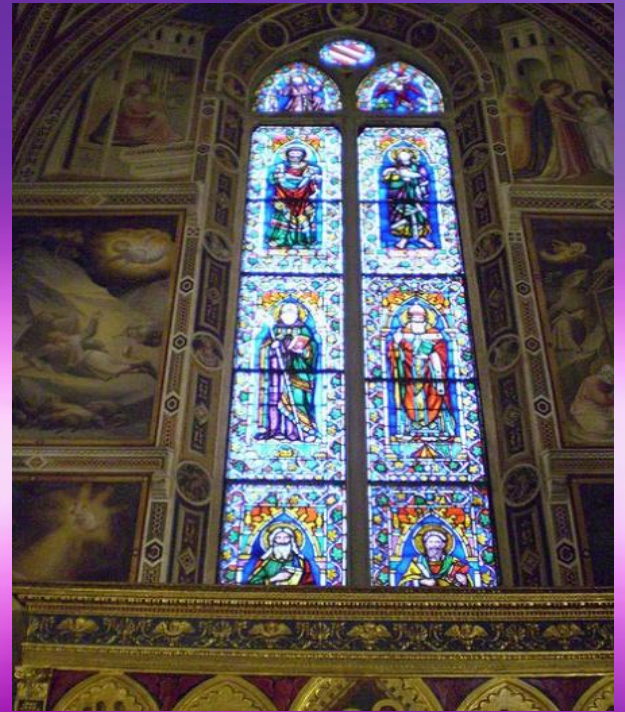
The Gothic Art is a style which was developed in Western Europe from Middle Ages



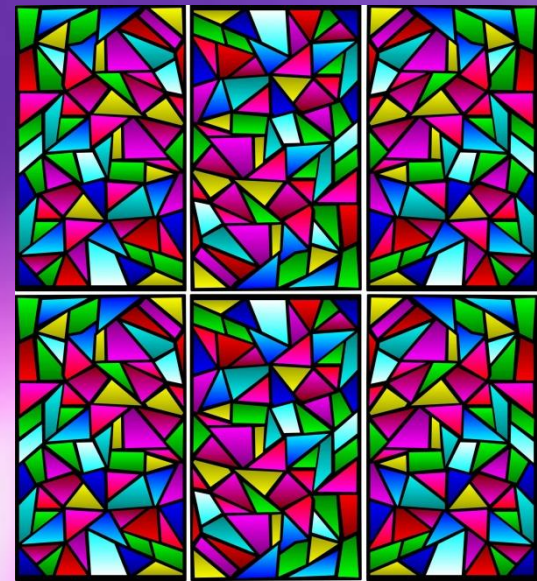
The term

Giorgio Vasari.



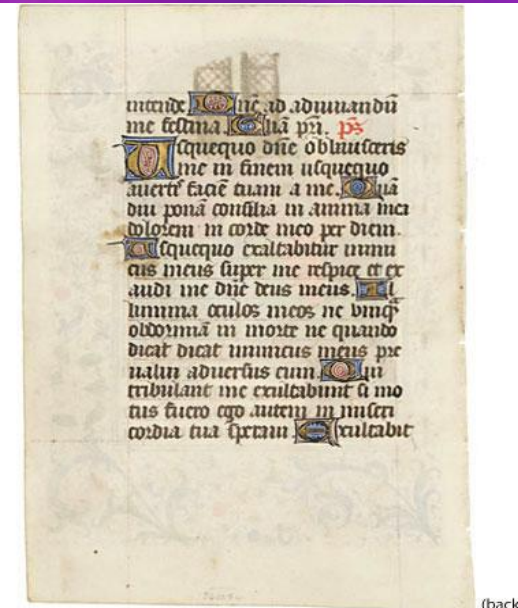
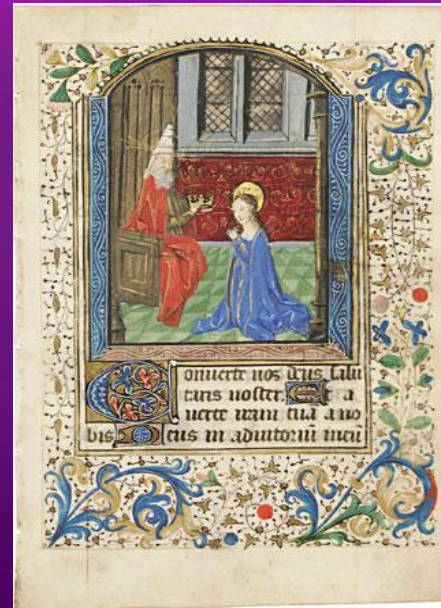
Fresco: Mural painting, a continuation of the previous Roman and Christian traditions
