Present Perfect-настоящее совершенное.

- **HAVE+V₃**
- **HAS +V₃**
- **He / She/It=HAS**
- **I/WE/YOU/THEY=HAVE**
- **Adverbs : already-уже, just-только что, never-никогда, ever-когда-либо, yet-(?)-уже/(-)-еще не.**
