Administrative division of the UK:

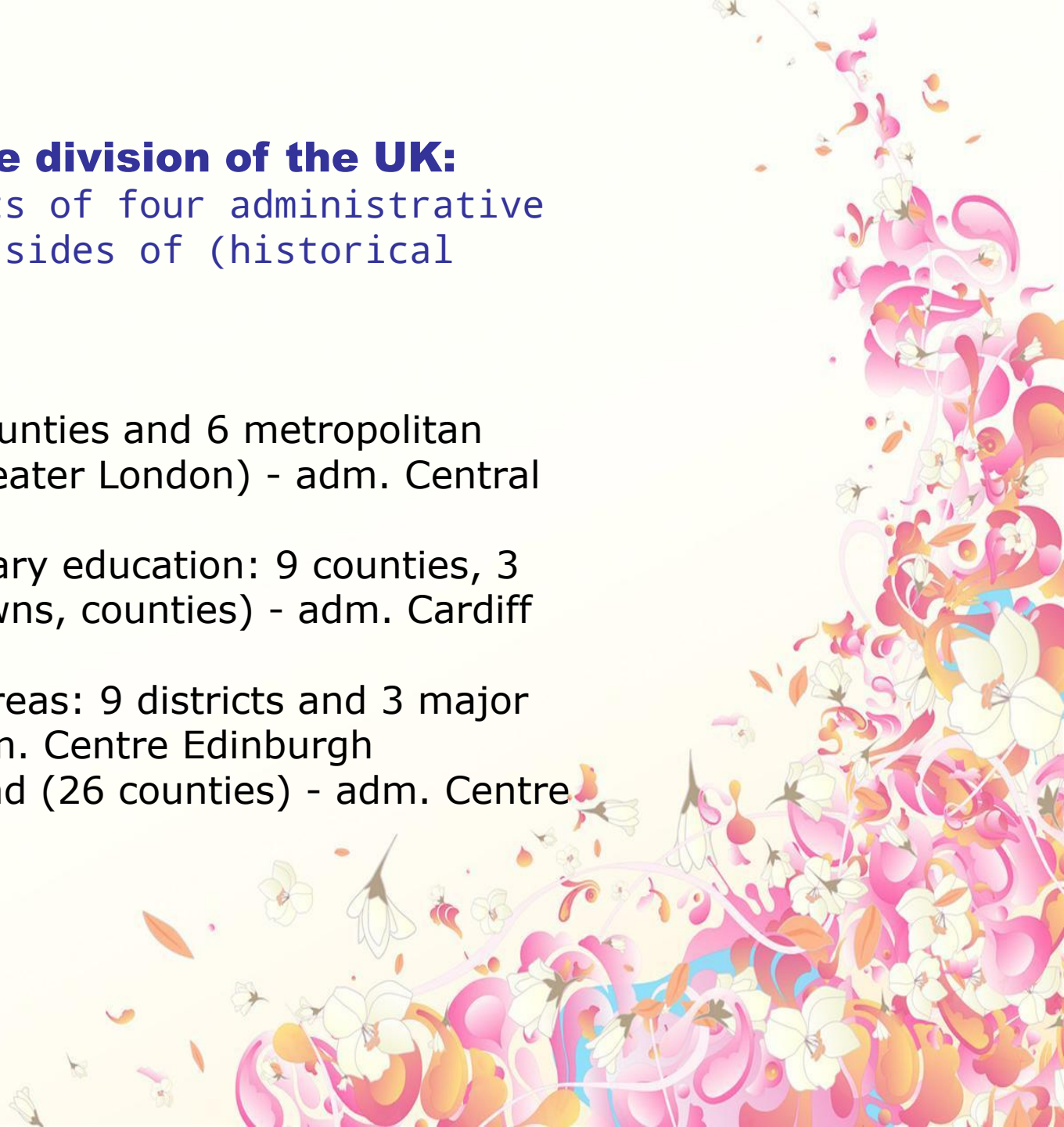
The UK consists of four administrative and political sides of (historical province):


_England (39 counties and 6 metropolitan counties and Greater London) - adm. Central London

_Wales (22 unitary education: 9 counties, 3 cities and 10 towns, counties) - adm. Cardiff Centre

_Scotland (12 areas: 9 districts and 3 major territories) - adm. Centre Edinburgh

_Northern Ireland (26 counties) - adm. Centre Belfast

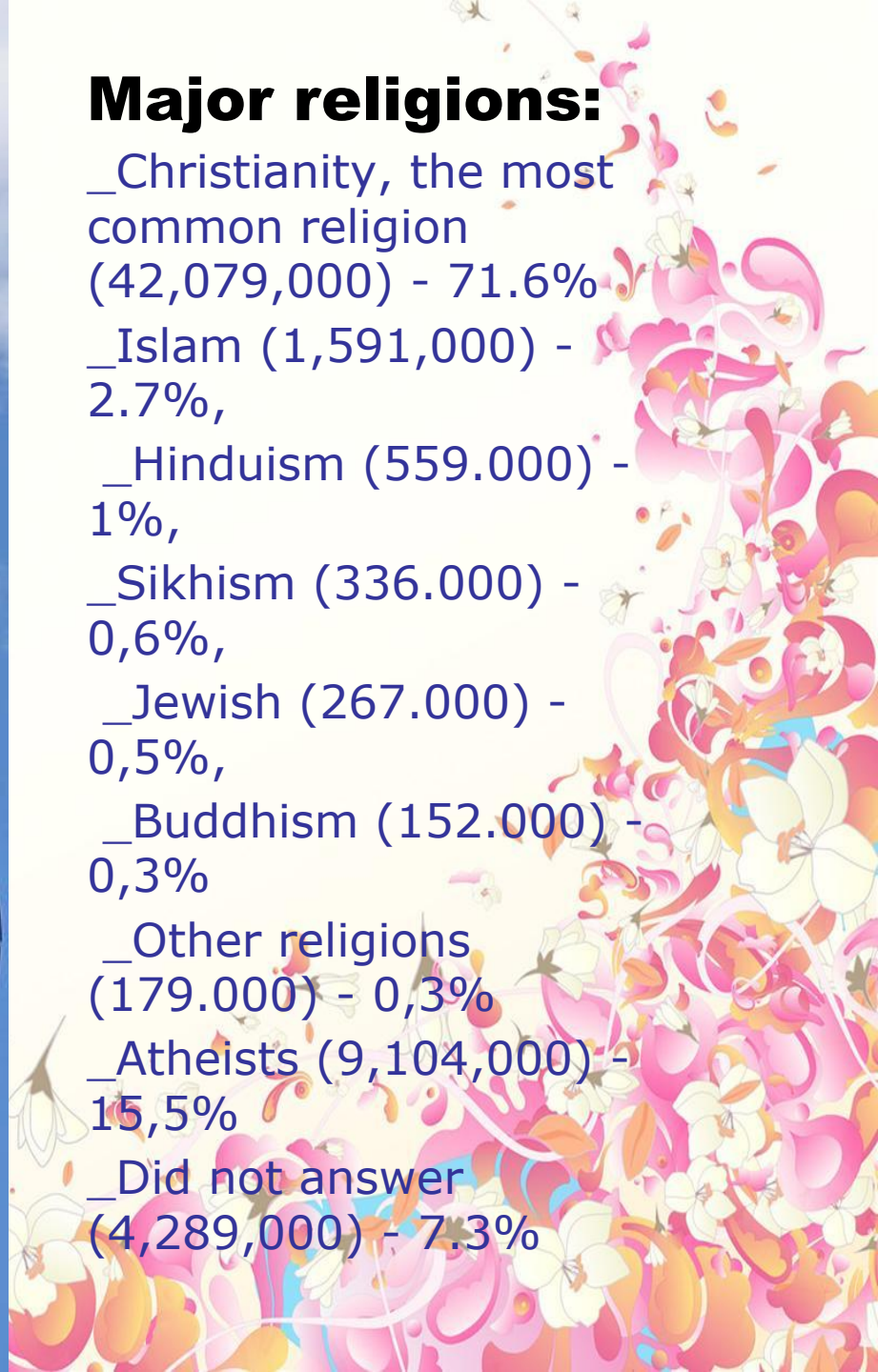
