Groot (Groot) is a comic book character by Marvel Comics. Was invented by Stan Lee, Jack Kirby, Dick Ayres, and first appeared in the series "Tales to Astonish" #13, November 1960. He is an extraterrestrial, tree-like humanoid with a high level of intelligence. Originally presented as the aggressor who seeks to capture people for experiments.

He was later shown as a hero, and appeared in the comics series "Annihilation: Conquest" in 2006. In 2008 he joined the team the Guardians of the Galaxy.



The history of the publication.

first appeared in the series "Tales to Astonish" #13, November 1960. 16 years later appeared in the comic "the Incredible Hulk" #5 (November 1976), one of the monsters from the series "Tales to Astonish". 21 years later came the terrible dream Peter Parker in the comic of "The Sensational Spider-Man" (July 1997).

In 2006, appears in a series of six editions of the "Roaring the team nick fury" and "Annihilation: Conquest" and limited series "Annihilation: Conquest — star-Lord". Later joins the team of Guardians of the Galaxy, followed by a series of comic books. Also appeared in the comic "the Thanos Imperative" and, together with rocket Raccoon in "the Destroyers".

Together with other members of the team Guardians of the Galaxy appeared in the comic book series "the Avengers collection", created for fans of the film "the Avengers". Appeared in the series "Guardians of the Galaxy: Volume 3" as part of the restart of Marvel NOW!.

Fictional biography



Groot is an extraterrestrial monster who initially came to Earth and sought to capture humans for experimentation. But was destroyed by termites, which is used Leslie Evans. Hemo made a duplicate of Groot to fight the Hulk, but the Hulk destroyed the duplicate.

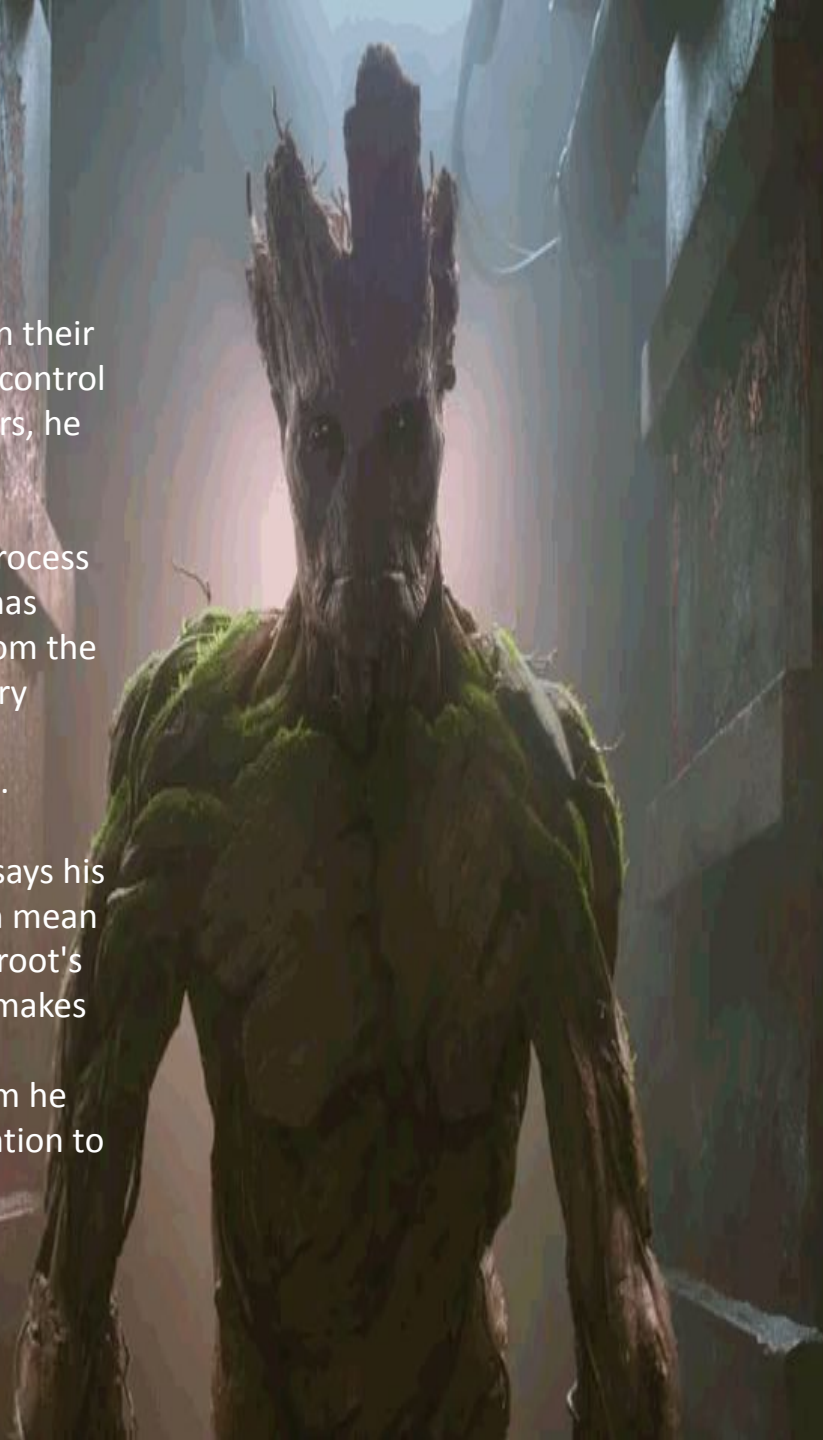
