The Queen is the head of the Church of England.

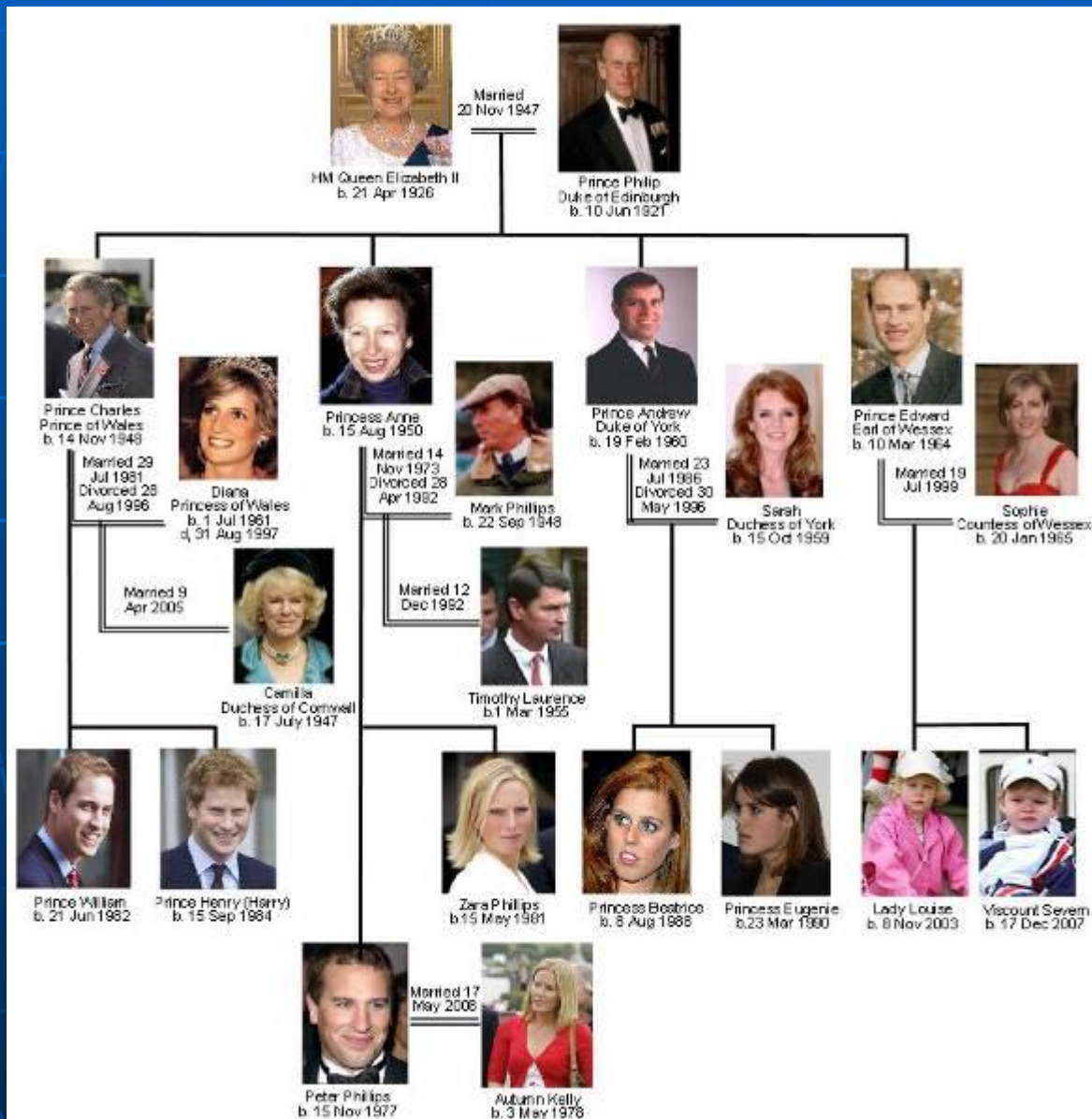
The Queen is Commander-in-Chief of the armed forces.
