

A block of flats is a large building with a lot of flats in it



 Almost in every English house there is a fireplace, it is usually in the sitting room. They think that electricity is cleaner but a coal fire is more homely.



Around a house there is a front garden & back garden.
 The front garden is a smooth grass lawn, you can see also there a few flower beds.





 Back garden is more useful, but less pretty than front one. Vegetables, potatoes, cabbage, cauliflowers, peas & lettuce are grown there.



 This house is a dream for common Russian, but it is a bit simpler in Russia. The majority of Russian population lives in blocks of flats.



There are several flats on one floor. Usual Russian flat consists of entrance hall, two or three rooms, kitchen, toilet & bathroom which are not very large. In front of a house there is a children's playground.
