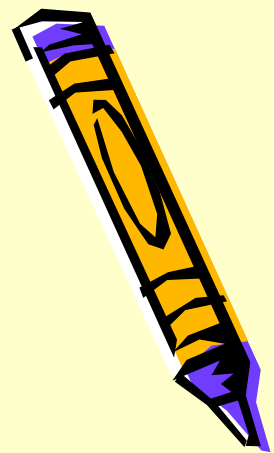


How Spot learns to bark

Cock. Say "Cock-a-doodle-doo".

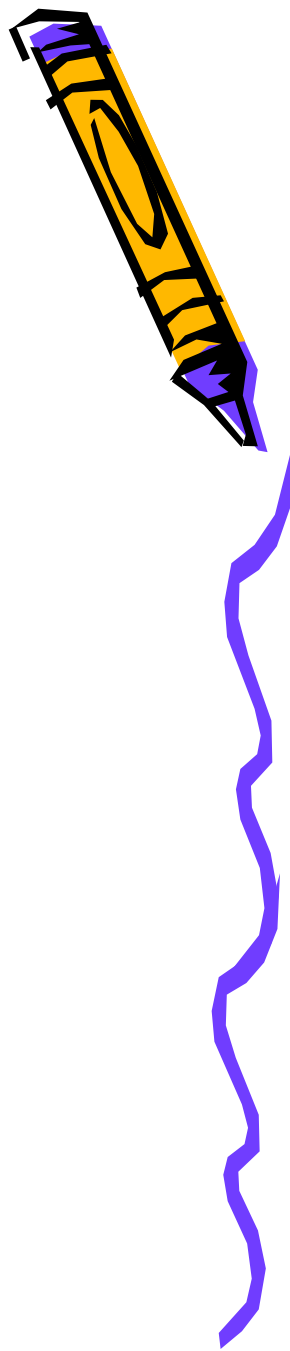
Spot. Oh, no. That is what the Cock says. Little dogs bark!

Cat. Mew-mew.

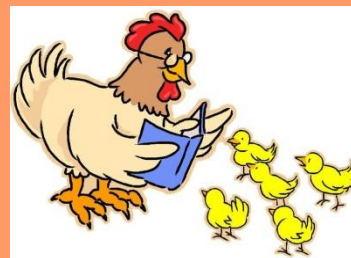
