How to be polite

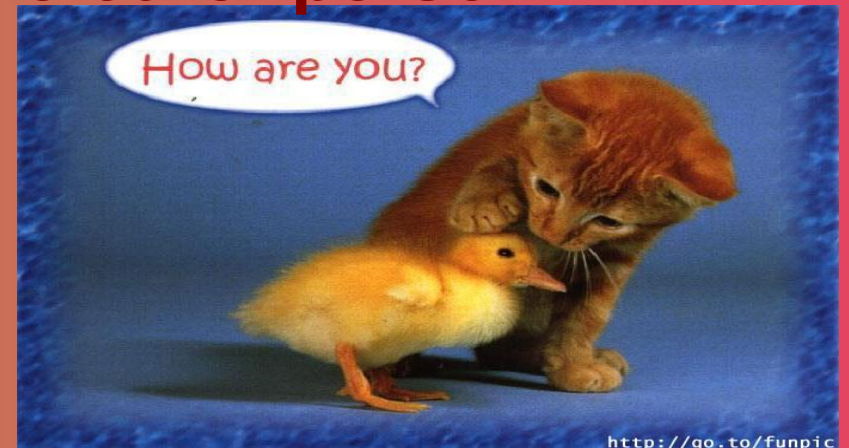


- 1. Be gentle,

Formal saying hello

- Let me introduce myself.
- Good morning/afternoon.
- Pleased to meet you.
- How do you do.



Informal saying hello

- My name is/ I'm...
- Nice to meet you.
- How are you?
- Hello!



Formal saying good-bye

- I'd like to say good-bye.
- I look forward to seeing you again.
- Please let me know how you are.
- I promise.



Informal saying good-bye

- Call me.
- See you.
- Have a good day.
