

Teddy bear



- The teddy bear is a soft toy in the form of a bear.
- Developed simultaneously by toymakers Morris Michtom in the US and Richard Steiff in Germany in the early years of the 20th century.
- The toy was named after
 President Theodore Roosevelt.
- Sewn teddy bears are made from a wide range of materials including felt, cotton and velour. many are stitched, others were made from yarn, either knitted or crocheted.





Barbie is a fashion doll manufactured by the American toy-company Mattel, Inc. and launched in March 1959. American businesswoman Ruth Handler is credited with the creation of the doll using a German doll called Bild Lilli as her inspiration.

- A roly-poly toy, round-bottomed doll, tilting doll, tumbler or wobbly man is a toy that rights itself when pushed over.
- Many roly-poly toys are hollow, with a weight inside the bottom.









- The precompressed helical spring invented by Richard James in the early 1940s
- It can perform a number of tricks, including travelling down a flight of steps end-over-end.
- it is also known as the Slinky Dog and Suzie, the Slinky Worm.
- Many of them are made with the colors of the rainbow in rainbow order. Plastic Slinkys are more flexible.
