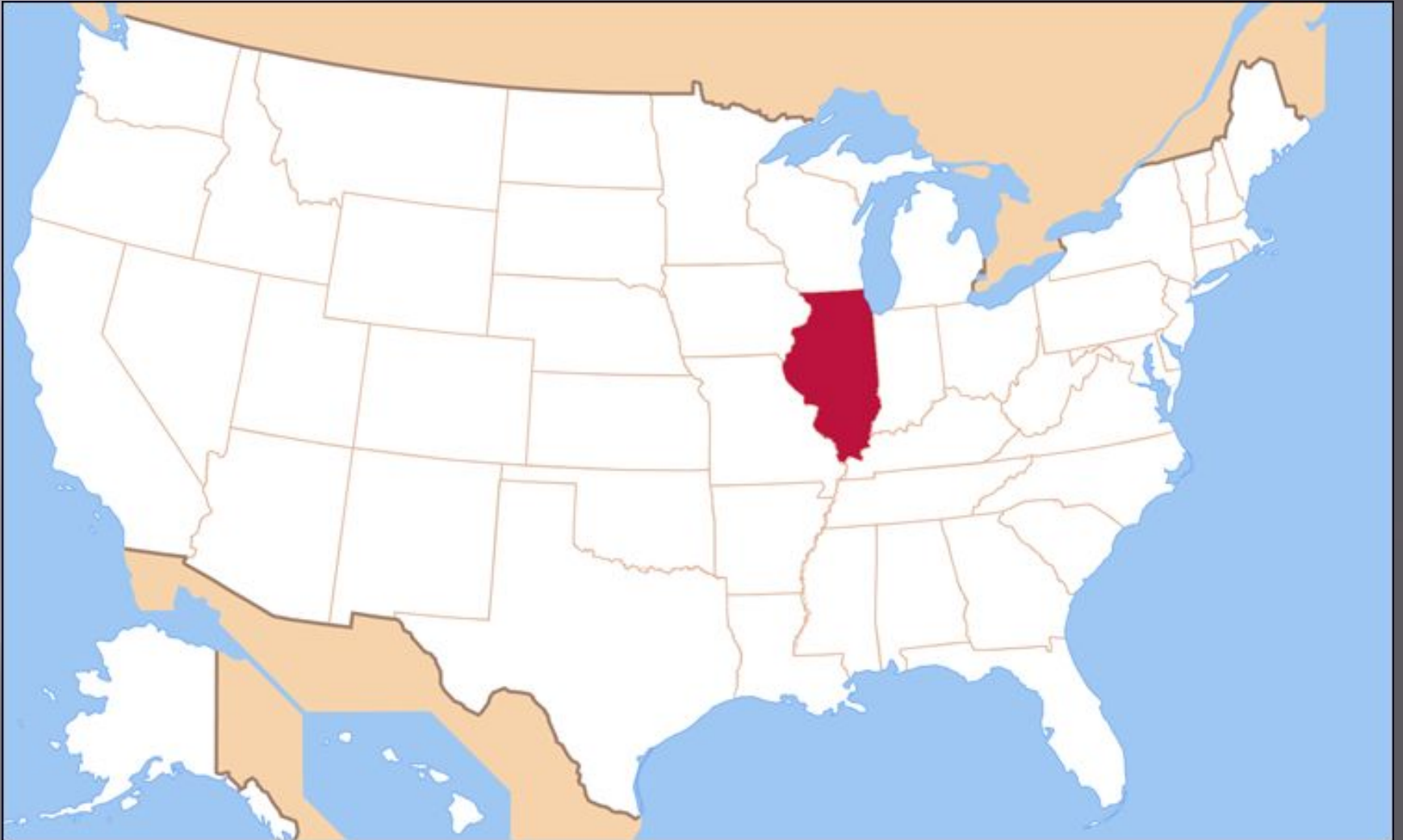

Illinois is typical for a humid continental climate with hot summers and cold winters.

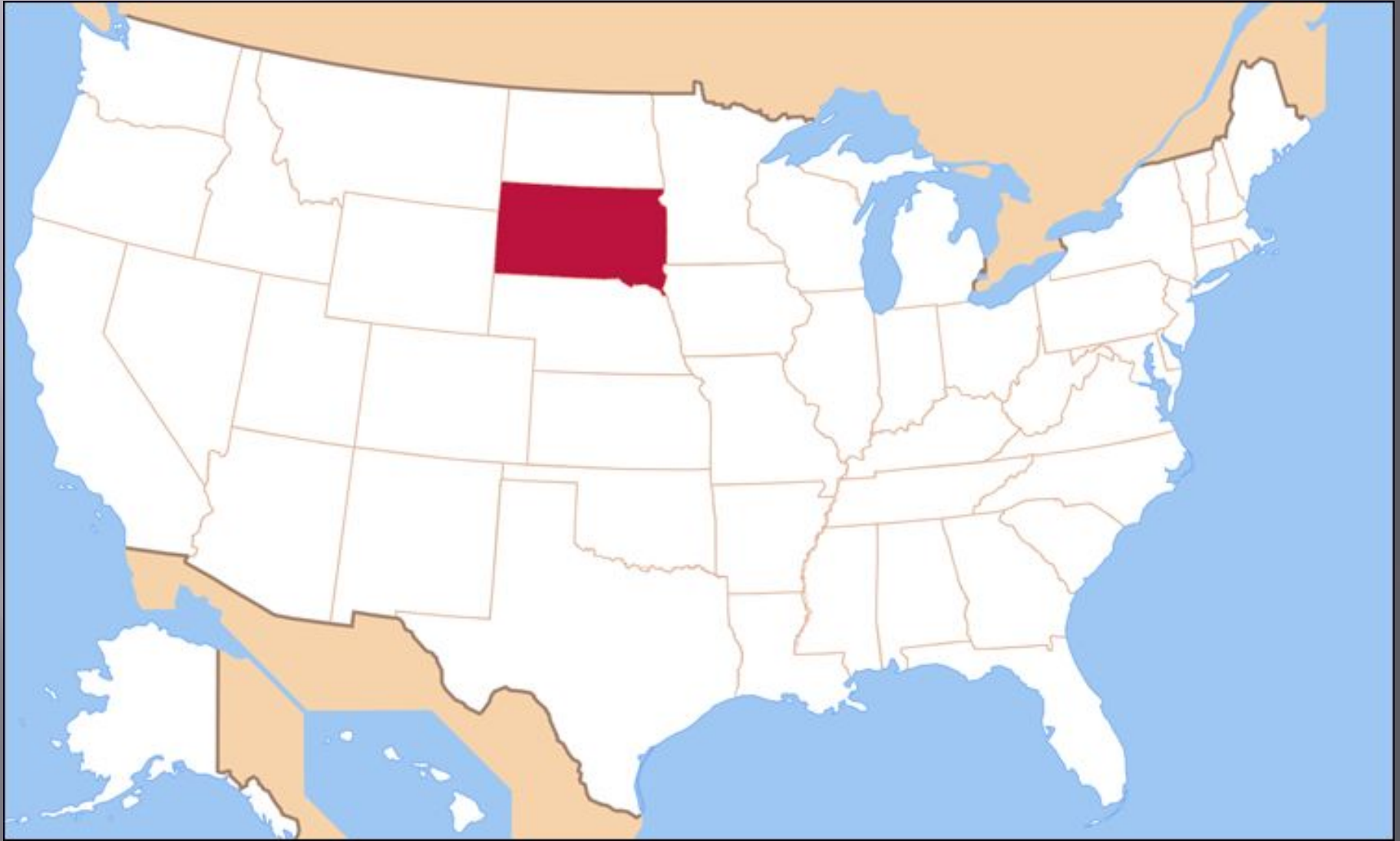
St. Patrick's Day in Chicago

South Dakota



The capital of South Dakota - Pierre

The largest city - Sioux Falls

Date of formation - November 2, 1889

The population— about 840 000 people

The motto - Under God the people rule

Nickname - "Mount Rushmore State"



Long before the advent of Europeans in America, in what is now South Dakota lived the indigenous inhabitants of the continent - the Indians.

And today, the population of South Dakota is relatively a lot of indigenous peoples. In the state there are several large Indian reservations, it is the third largest in the United States by number of Indians

For South Dakota is characterized by a continental climate with long cold winters, hot summers and short, but pronounced in spring and autumn.

The eastern part of South Dakota is located on the "tornado alley", there are often up to thirty times per year



Mount Rushmore



In the south-west of the state of South Dakota, in the mountains of the Black Hills, the majestic monument - "Mount Rushmore National Memorial." Here, from the granite rock carved huge images of four Presidents of the United States: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Abraham Lincoln and Theodore Roosevelt.

Construction of the monument began October 4, 1927 and ended on 31 October 1941, in the construction take part hundred workers, manually minced granite.
