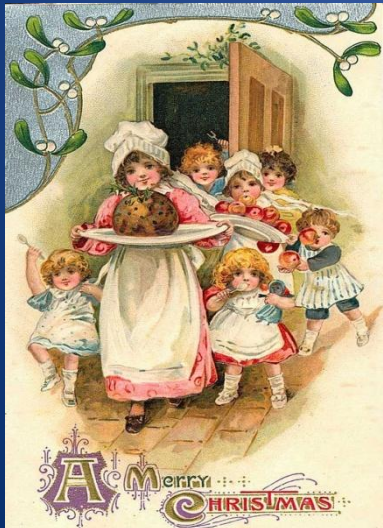

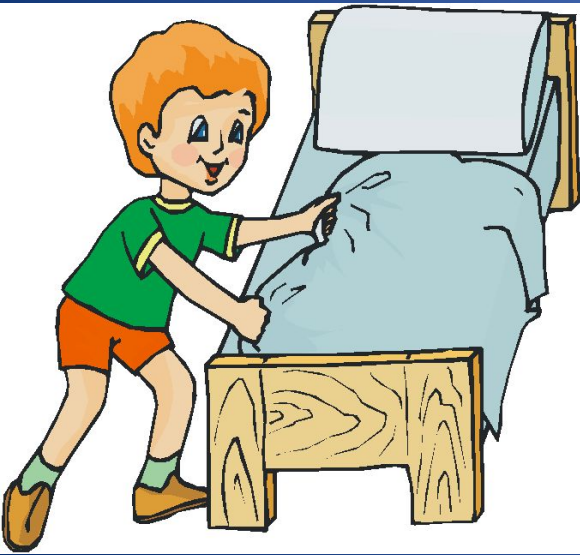


Christmas Day

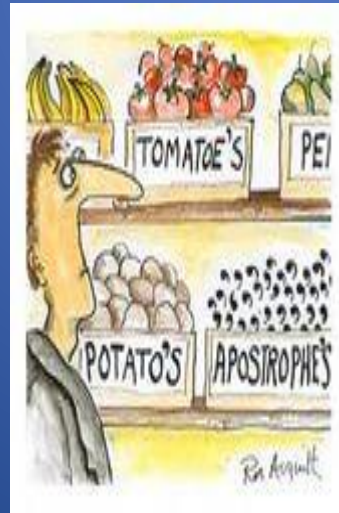
Plan:




