Extinct volcano – a volcano that is no longer active

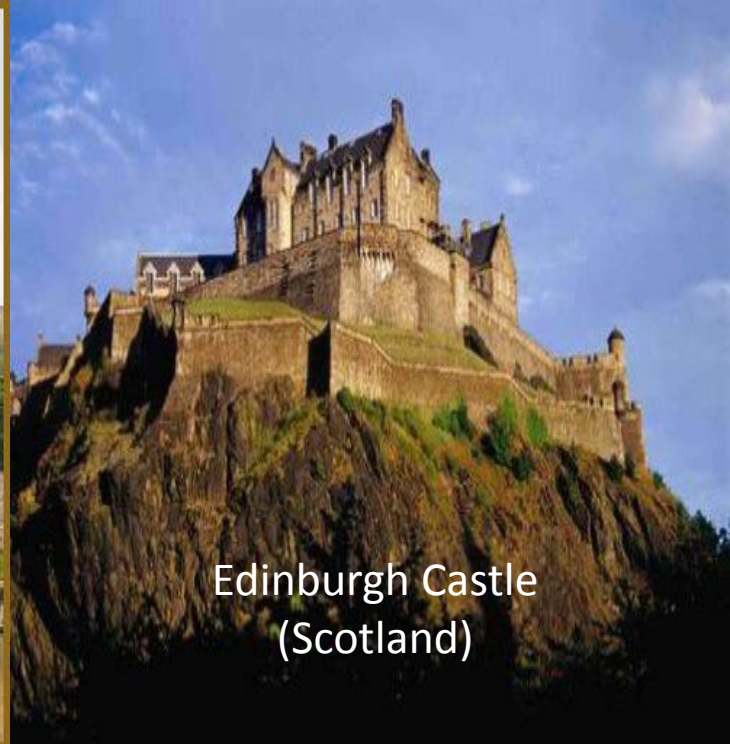
Guarded by – protected by
