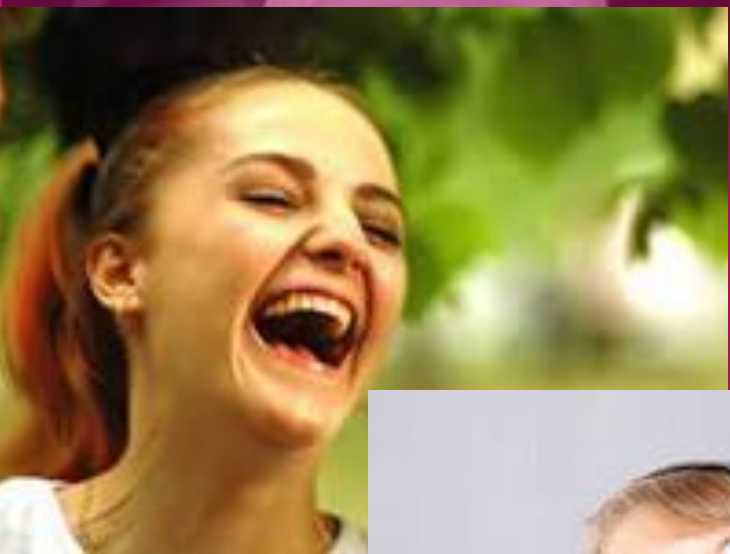
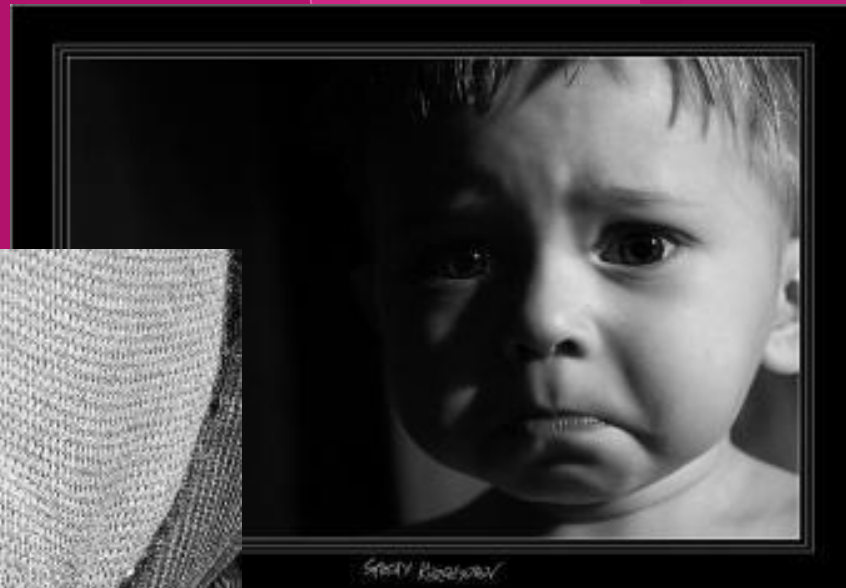

*It sounds like someone saying,*

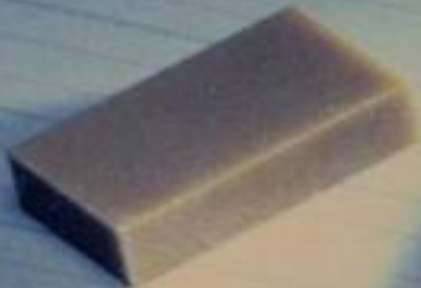
*"I've got a present for you".*
