great bell which strikes the hour. It is in the Clock Tower of the Houses of Parliament.








# Buckingham Palace is the official home of the British royal family




### The British Museum

#### The Sherlock Holmes Museum


 The house of Sherlock Holmes is on the 221b Baker Street. Now it is a museum.
