CHILDHOOD MARILYN MONRO...

❖ Norma Jeane Mortenson was born around 9:30 am on June 1, 1926 in a Los Angeles hospital , and was the third child kinomontazhnitsy RKO Pictures Gladys Pearl Baker.



MARILYN MONRO...

❖ While studying at the «Van Nuys High School», Norma Jean met James Edward Dougherty , and began an affair between them . In January 1942, the Goddard family decided to go to the East Coast to West Virginia , but for Norma Jean in this place was not moving , and therefore the 16- year-old girl was found alternative and June 19, 1942 Norma married Jim Dougherty , then dropped out of school and went to live with him



MARILYN MONRO...

❖ A year after the wedding, he was employed in the merchant navy , and Norma Jean went to work in an aircraft factory , which produces UAV Radioplane OQ- 2 . At the end of 1944, when Norma Jean worked in the factory, there appeared Army photographer David Conover, who was making propaganda images of women in munitions factories , after the shoot , he proposed to Norma Jean to pose for \$ 5 an hour, and she agreed. After a while Norma Jean leaves work at the factory to start a modeling career

MARILYN MONRO...

❖ August 2, 1945 nineteen model named Norma Jean Dougherty consulted in the agency models Blue Book, located in the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles , California, after which the team with the head of the Blue Book Modeling Agency Emmeline Snayvli and photographer Andre de Denesa , began to take popularity and fame .





MARILYN MONRO...

❖ In August 1946, she received an offer to conclude a contract for the film studio 20th Century Fox, where she took showgirl . At the studio , she was offered the names Carol Lind , Claire Norman , Marilyn Miller , but eventually settled on the name under which it subsequently became famous - Marilyn Monroe. Surname Monroe - her mother's maiden name

MONROES DEATH...

❖ August 4, 1962 , according to the testimony of Marilyn maid - Eunice Murray , Monroe, citing fatigue , early went into the bedroom , taking the phone . Subsequently, many told me that talking to Marilyn in her last hours , but these claims have not been confirmed in any way .A few hours later , after midnight , Eunice Murray , troubled by the fact that under the door Marilyn breaks the light went out in the garden and looking into the window of the bedroom , found the lifeless body of Monroe lying on the bed.

MONROES DEATH...

❖ Alarmed, Eunice Murray called a psychiatrist, Dr. Ralph Greenson, her personal physician, Dr. Hyman Engelberg. Greenson arrived and found the body of Marilyn. A few minutes later Engelberg confirmed his death. Its cause, as shown by examination, was "acute barbiturate poisoning, oral overdose." The police report stated: "Perhaps the suicide." Marilyn Monroe was found dead, with a telephone receiver in hand, on the night of 4 to 5 August 1962, at his home in the Los Angeles district of Brentwood, at 12305 Fifth Helena Drive, Brentwood, California. Beside the bed was an empty package of sleeping pills. Fourteen other bottles of drugs and pills were on the bedside table. Monroe did not leave any suicide notes. The body was taken to the morgue for an autopsy, which was performed by pathologist Dr. Tsunetomo Noguchi, after which it was announced that Marilyn Monroe died of an overdose of sleeping pills.
