It was built in baroque style by architect Rastrelli



During its history the palace served as the residence for high guests. The White Hall is situated in the middle of the Palace and connected by archs with the entrance hall.

To the entrance hall from both sides**

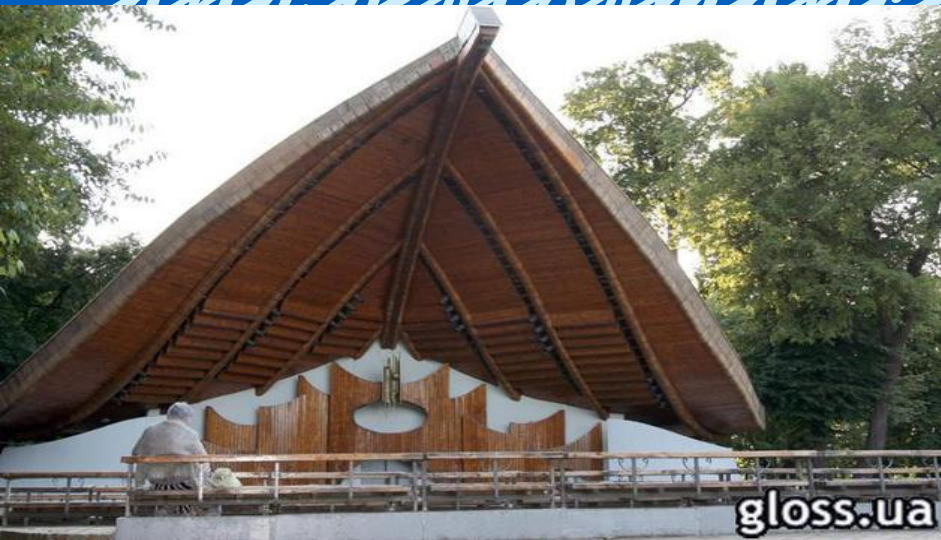
During excursion you will walk through the famous rooms and halls of the palace, including those that are usually closed for regular visitors.
