



## **Modifying Adverbs**

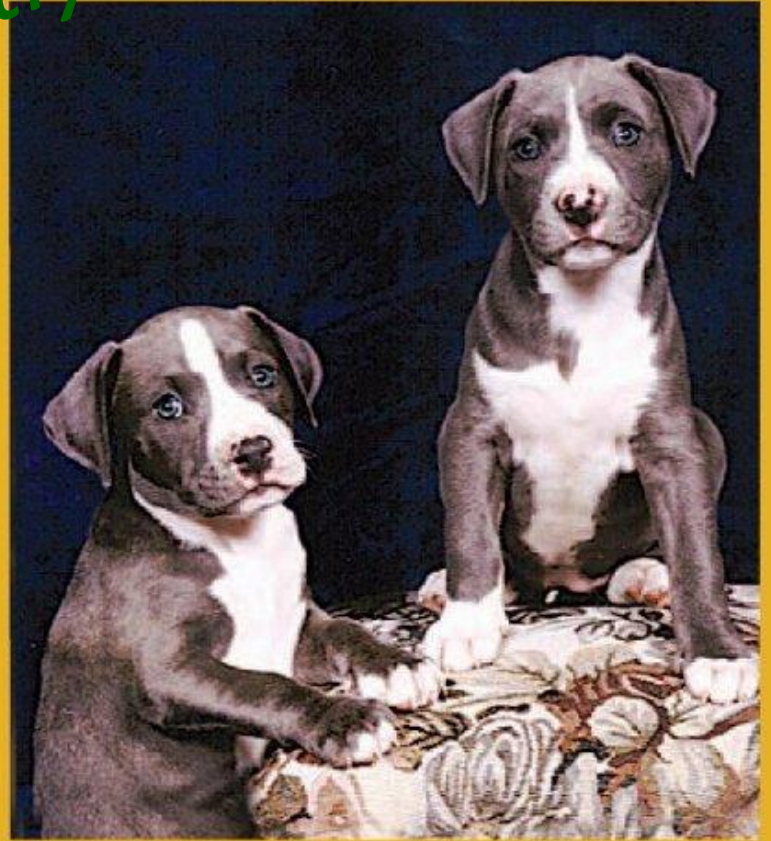
Very, pretty, quite, fairly, rather, so,

Modifying adverbs make the meaning of adjectives **stronger** or **weaker**.

*slightly different*

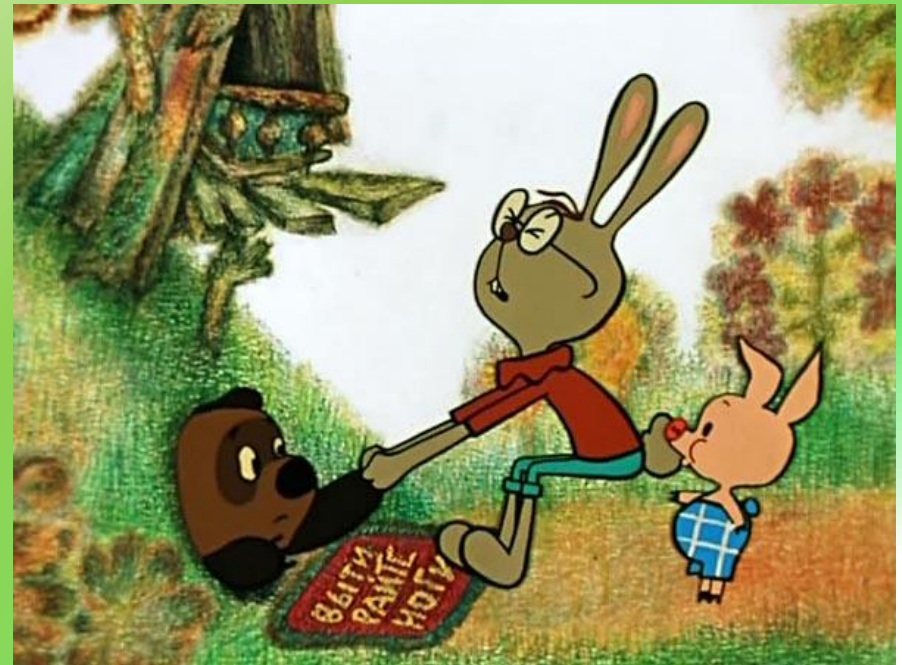


*different*

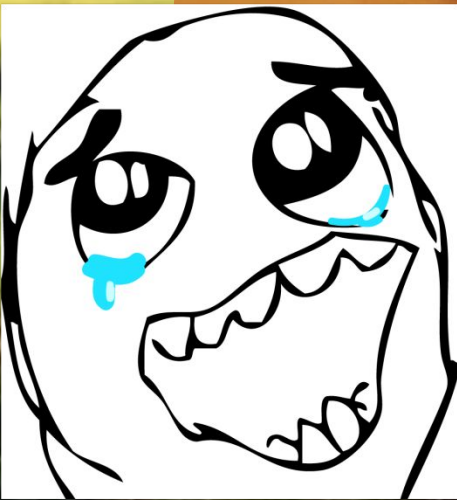
