TO HAVE TO – должен, вынужден
(в силу каких – то обстоятельств)

- + I must go there just now.**
- You mustn't (must not) talk like that!**
- ? Must you always interrupt me?**

HAVE TO

PRESENT TENSE

+ WE HAVE TO STAY AT HOME NOW.

- WE DON'T HAVE TO STAY AT HOME NOW.

HE DOESN'T HAVE TO STAY AT HOME
NOW.

? DO YOU HAVE TO GO THERE?

DOES SHE HAVE TO LOOK AFTER HER
SISTER?

HAVE TO PAST TENSE

+ WE **HAD** TO STAY AT HOME
YESTERDAY.

- HE **DIDN'T** HAVE TO WAIT FOR
US.

? **DID** YOU HAVE TO KNOW THE
TRUTH?

HAVE TO
FUTURE TENSE

+ I **SHALL HAVE TO** DO THIS WORK
JUST NOW.

- THEY **WILL NOT (WON'T) HAVE TO**
GO THERE.

WE **SHALL NOT (SHAN'T) HAVE TO**
STAY AT HOME.
