Home, sweet home...

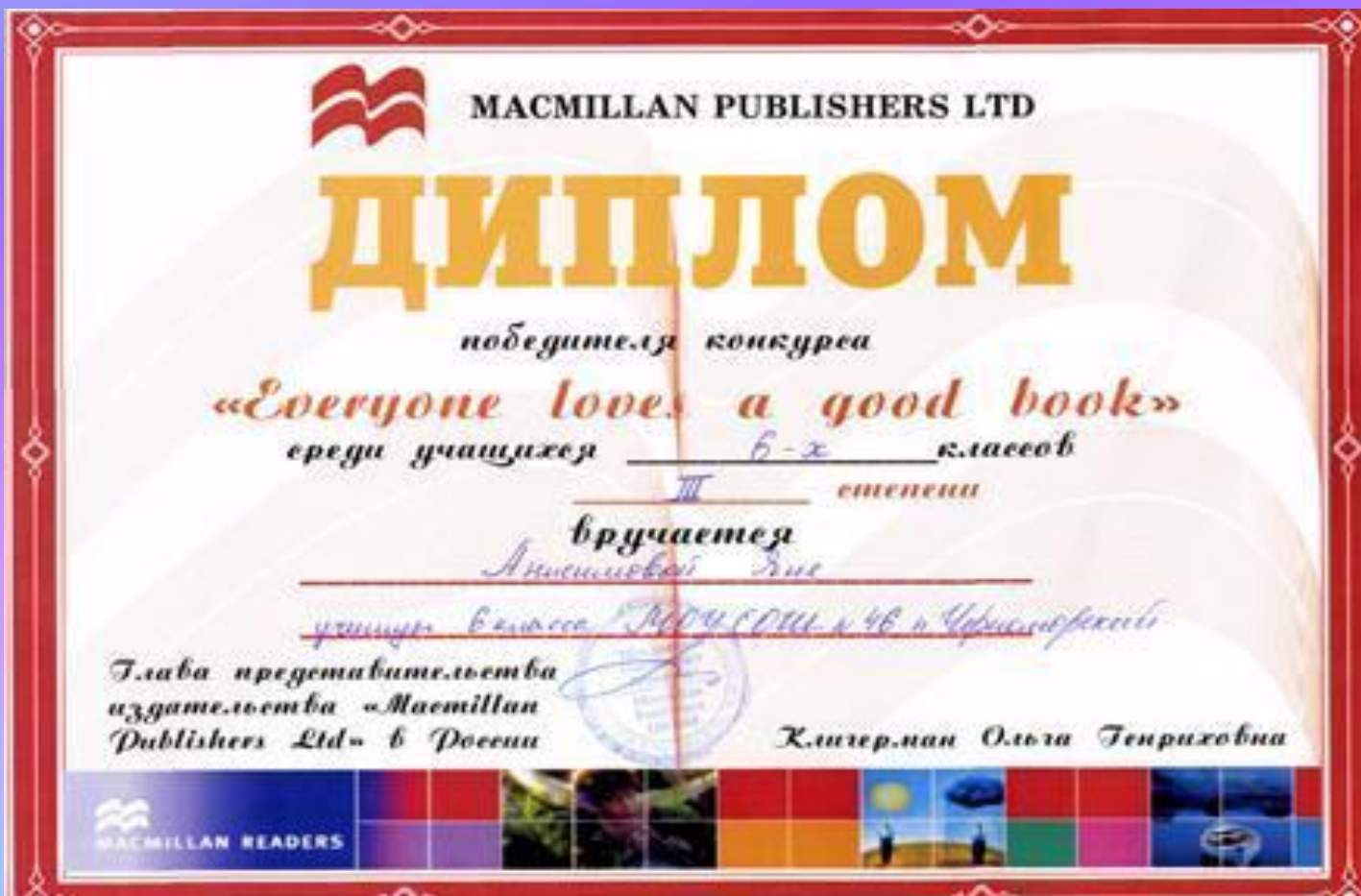
It had been warm and dry till the middle of October.

purr happily.

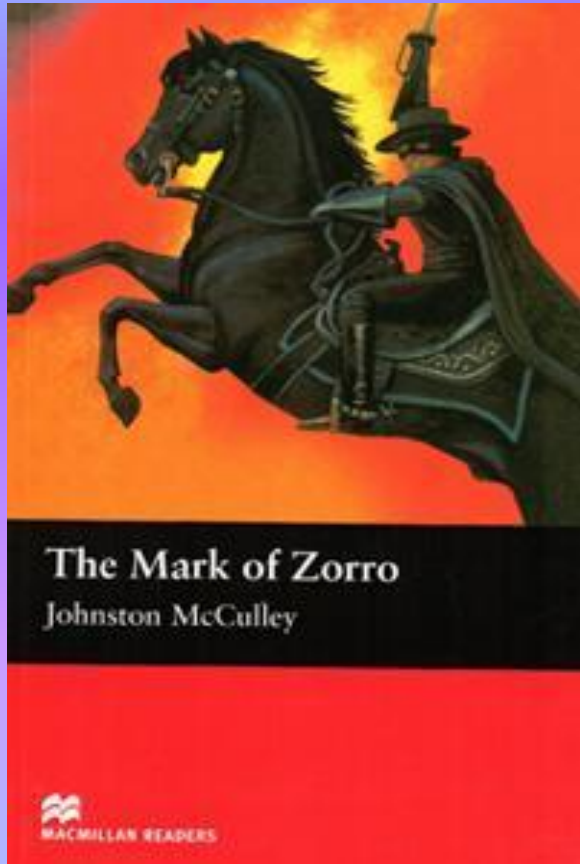
I like such tea-drinking and calm conversations at the

“The Mark of Zorro” was written by Johnston McCulley. He was born in the USA in 1883. McCulley wrote 64 stories about the masked hero, Zorro.

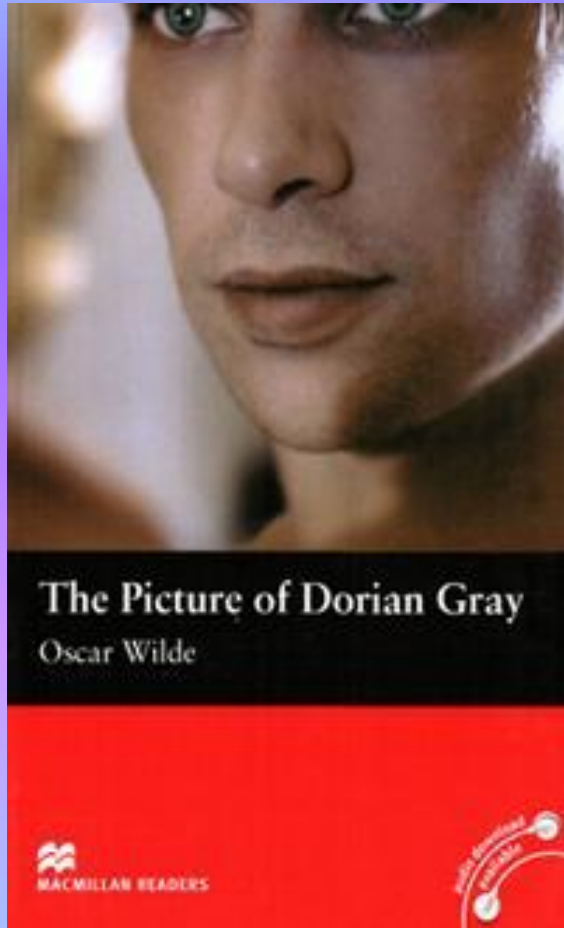
This story takes place in California in about 1822.

“THE PICTURE OF DORIAN GREY”

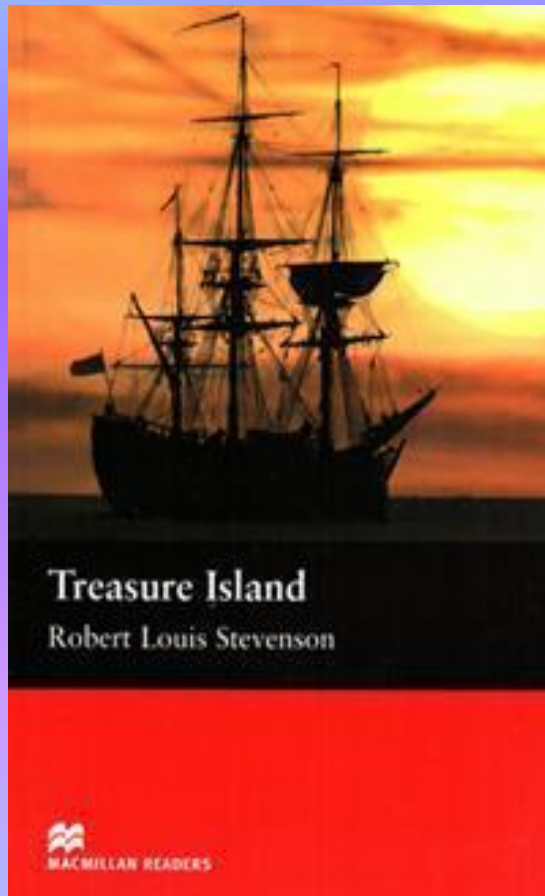


This story was written by Oscar Wilde.

“TREASURE ISLAND”

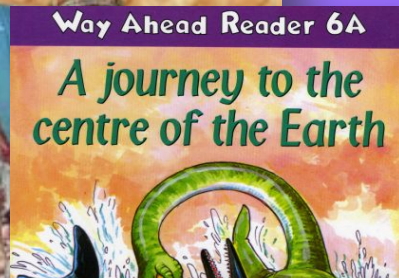


“Treasure Island” was written by Robert Louis Stevenson. It is one of his most famous stories.

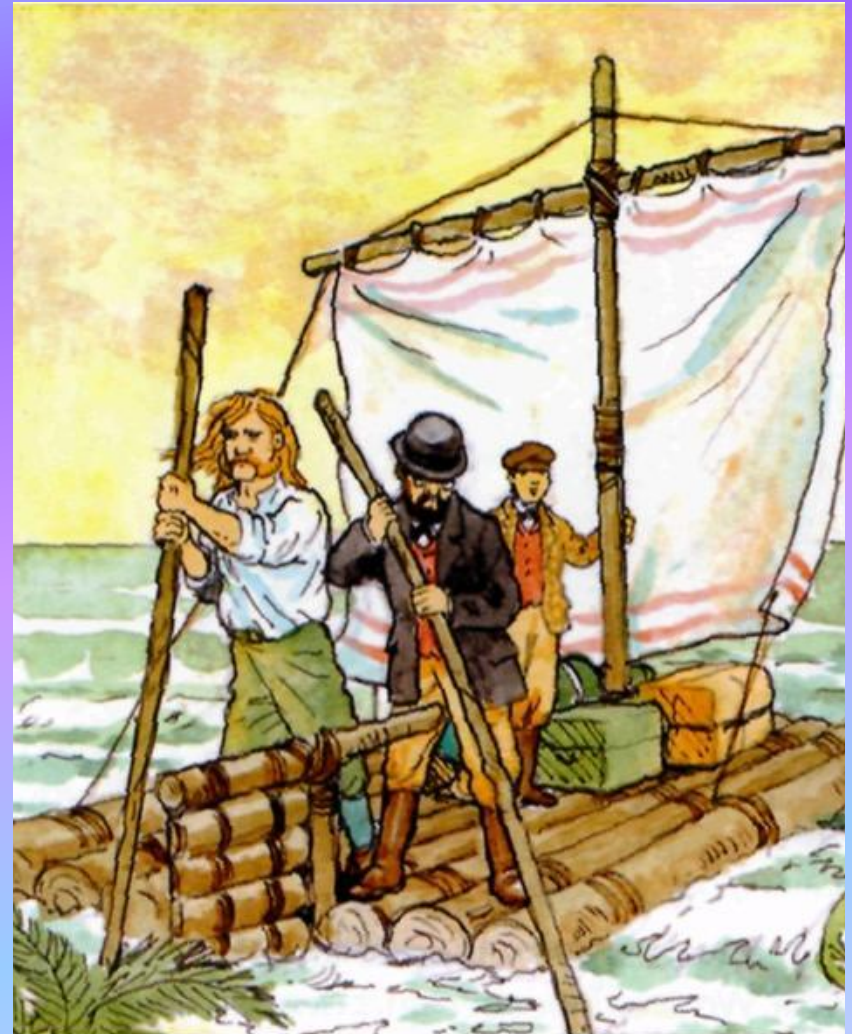
Swiss Family Robinson

Gulliver's travels in Lilliput

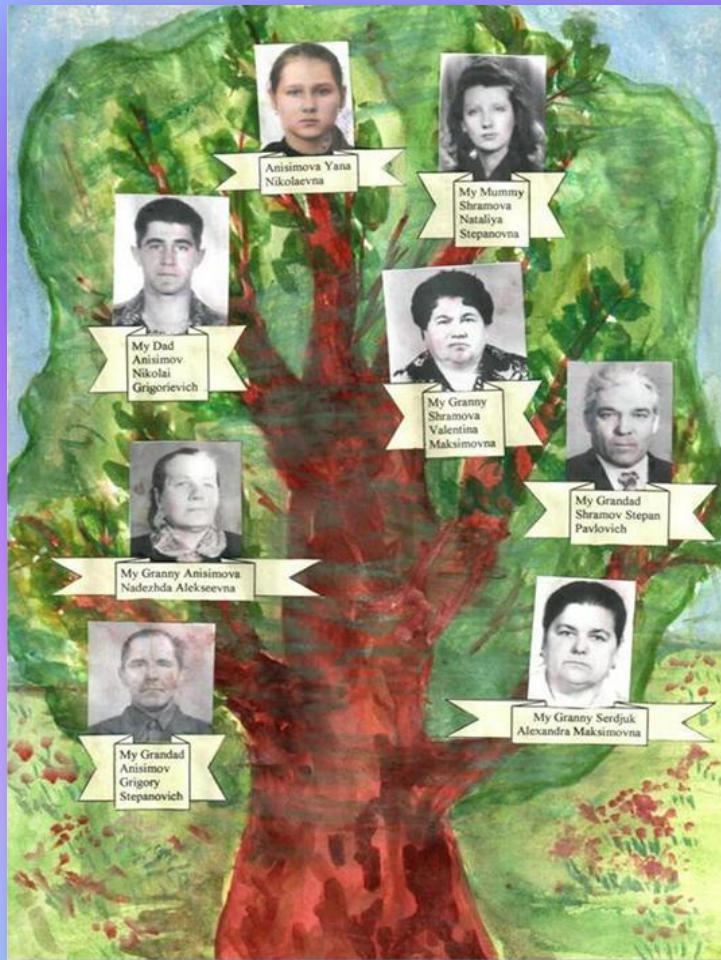
