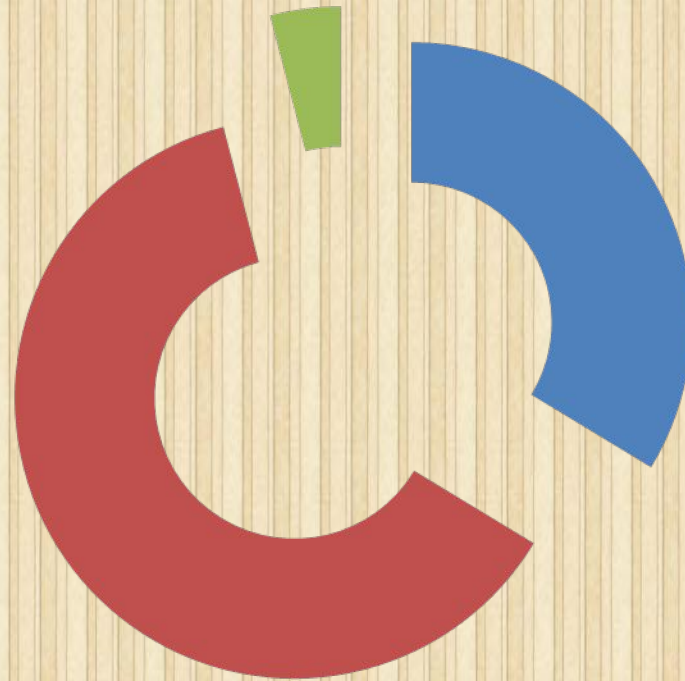
Задачи:

61% of students like cats.





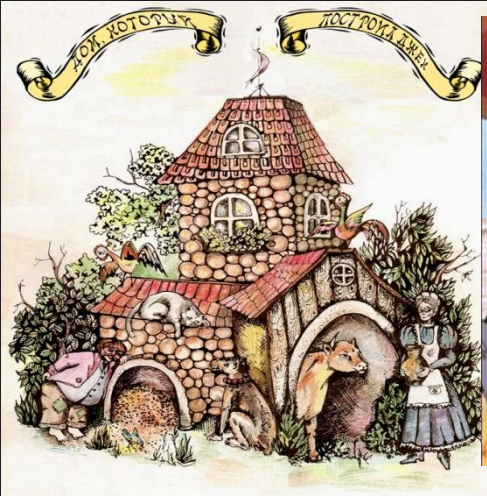

Thus, cats live happily in people’s houses and are the members of their families.

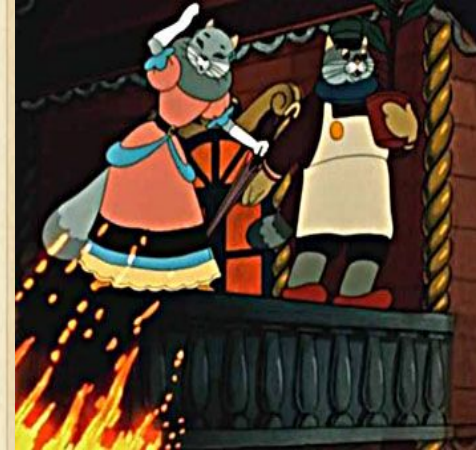
Cats in literature, cartoons
