- Many interesting animals live in the forests around lakes.

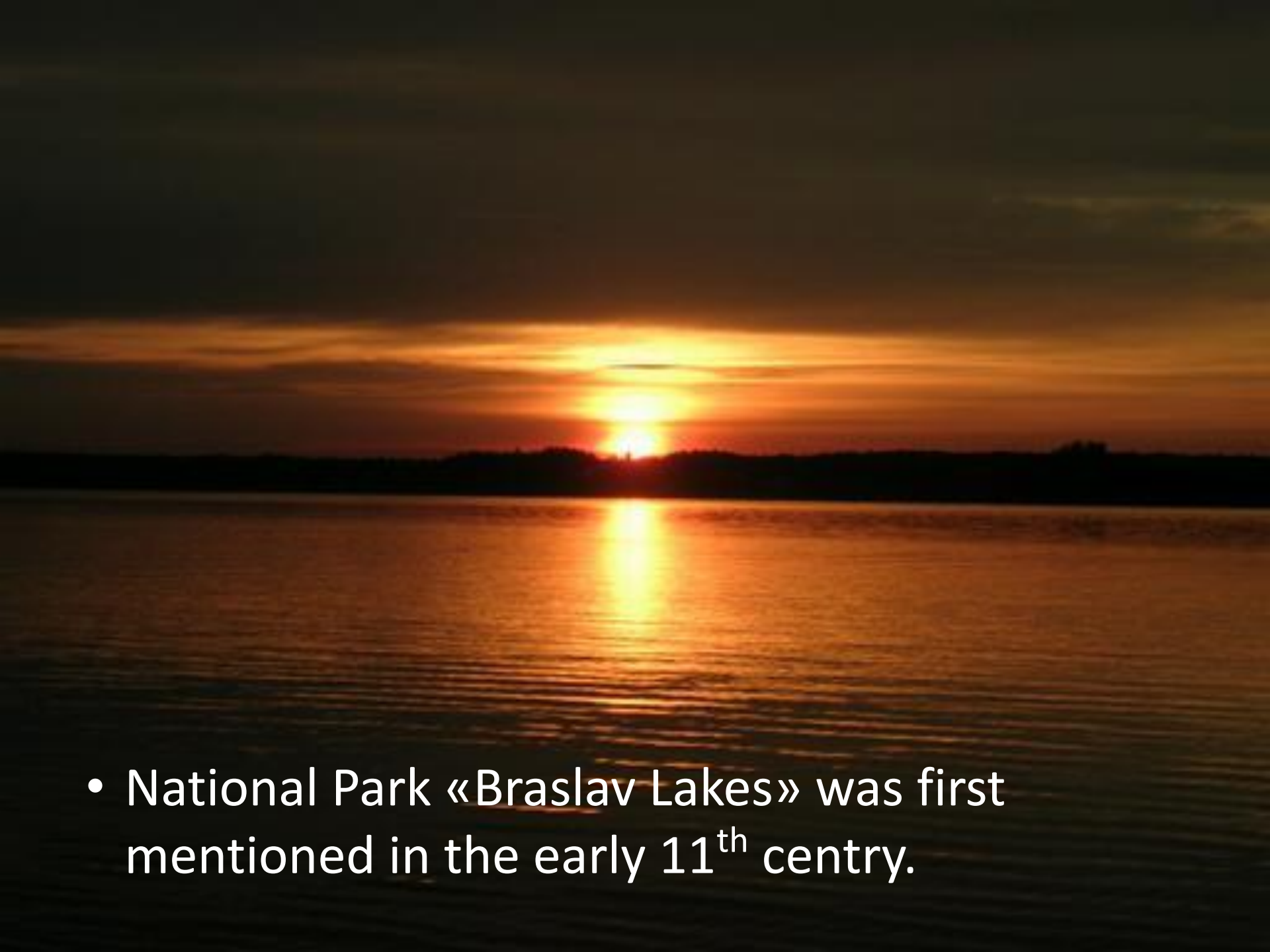






- The centre of the park – one the most ancient towns in Belarus.
