

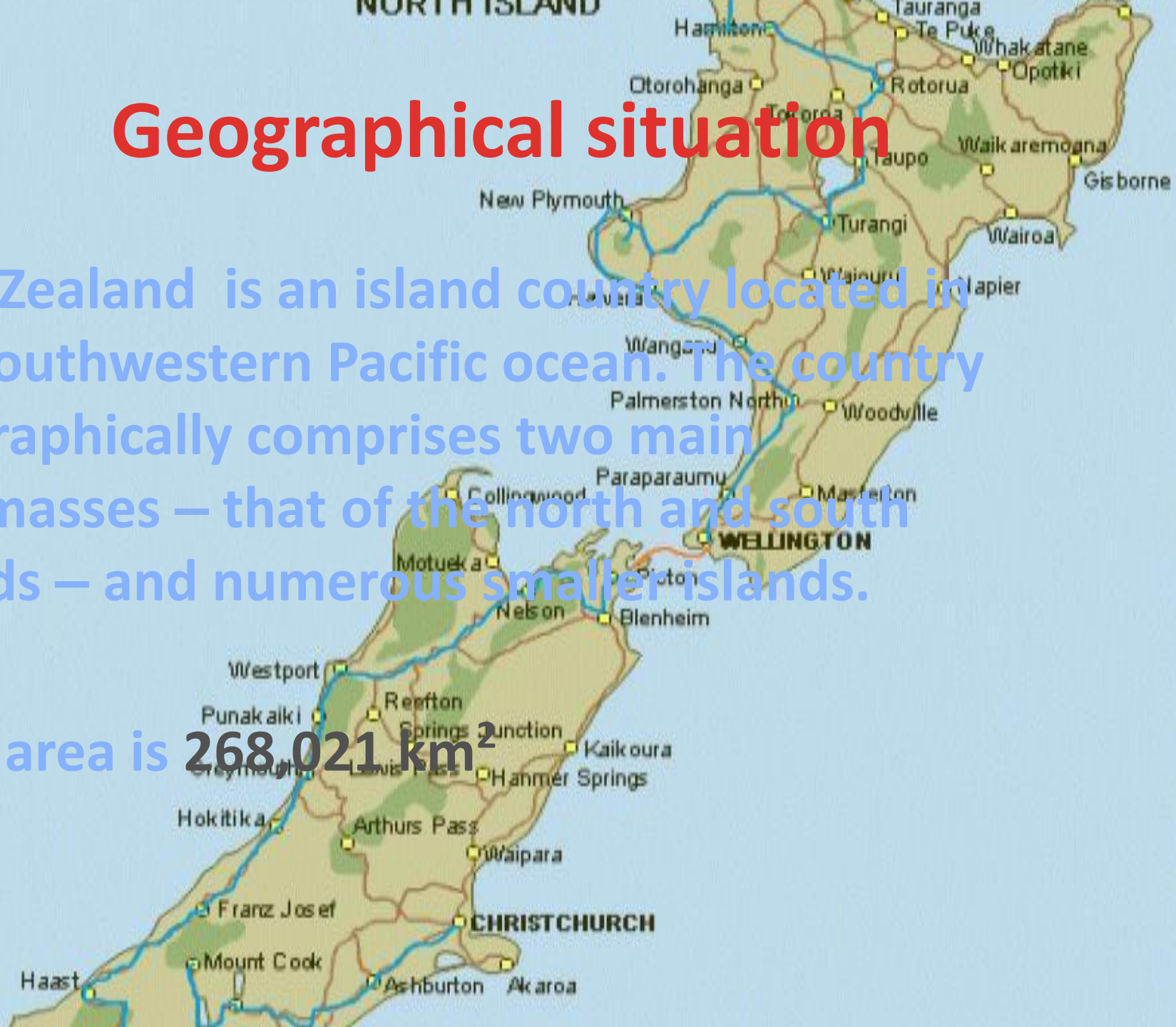
New Zealand

There are many small rivers and lakes in New Zealand.

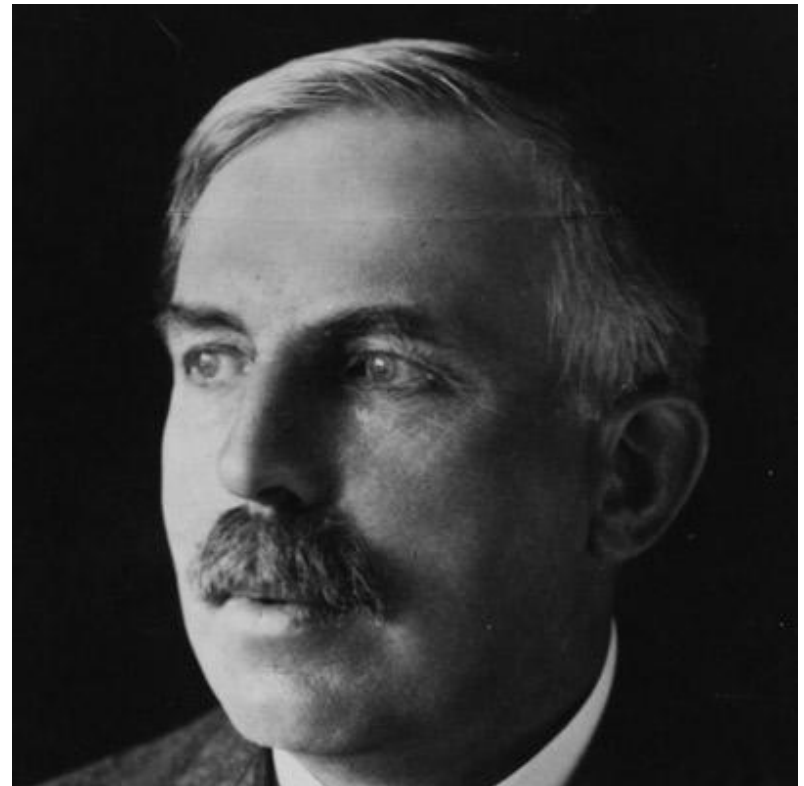
The biggest lakes are Taupo and Haruoko.
