The title of Queen Elizabeth II and is different for each country, which is part of the Commonwealth. For the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland he is:

"Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith".



The Queen celebrates two birthdays a year – on 21 April (the official date of birth) and in mid-May. The second date selected for the popular celebration.

The Queen Elizabeth II **doesn't have a passport.** As a British passport is issued on behalf of Her Majesty, the Queen cannot issue the passport itself. All other members of the Royal family including the Duke of Edinburgh and Prince of Wales have a British passport.





Queen Elizabeth II is the only person in the country who is allowed to drive a car without registration number and driver's license. By the way, driving licence, the Queen received back in 1945.





Queen Elizabeth II is head of state in **16 States** and is the head of the Commonwealth, comprising **53 countries**.
