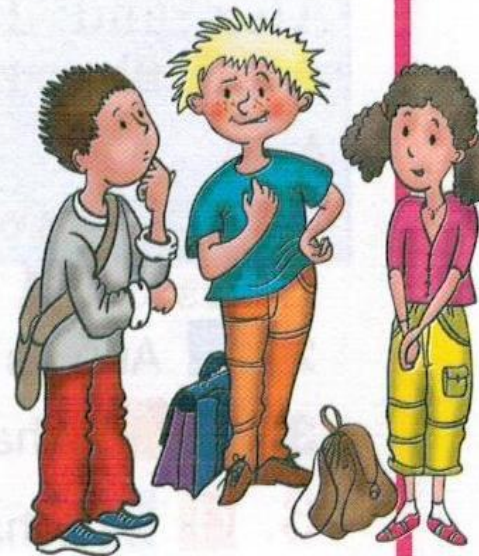
Daniel: I **am going** to be an actor.
