



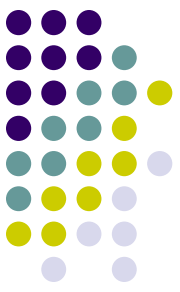

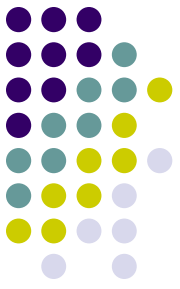
Domestic animals

The crocodile is very dangerous.

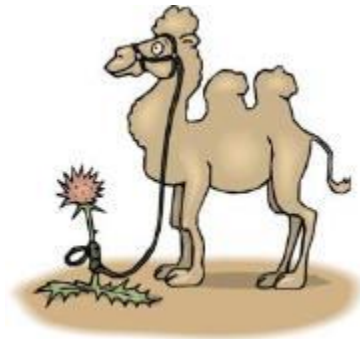
The snake is very long.
