BC. e.

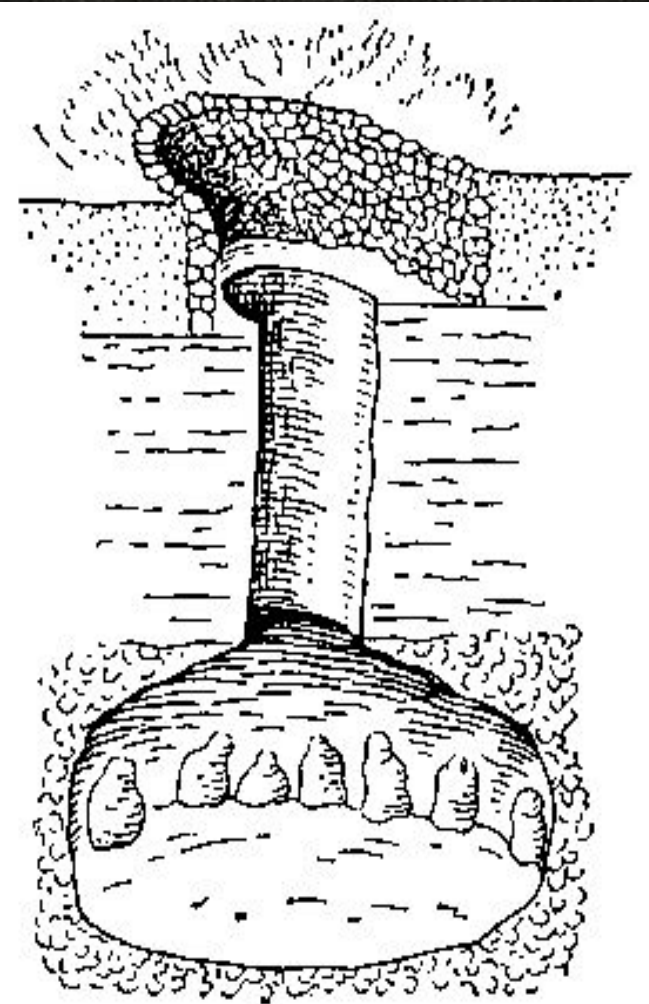


We know of this culture through
research Julio Tello in the 1920s.

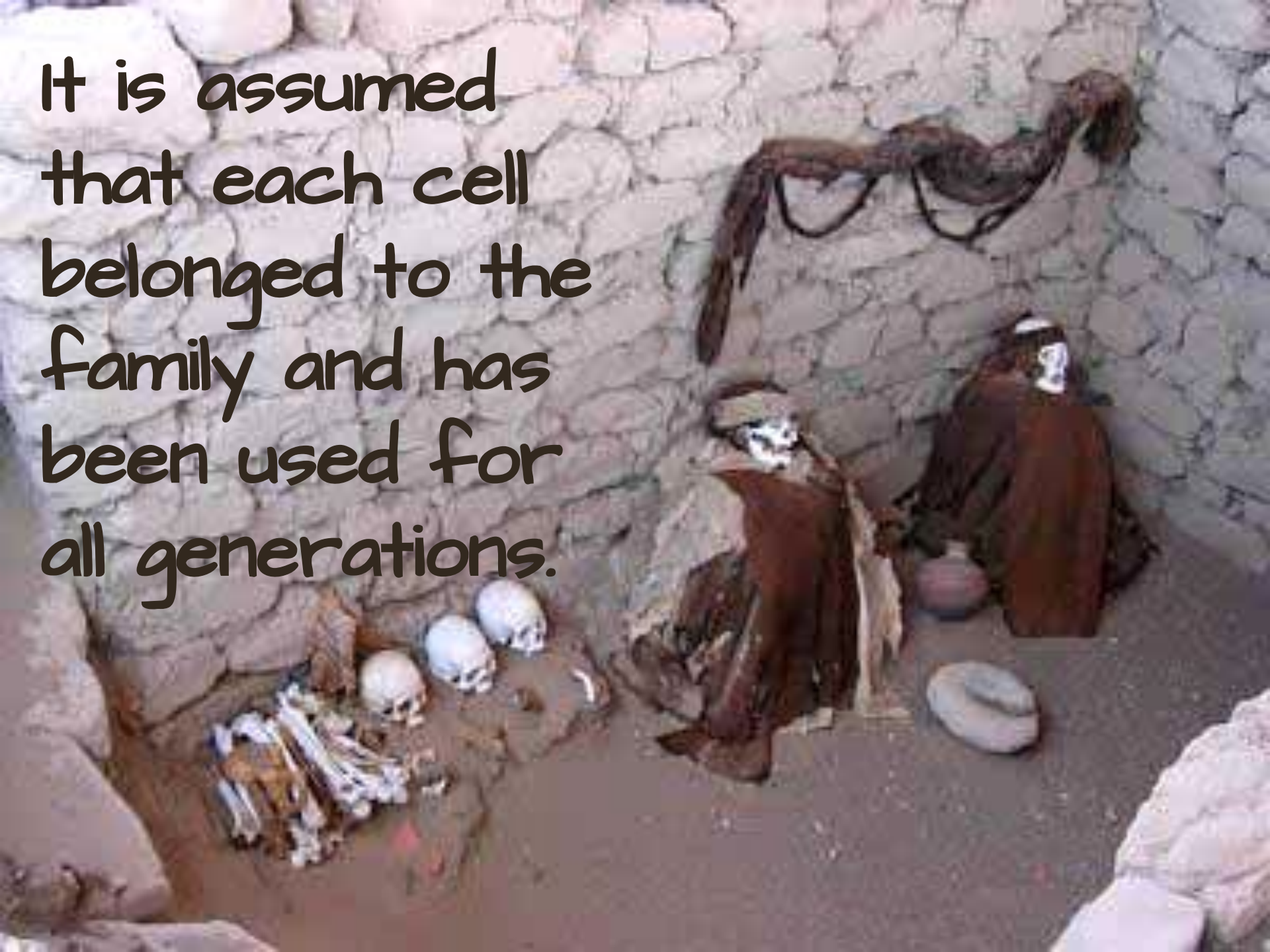
The word "Paracas" means an Indian language "sand rain."

all generations.





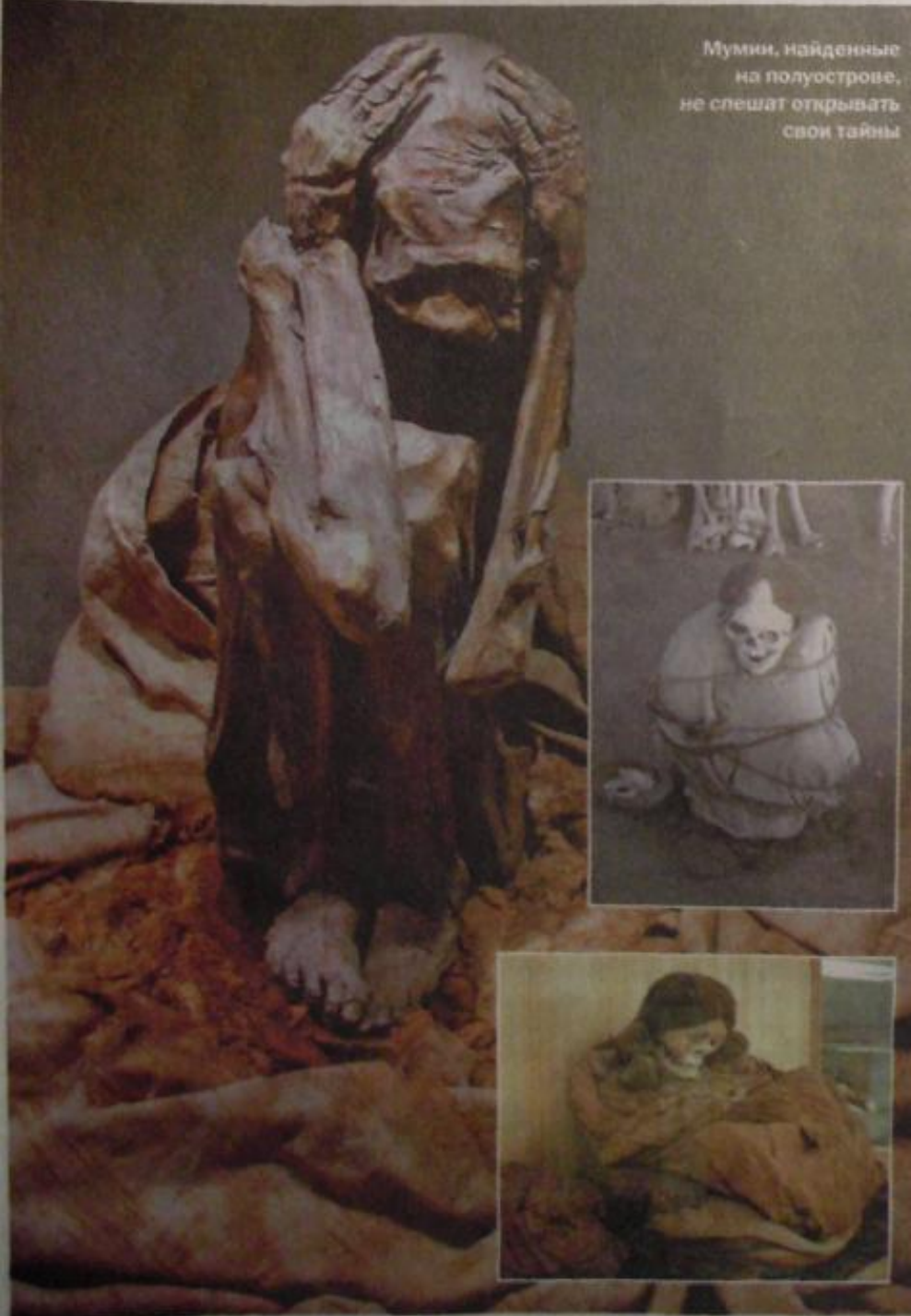
On ancient ceramics and fabrics parakasskih frequently revealed images of the sacred jaguar.

Tello found around the cave, inside which sat dozens of mummies, wrapped in several blankets each.

The process of preparing mummies was as follows: the body was cleansed from the innards and filled with wooden bars.

mouth a little piece



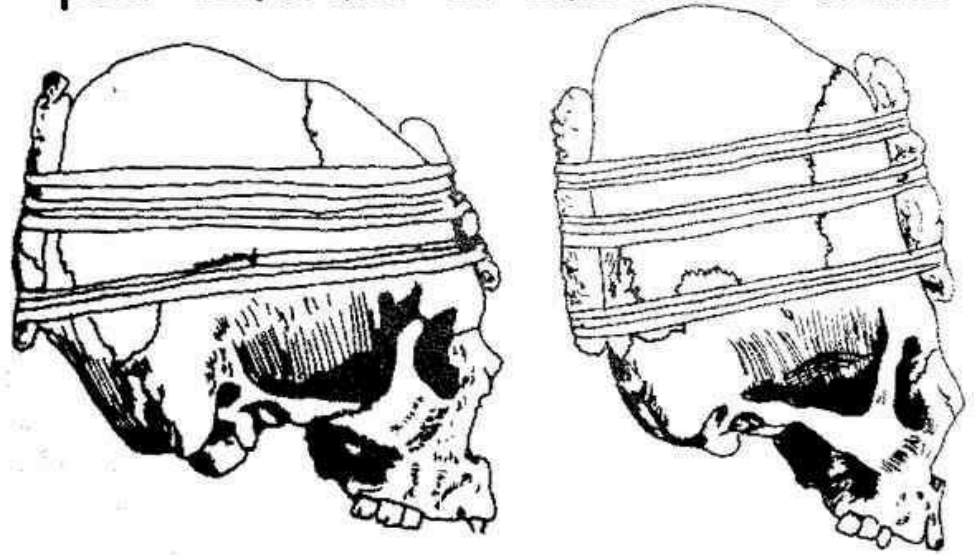

Members of the Paracas culture was a strange fondness for experimenting with their skulls.
