On the 7<sup>th</sup> of December, 1941 Japan made a surprise, attack on the American naval base at Pearl Harbor and the US entered the war

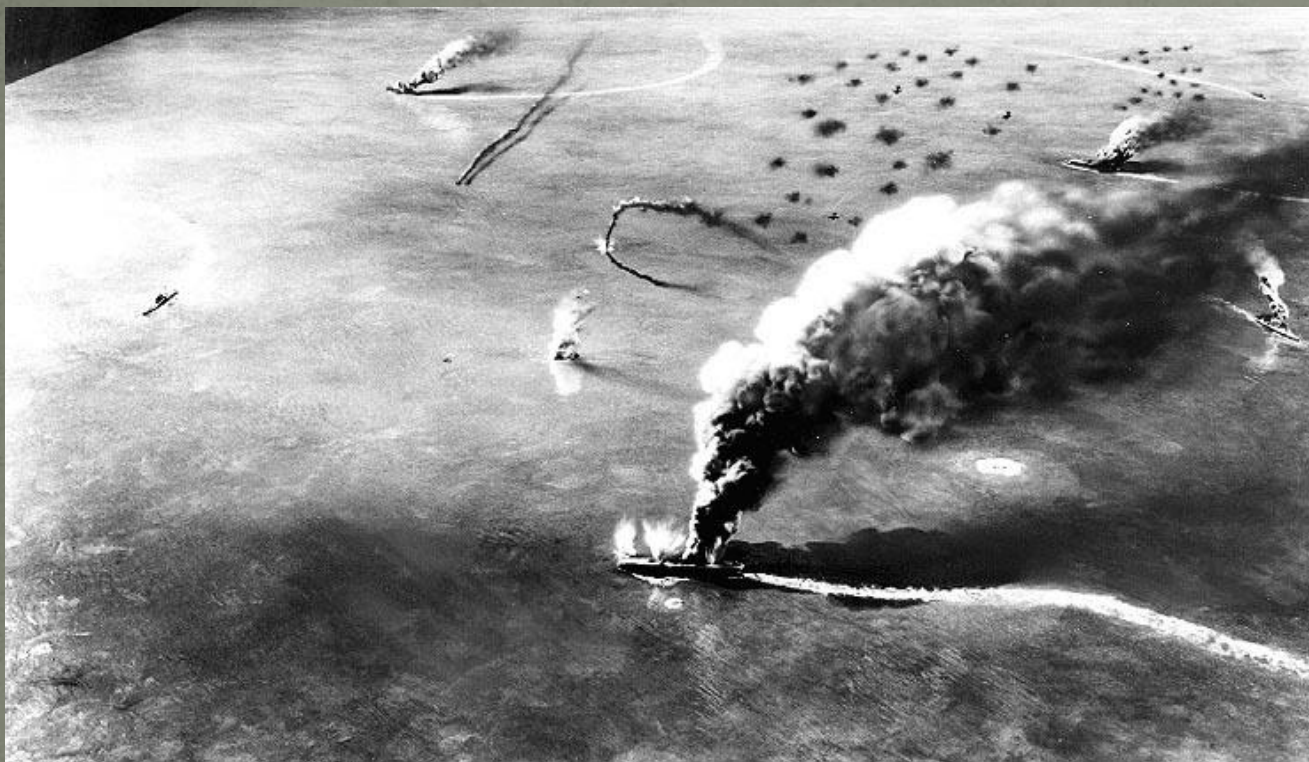


On the 8<sup>th</sup> of

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of August  
US dropped atomic  
bomb on Hiroshima





On the 9<sup>th</sup> of August  
US dropped atomic  
bomb on Nagasaki  
in Japan
