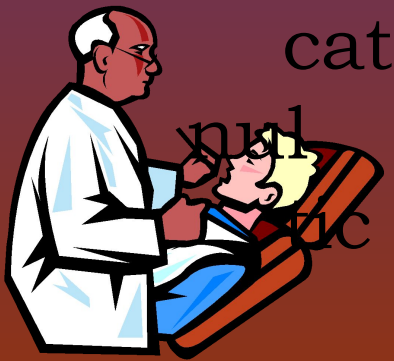

- blending steps
- types of syllables
- where to break



Blending Steps

1. Identify the vowel sound
2. Blend from the beginning
3. Blend to the end
4. Say it fast
