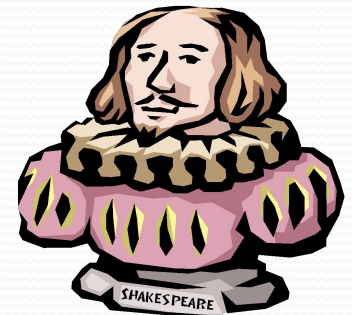

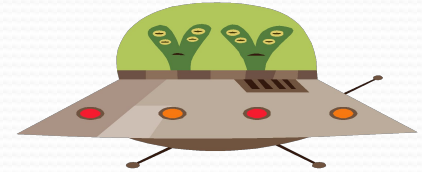

Statistics surveys:

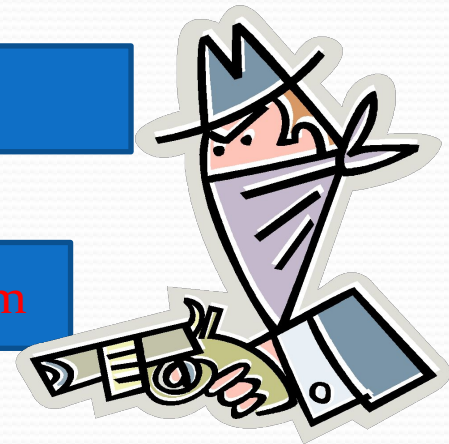


About **50 %** respondents say that the more prefer a **fiction**

About **25%** respondents say that the more prefer a **thrillers**

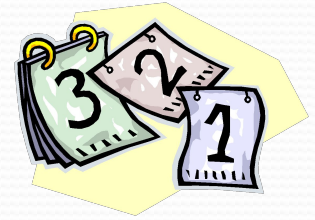
About **13 %** respondents say that the more prefer a **classic**

About 5 % respondents say that read 1 times a month

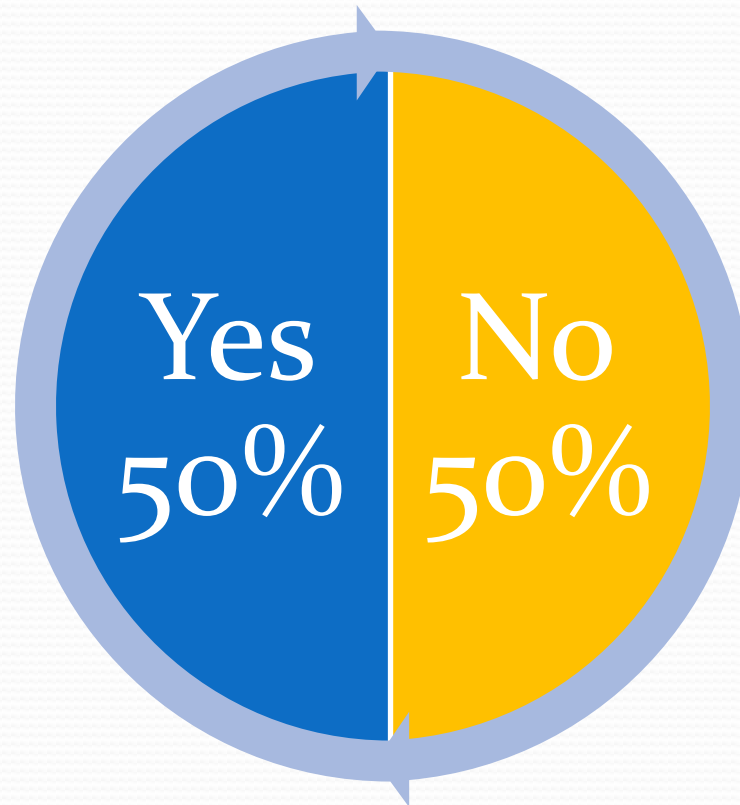
About 3 % respondents say that read only on holidays
