Underwater rugby



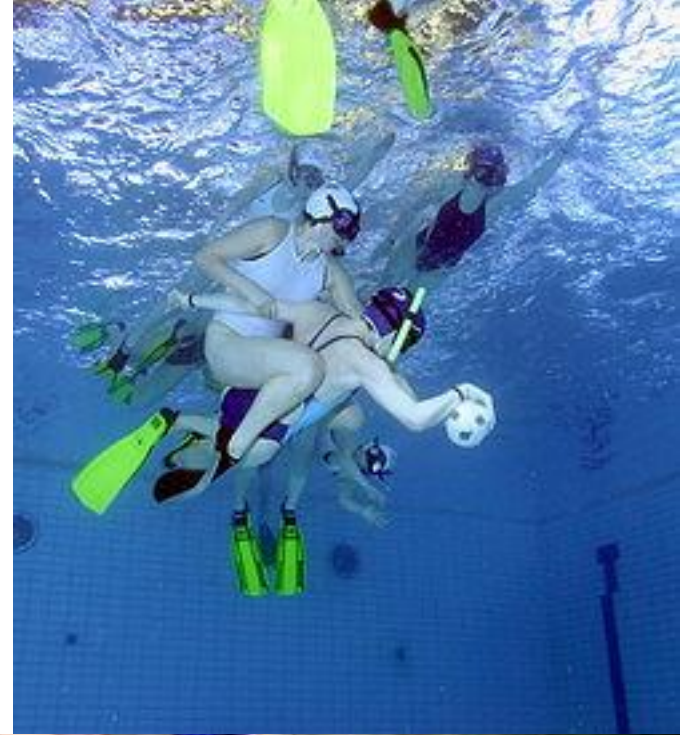
- In 1961 a member of the German Underwater Club Ludwig von Bersuda, came up with the idea of an underwater ball game.



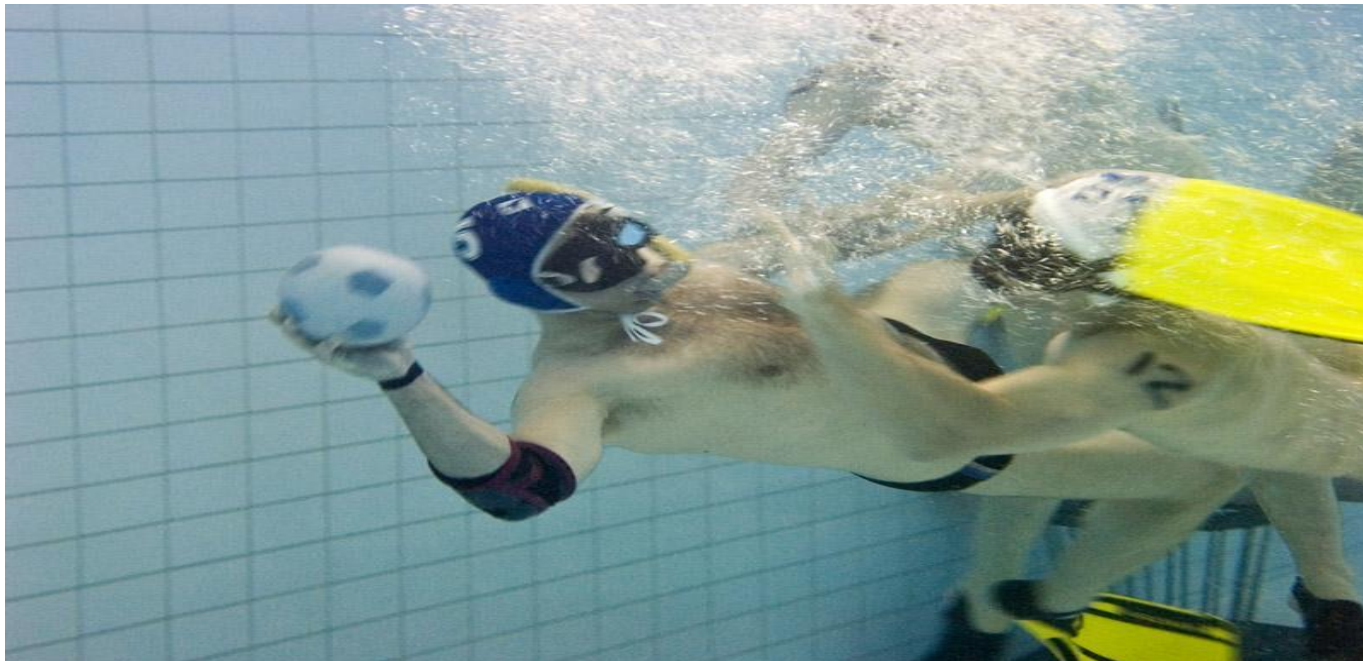
Grimmeisen

As sports underwater Rugby football have been recognized the first in Germany in 1972, and carrying out of the championships became official sports action.



- In 1978 CMAS officially recognizes underwater Rugby as new discipline of underwater sports and on May, 28-30th, 1978 spends the first European championship in the city of Malmo (Sweden), and on May, 15-18th, 1980 the first world championship in the city of Munich.


