
Portraít - a picture or description of any person or group of people that exist or have existed in reality.

Portrait painting - is one of the main genres in fine art, showing the appearance of one particular person, and sometimes groups of people.







The heyday of portrait painting began in the Renaissance. The greatest masterpiece of that time was known by everyone is "Mona Lisa" by Leonardo da Vinci.


