# Reading (5 tasks - 35 questions)

Contains

- ✓ tasks-choice from a variety of options proposed
- ✓ tasks on correlating text and the associated human
- ✓ task to choose true / false.

# Writing (3 tasks 7 questions)

Contains

- ✓ a task to the compilation sentences identical with this,
- ✓ writing short notes or letters,
- ✓ writing a letter or story (optional).

# Listening

Task 1	7 short conversations, each of which you must choose one of the three proposed images
Task 2	Monologue or interview and 6 questions to him with the choice of the correct answer from the three choices
Task 3	Monologue. You must fill in 6 passes in the text after listening
Task 4	Dialogue. You must define true or false each of these 6 offers after listening

# Speaking

1. Answers to the questions of the examiner (mostly about themselves)

2. The examiner gives the candidate a picture and describes the situation.  
Necessary in a conversation with the other candidate to come to the decision that it would be the best choice of action in this situation

3. The examiner gives a color photo, which the applicant must describe

4. Conversation both candidates on topic started in the task three (on photographs)
