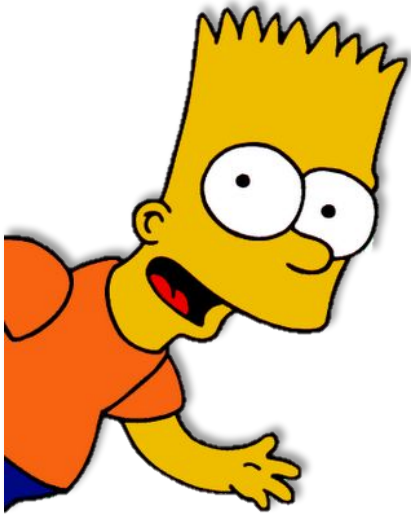

bone.



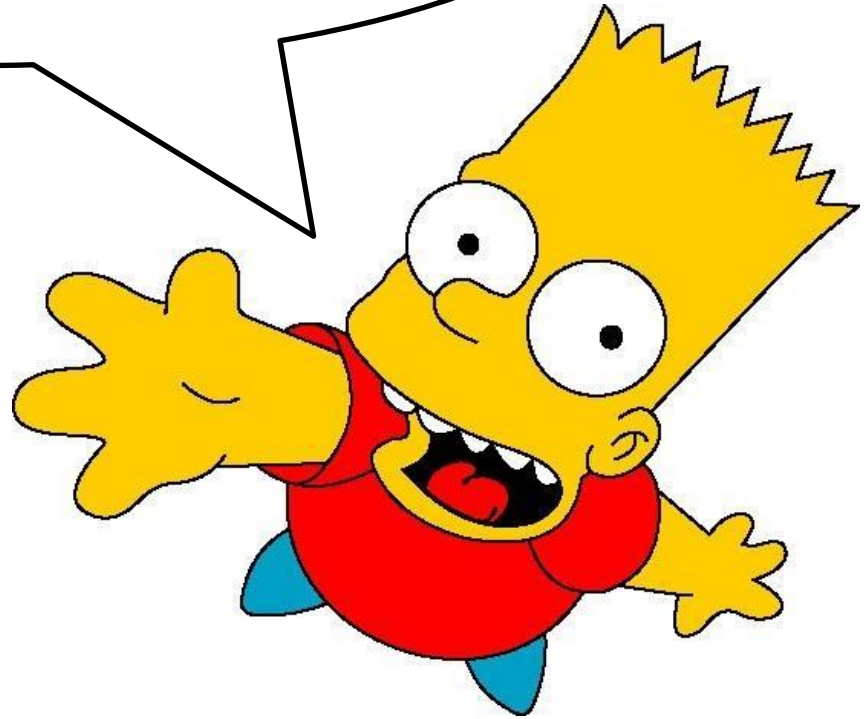

He **hasn't got** a saxophone.

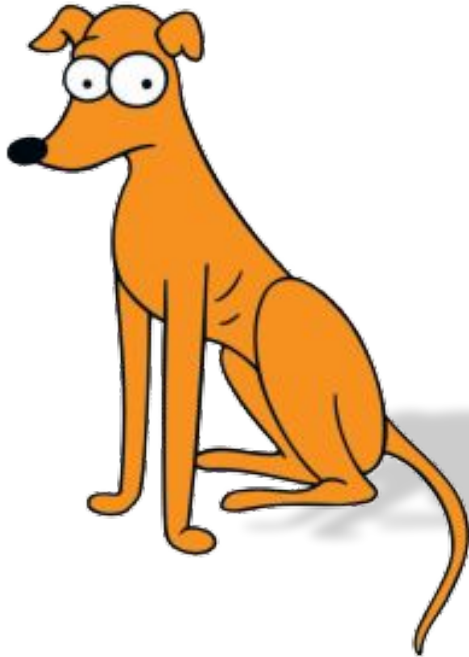
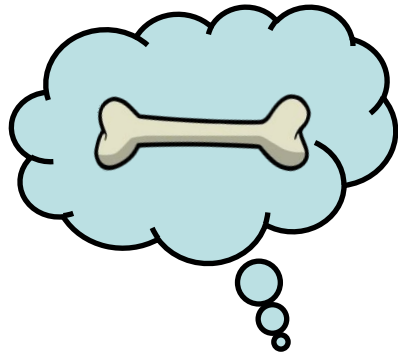


HAVE GOT NEGATIVE

bone.



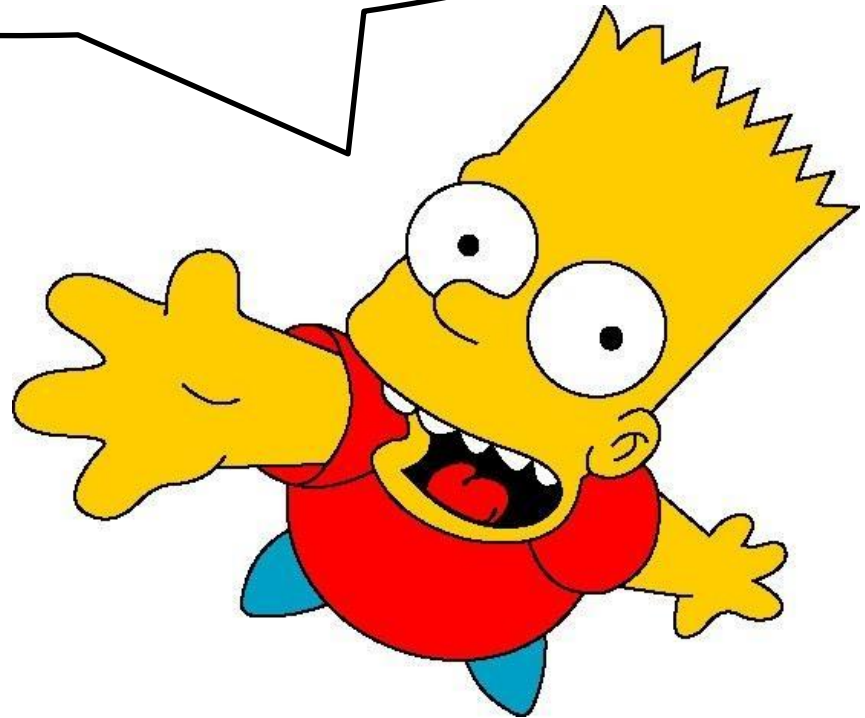
HAVE GOT NEGATIVE

Yes, **you have.**



HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

Have you got
a skateboard?

No, I
haven't.



HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

Has she got a ball?

No, she hasn't.



HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

Have they got a saxophone?

No, they haven't.



HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

QUESTIONS

Have I got?

Have you got?

Has he got?

Has she got?

Has it got?

Have we got?

Have you got?

Have they got?

SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I/you have

No, I/you haven't

Yes, he/she/it has

No, he/she/it hasn't

Yes, we/you/they have

No, we/you/they haven't
