Later that night the Ghost of Christmas Past, the Ghost of Christmas Present and the Ghost of Christmas yet come to visit him.

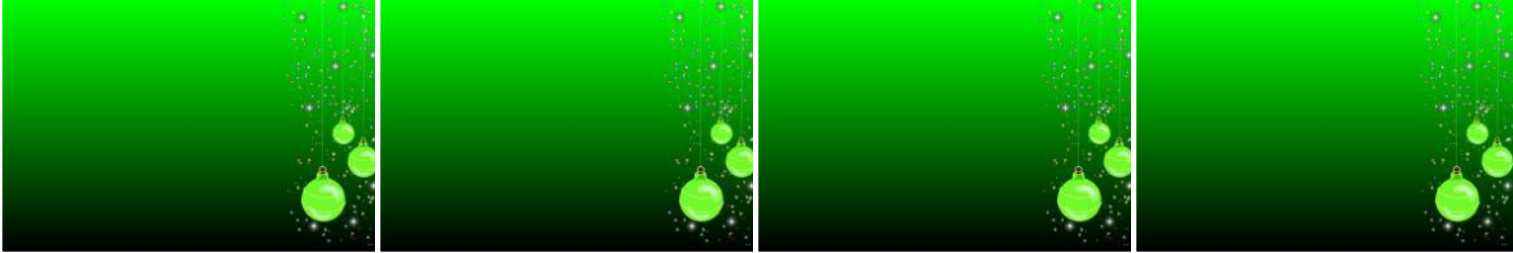
The spirits complete their visits in one night giving him the opportunity to mend his ways.



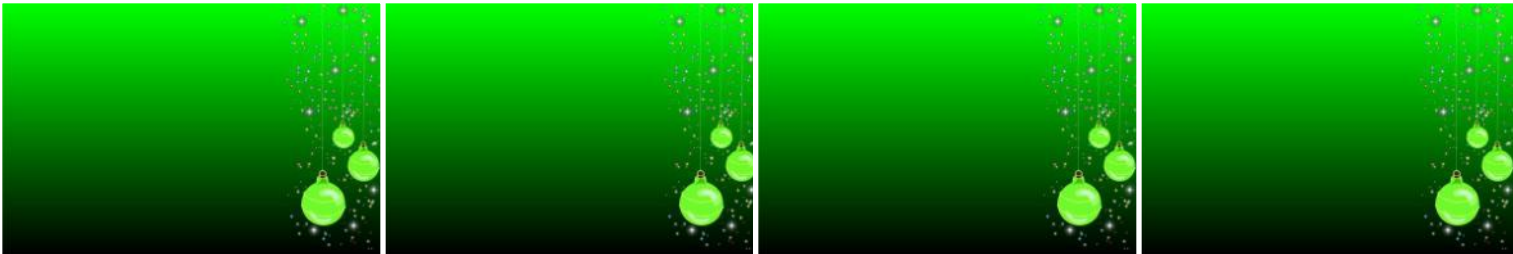

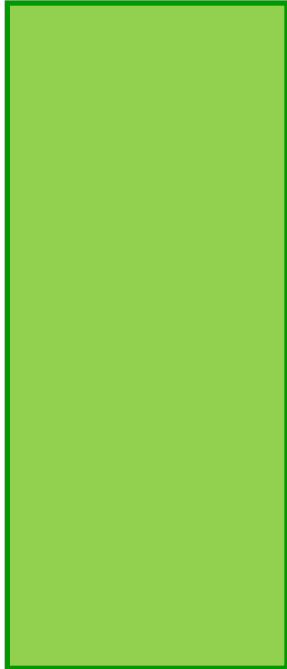
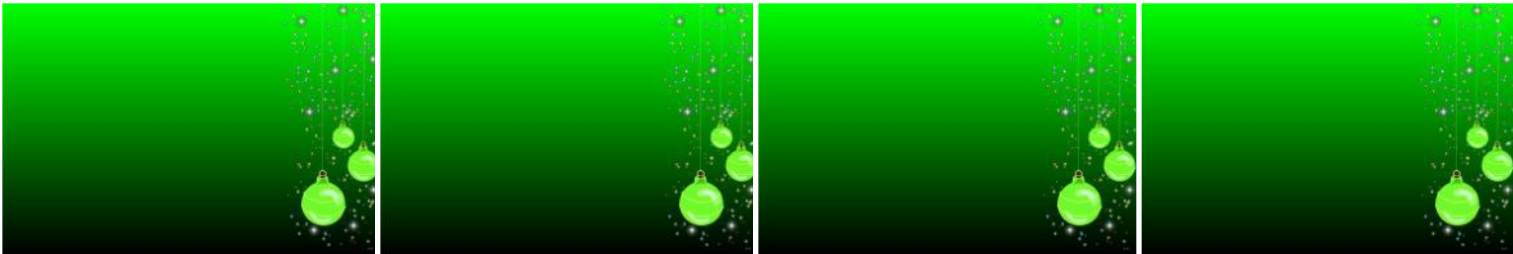
