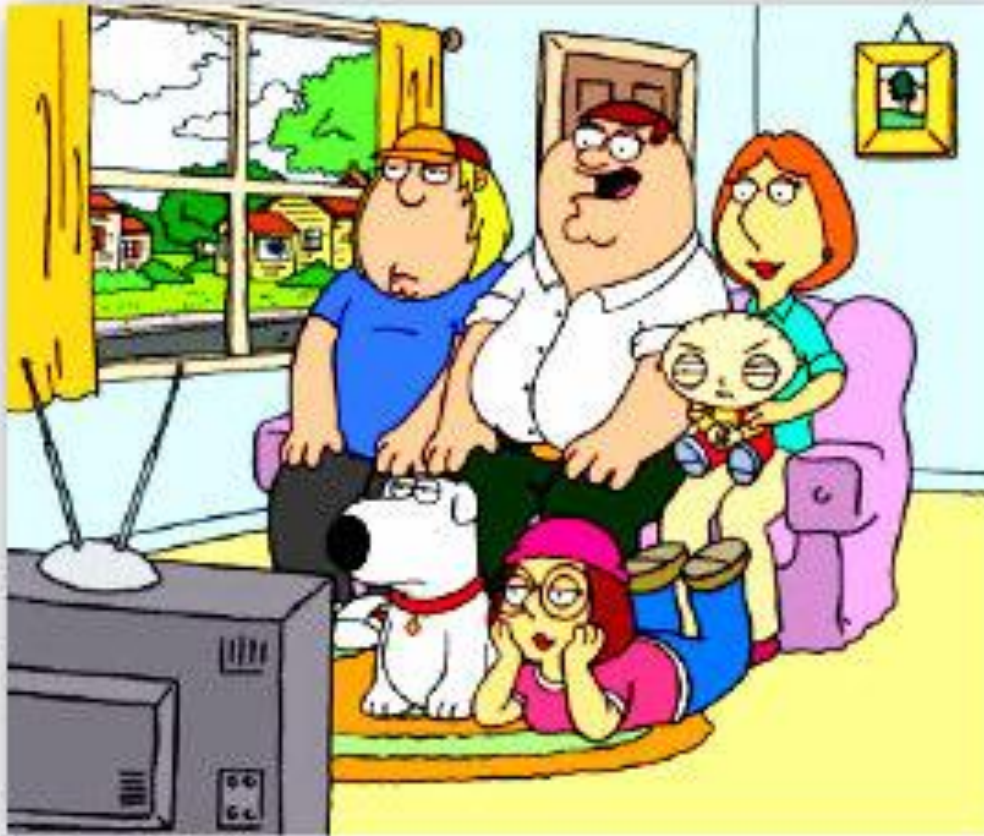

The dog isn't driving a car.

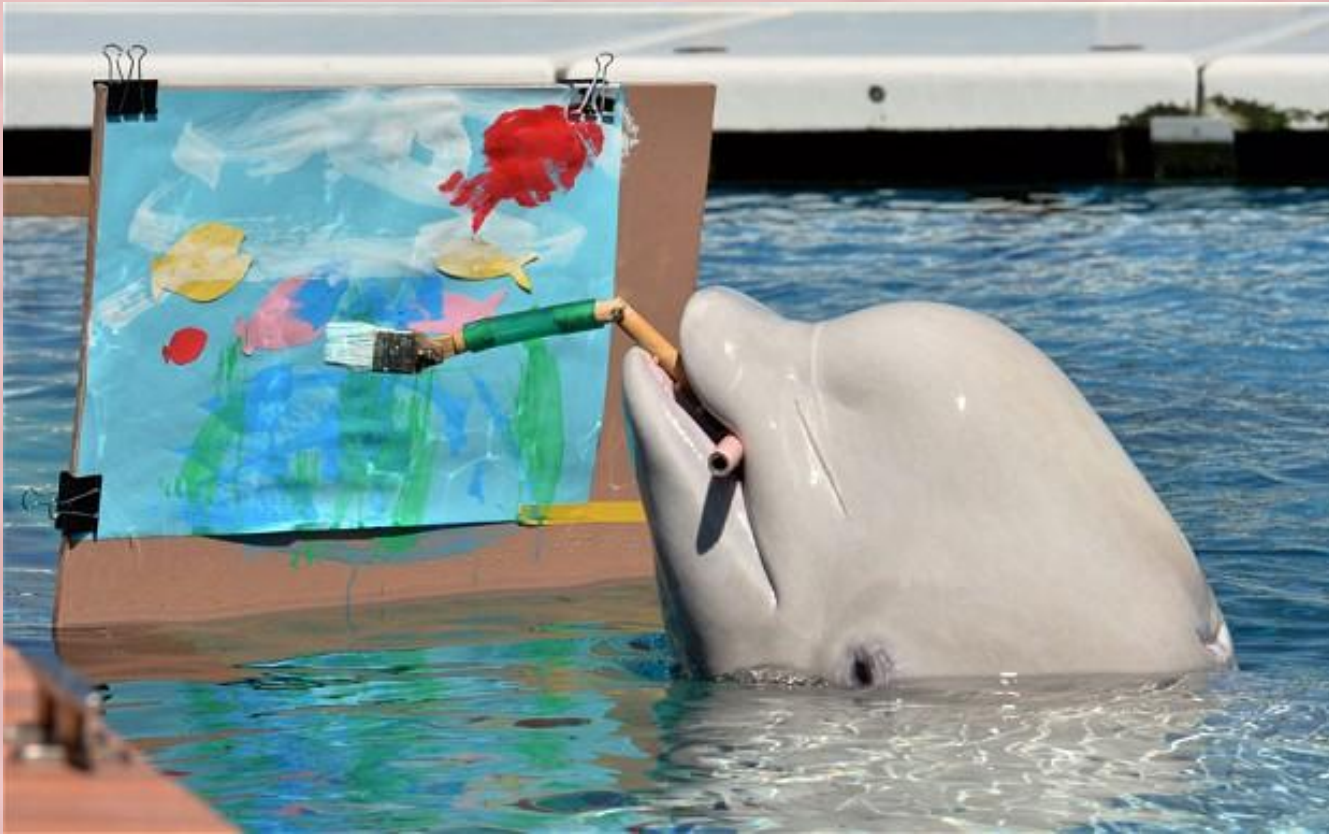
You can't see the picture now,
