And go back when it's light.



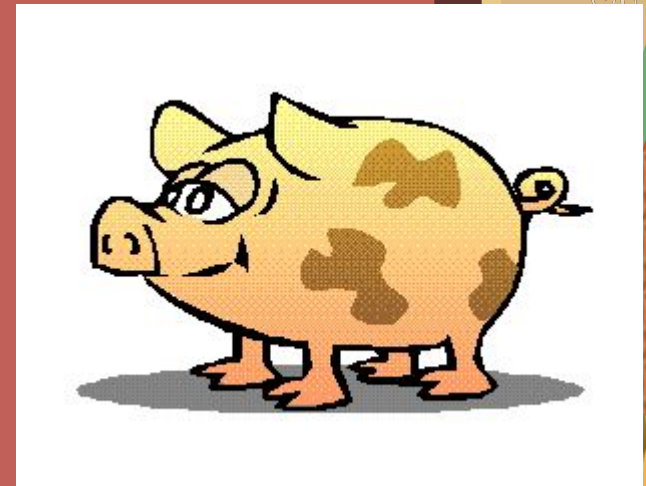
**My dog has 4 legs,

And she never runs away.**



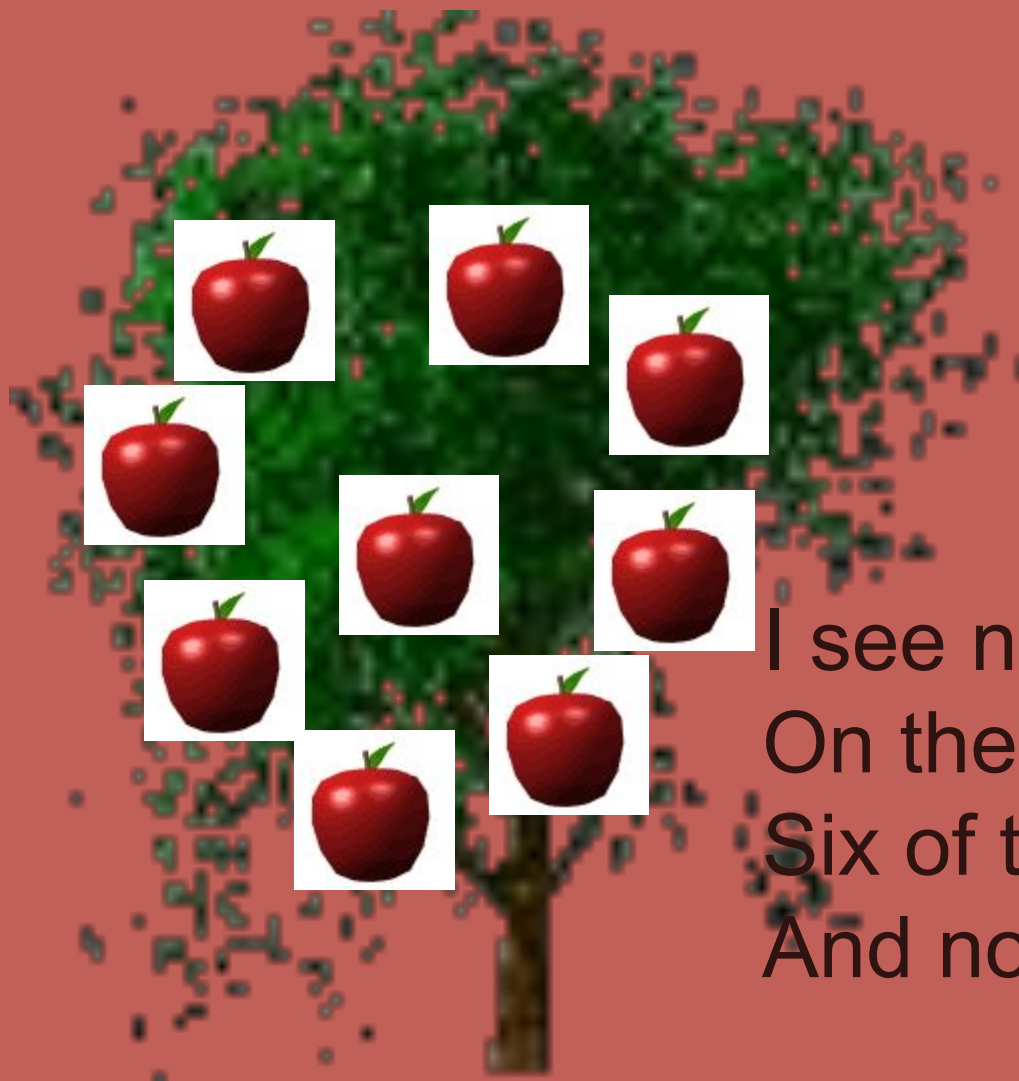
**Look at the pig.

Fly high in the blue sky.

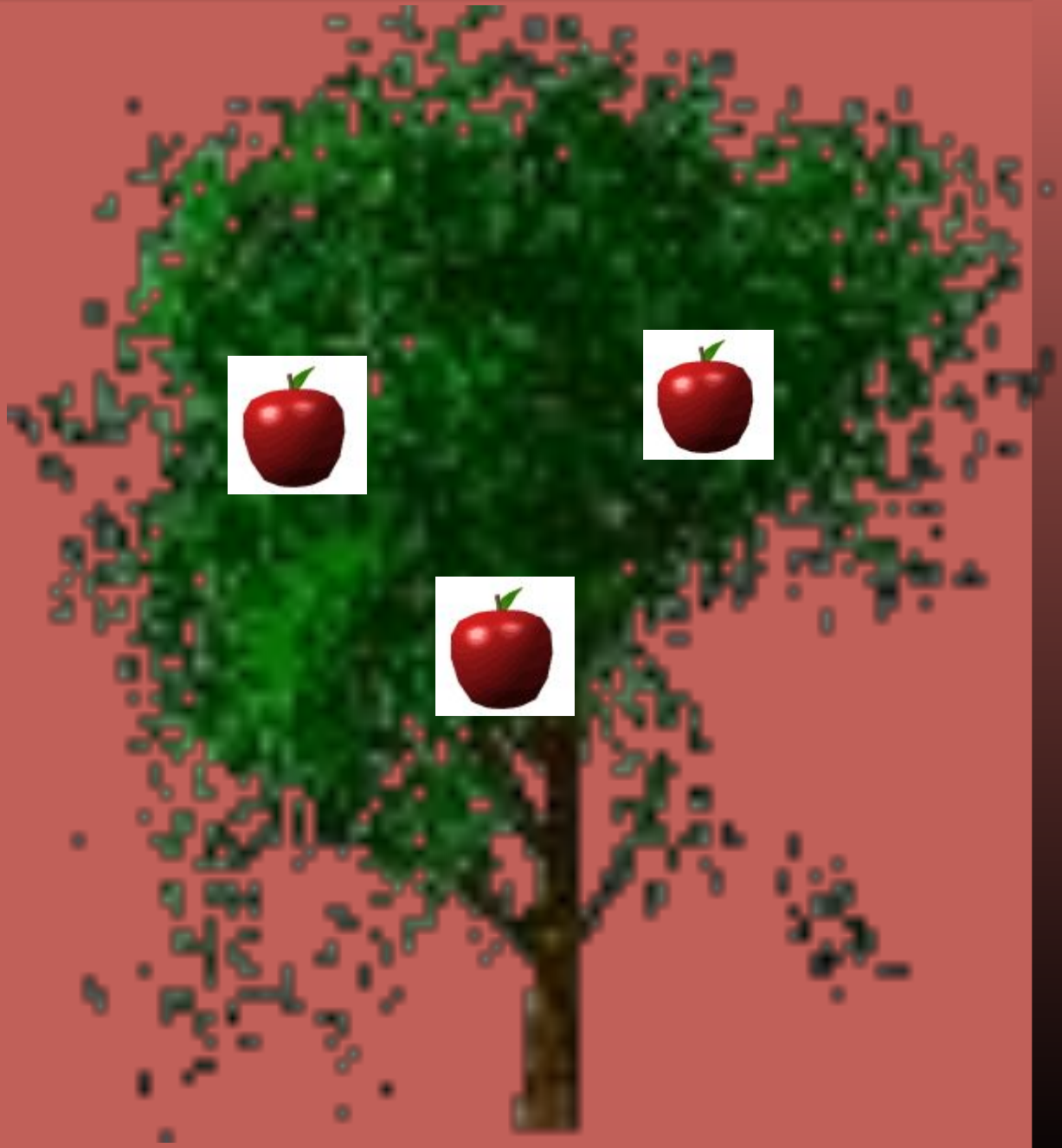






I see nine apples

And what about you?



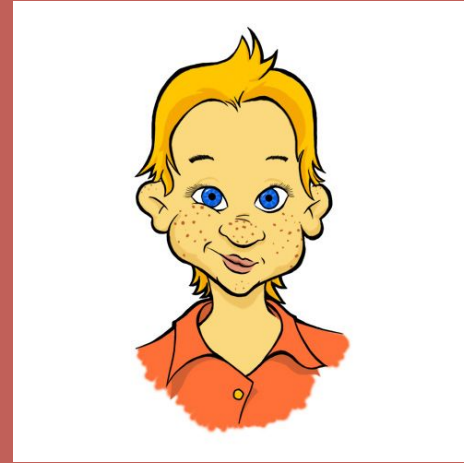
**House**
