


Reflexive Pronouns





Reflexive Pronouns

- Возвратные местоимения показывают, что действие в предложении направлено на лицо, которое его выполняет
- и на русский язык переводятся с помощью суффикса -ся (-сь) или местоимением "себя", "собой", "себе", "сам".





Reflexive Pronouns

- Reflexive pronouns are used to show that the actions described by a verb act upon the subject of the verb:
- the subject and the object are the same



Reflexive pronouns

- Reflexive pronouns are formed by adding
- self (singular)
- or selves (plural)
- to my, your, our him, her, it, them





 The forms of reflexive pronouns correspond to the forms of the subject pronouns:




