- Streets and houses are decorated garland.



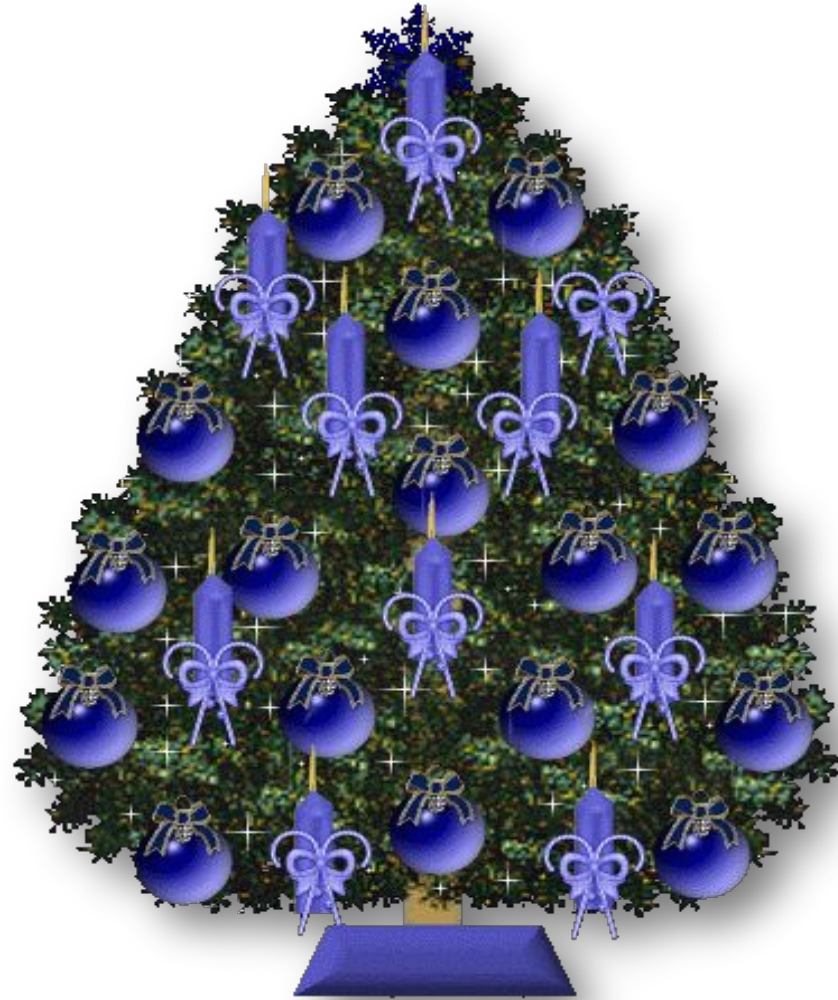
Every New Year Russia have got a big New Year tree. We put it up in Red Square in Moscow.
