



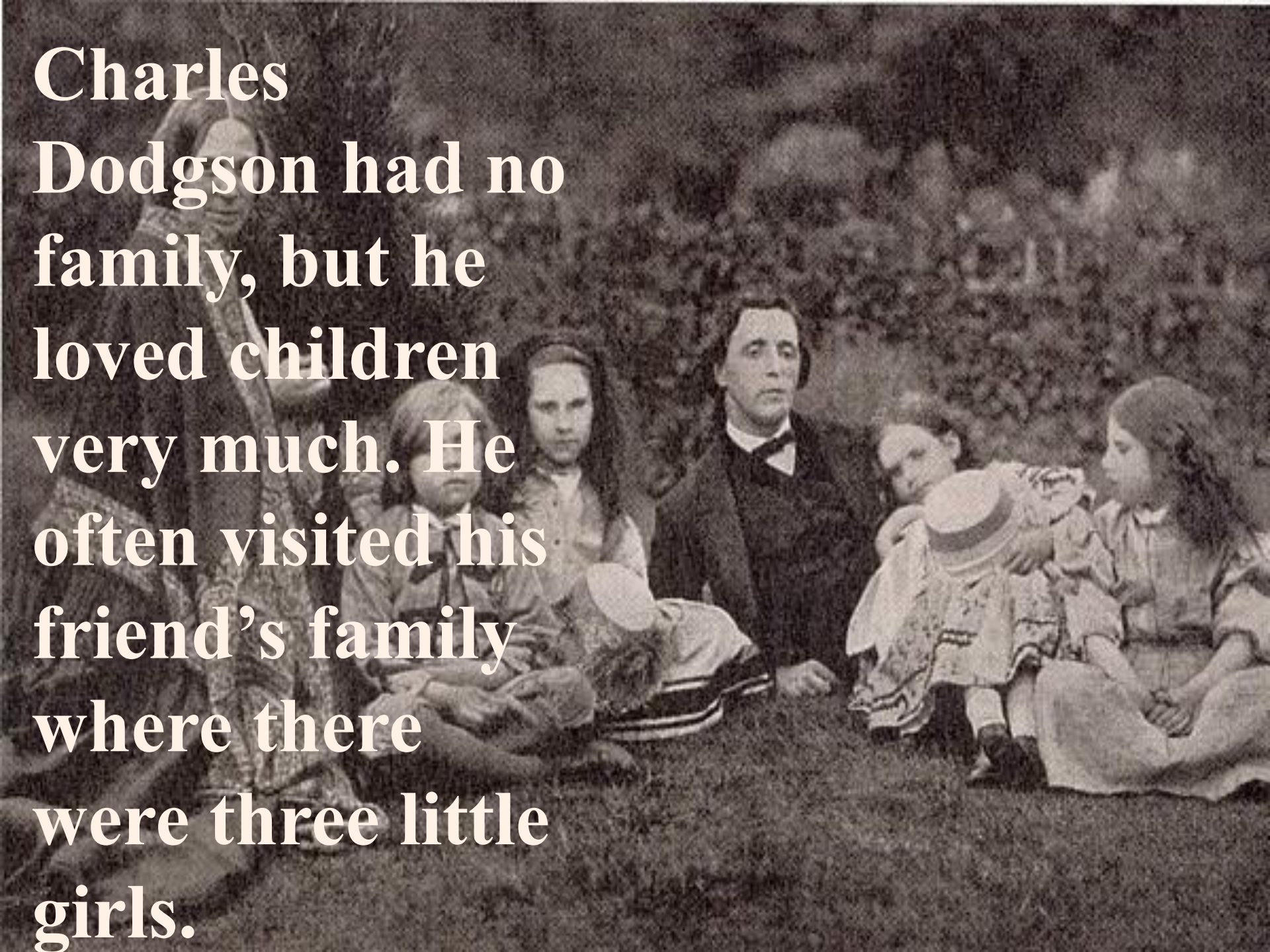


**Lewis Carroll

girls.**

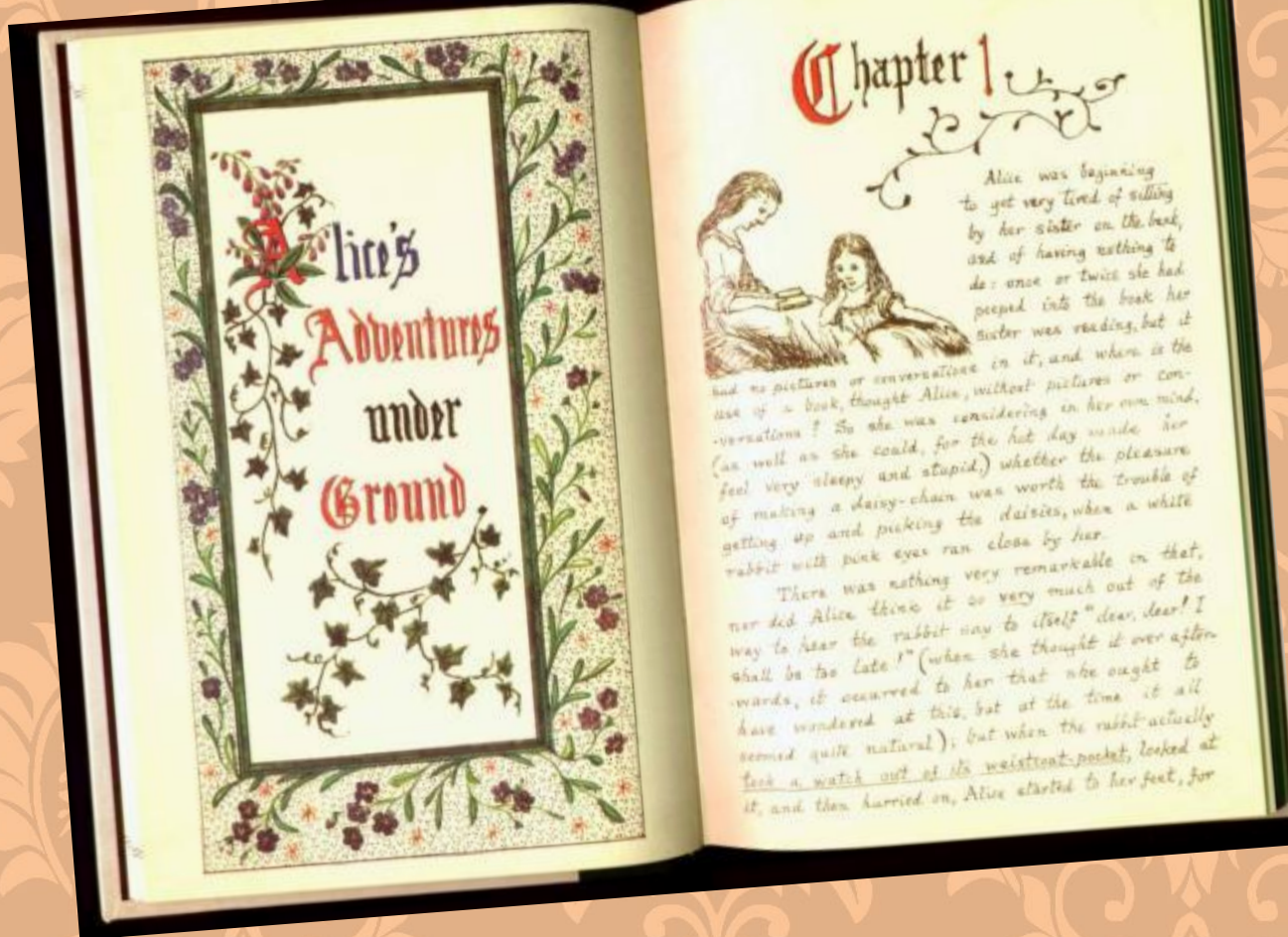




**One of them

**When Alice was about ten years old, she asked Charles to write down the stories.**

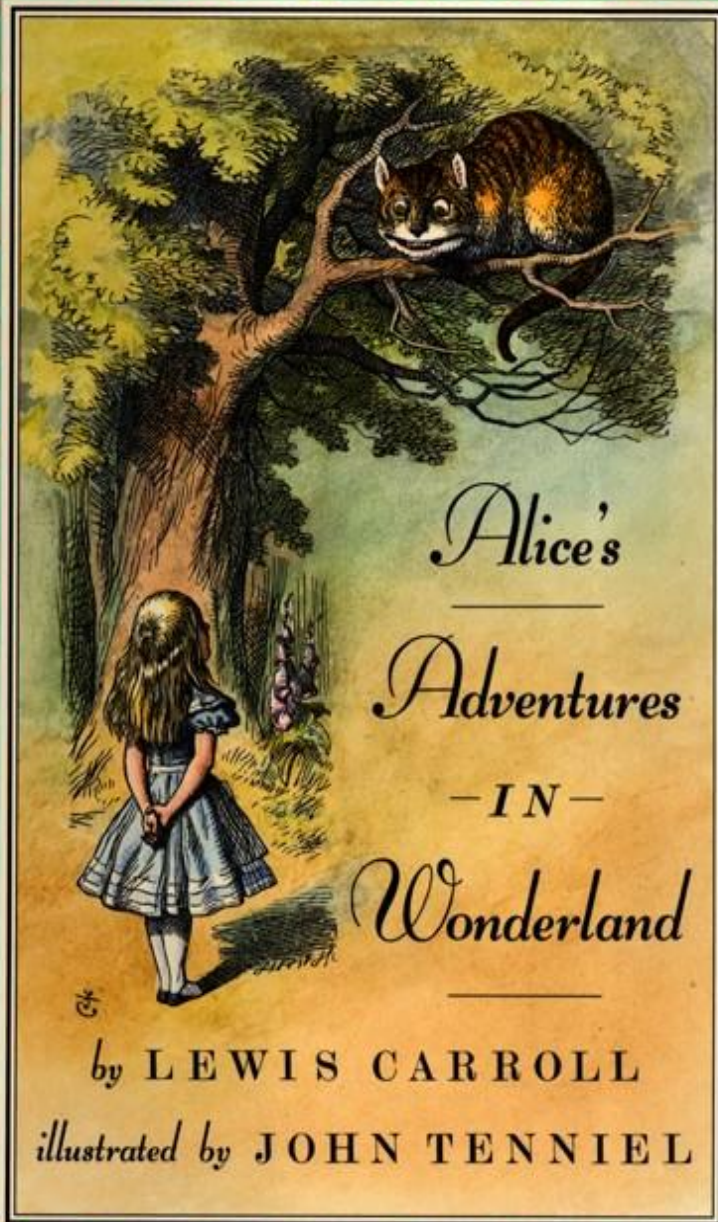


**He made a handwritten book for her and even draw pictures in it.**

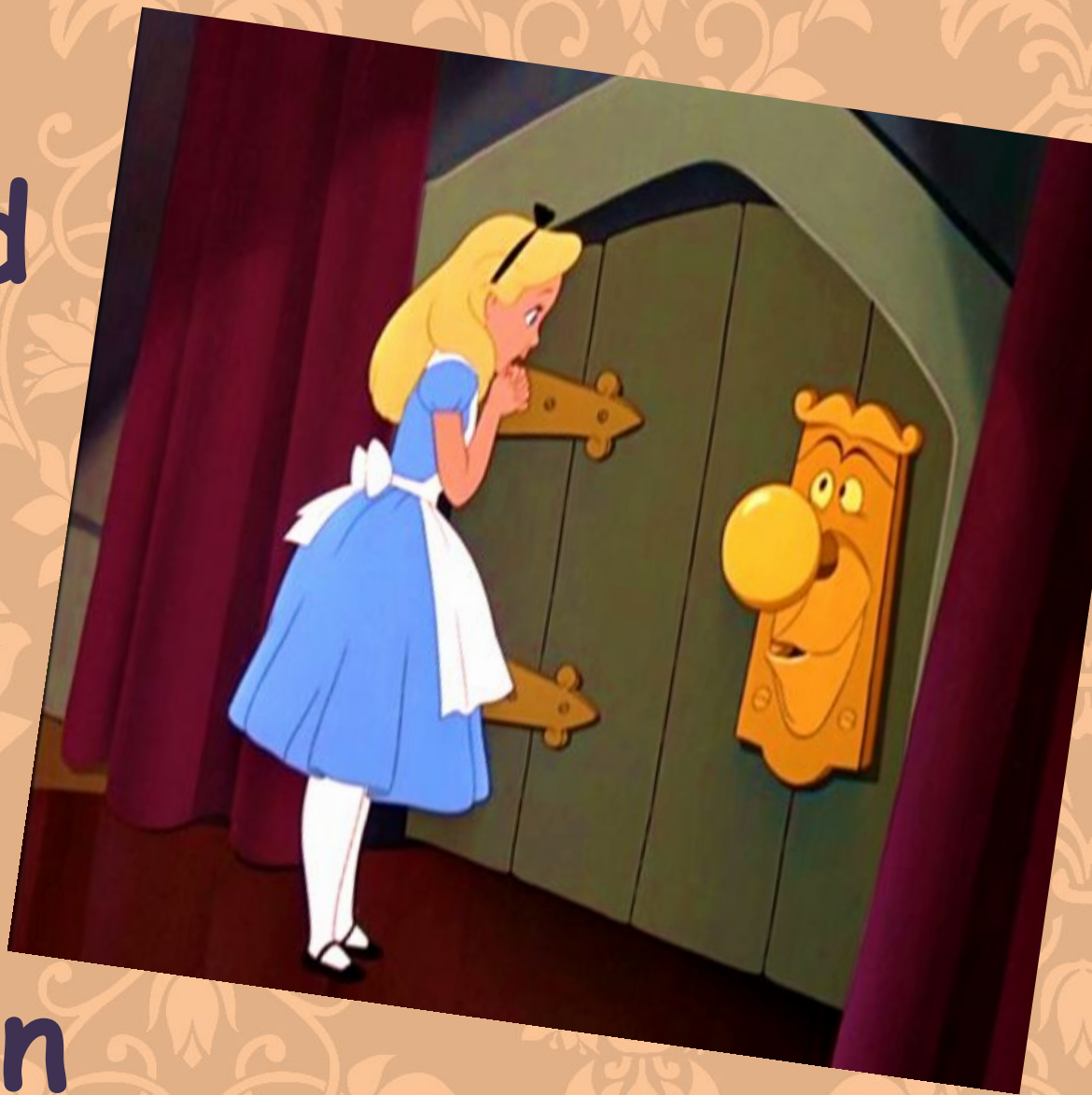

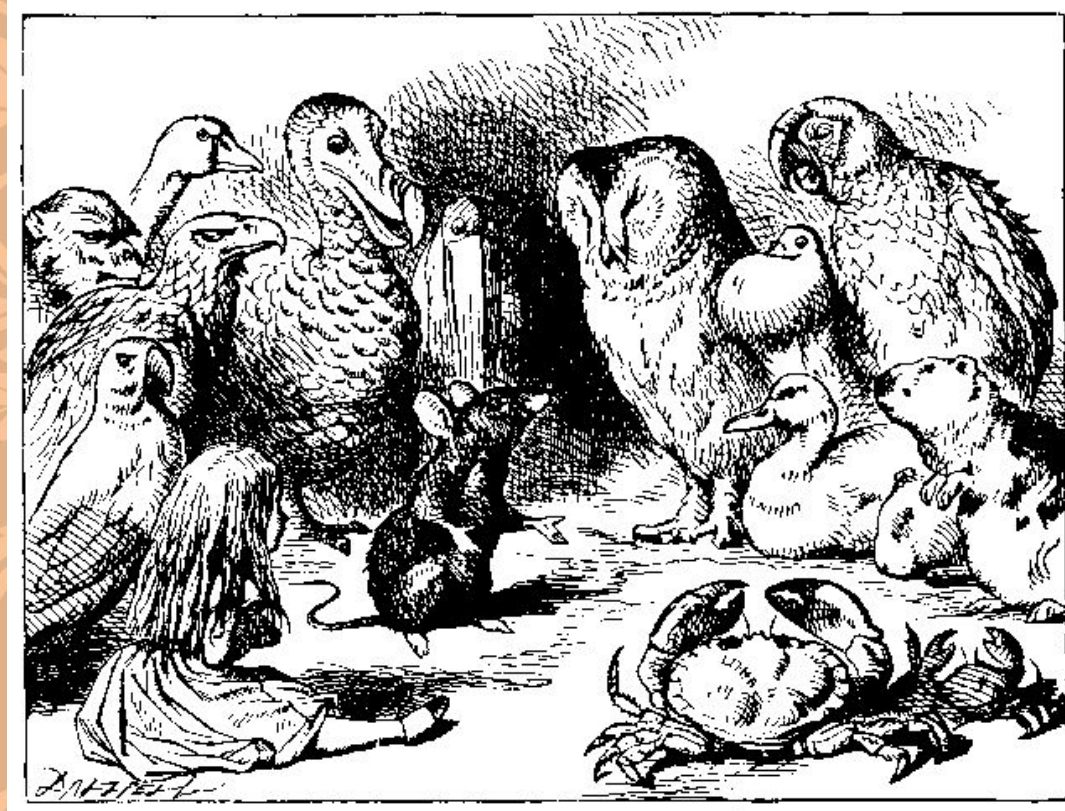
