# Have you been to the theatre this year?

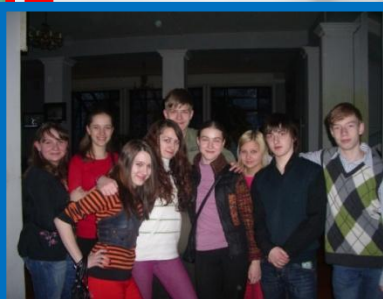
**No?...But our class have been to the theatre four times!**
