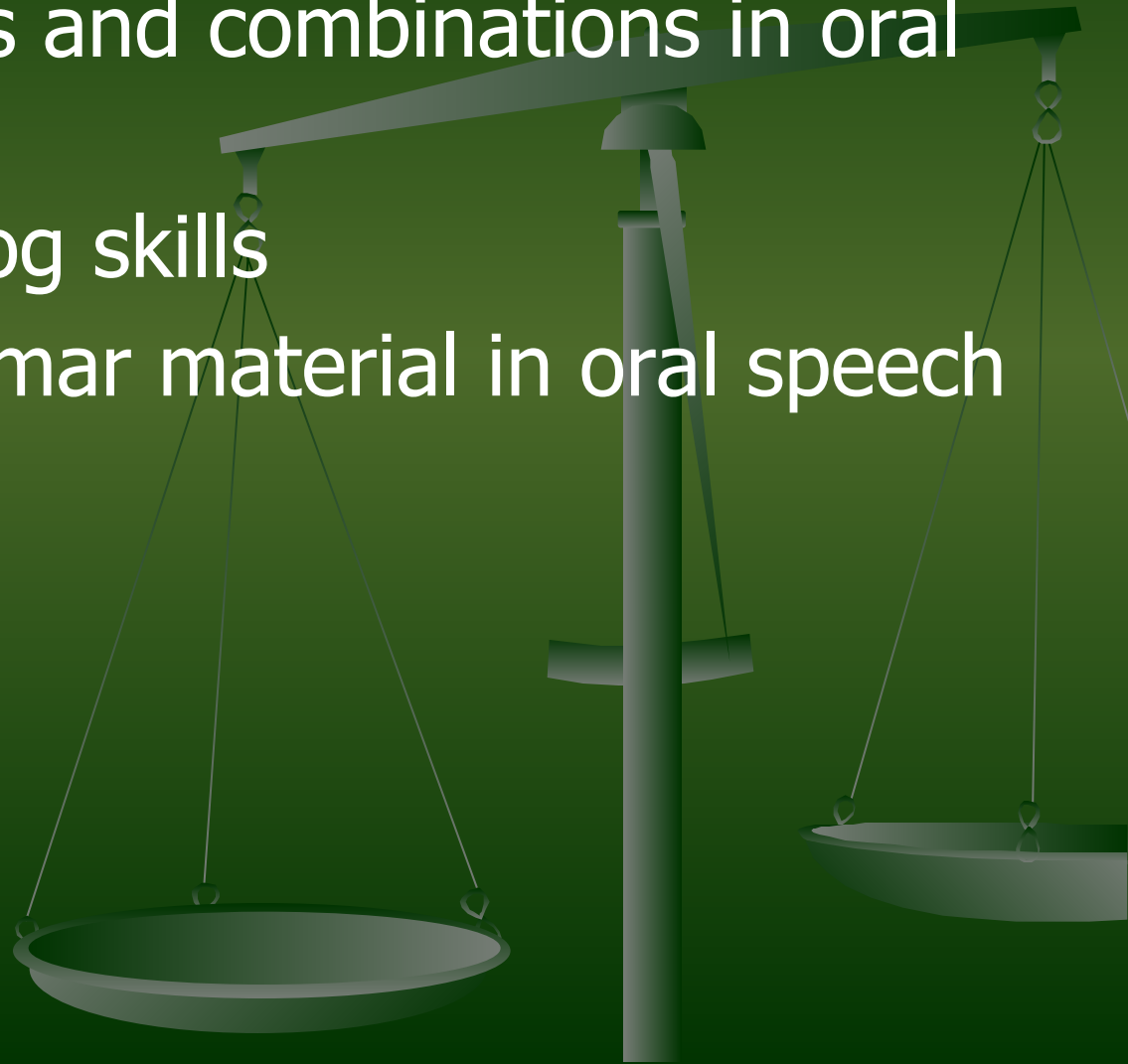

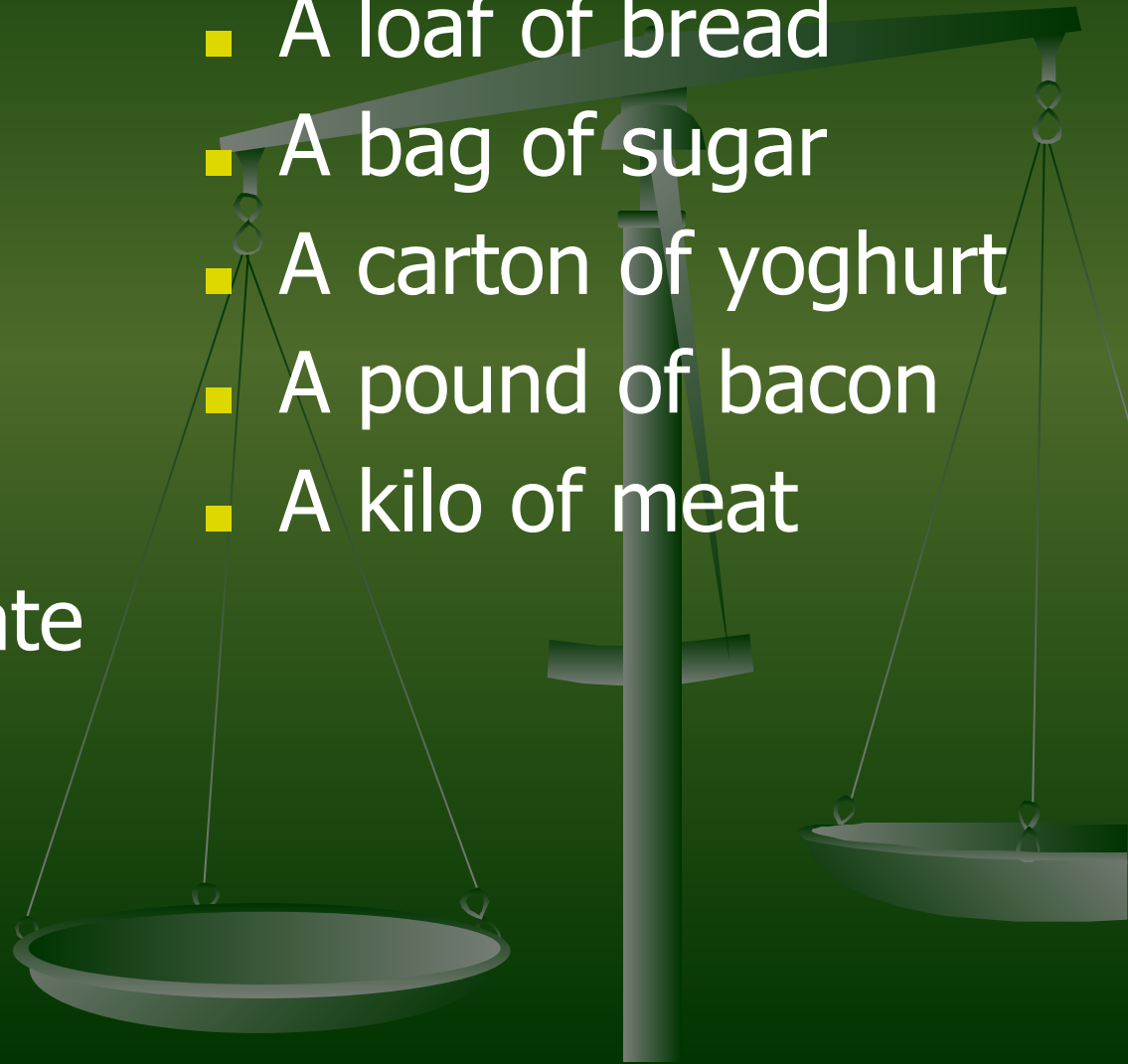
- To repeat words and combinations in oral speech

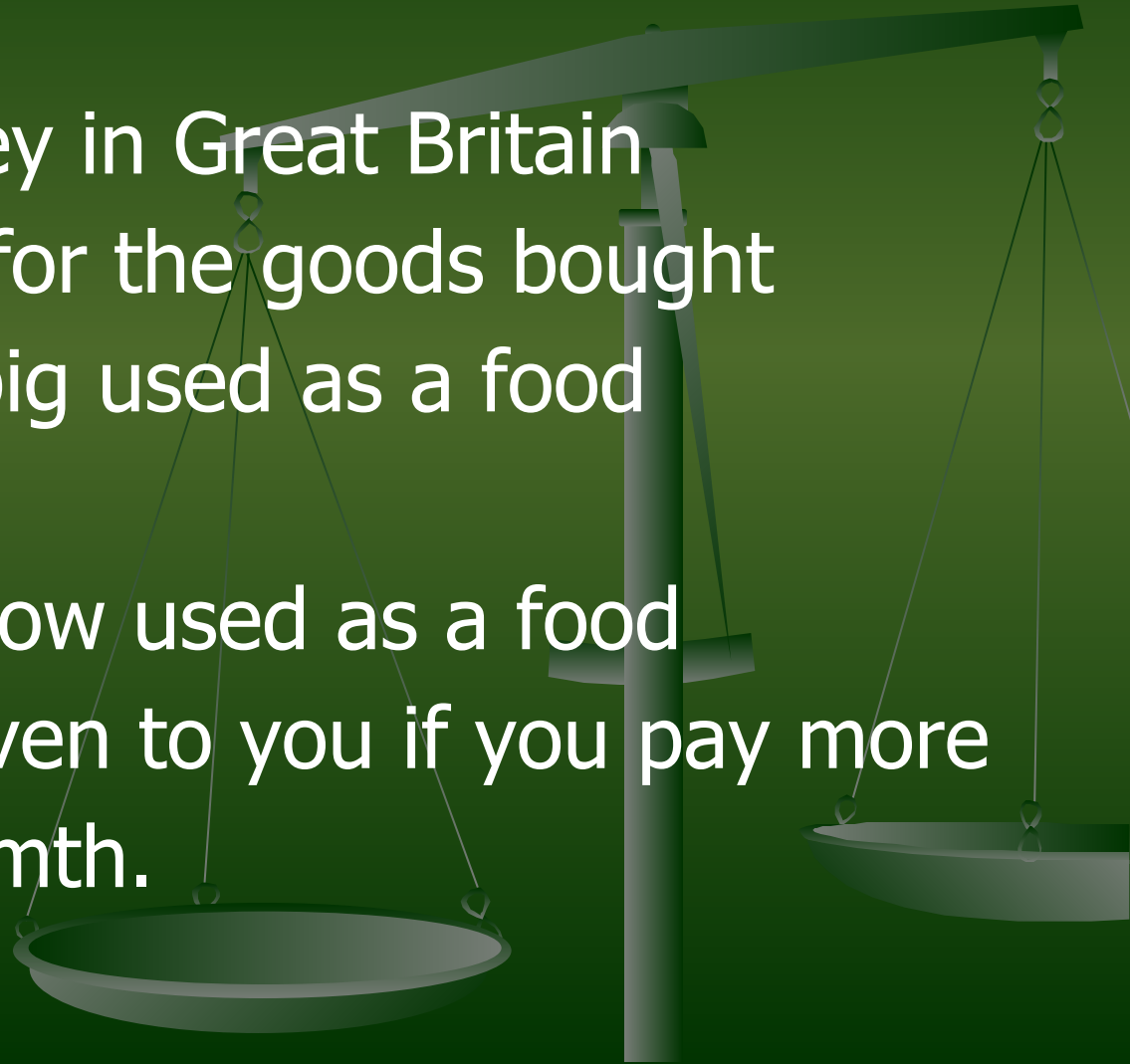
Words

- A kilo of meat

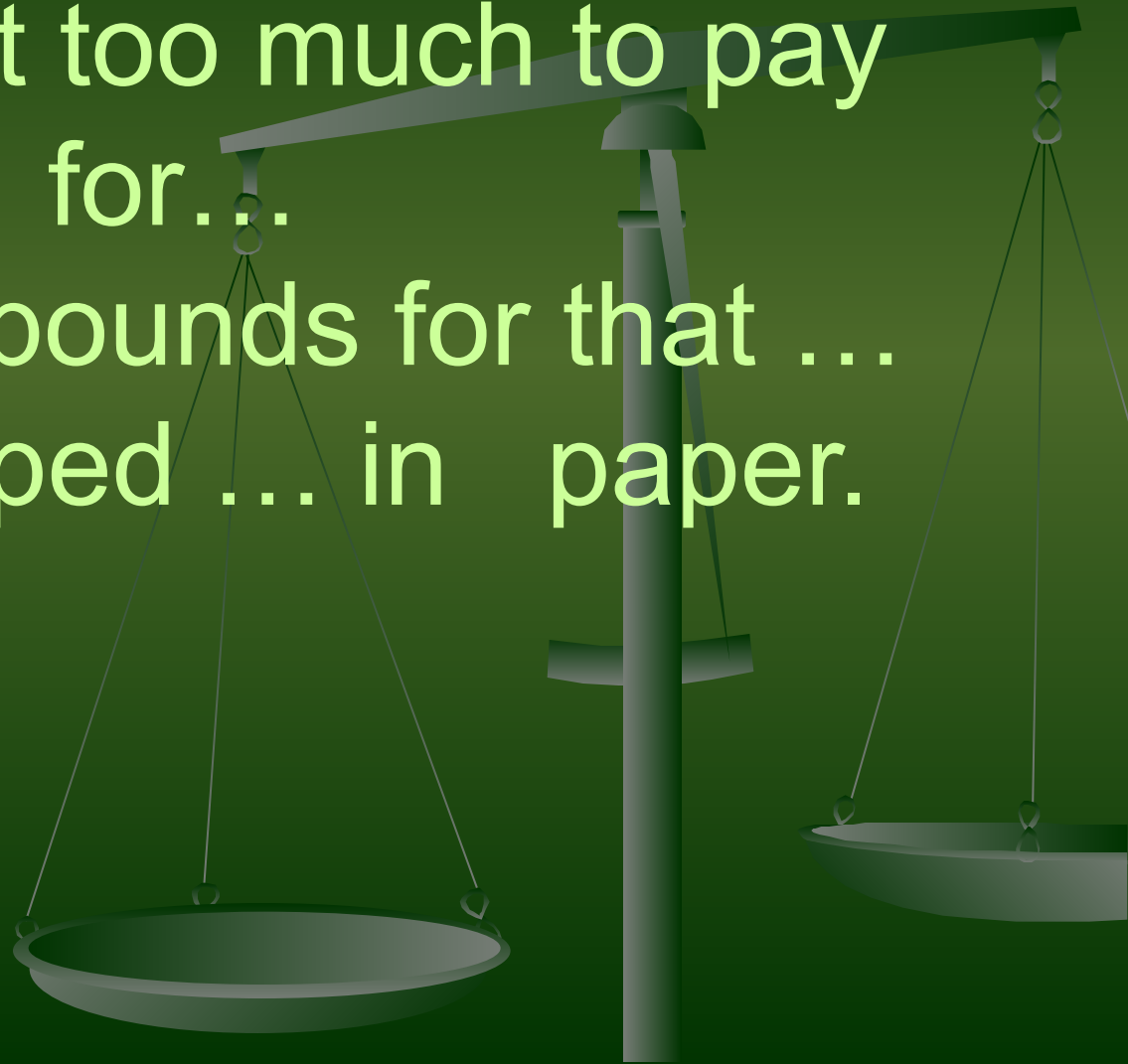


Words

- A little part of smth.

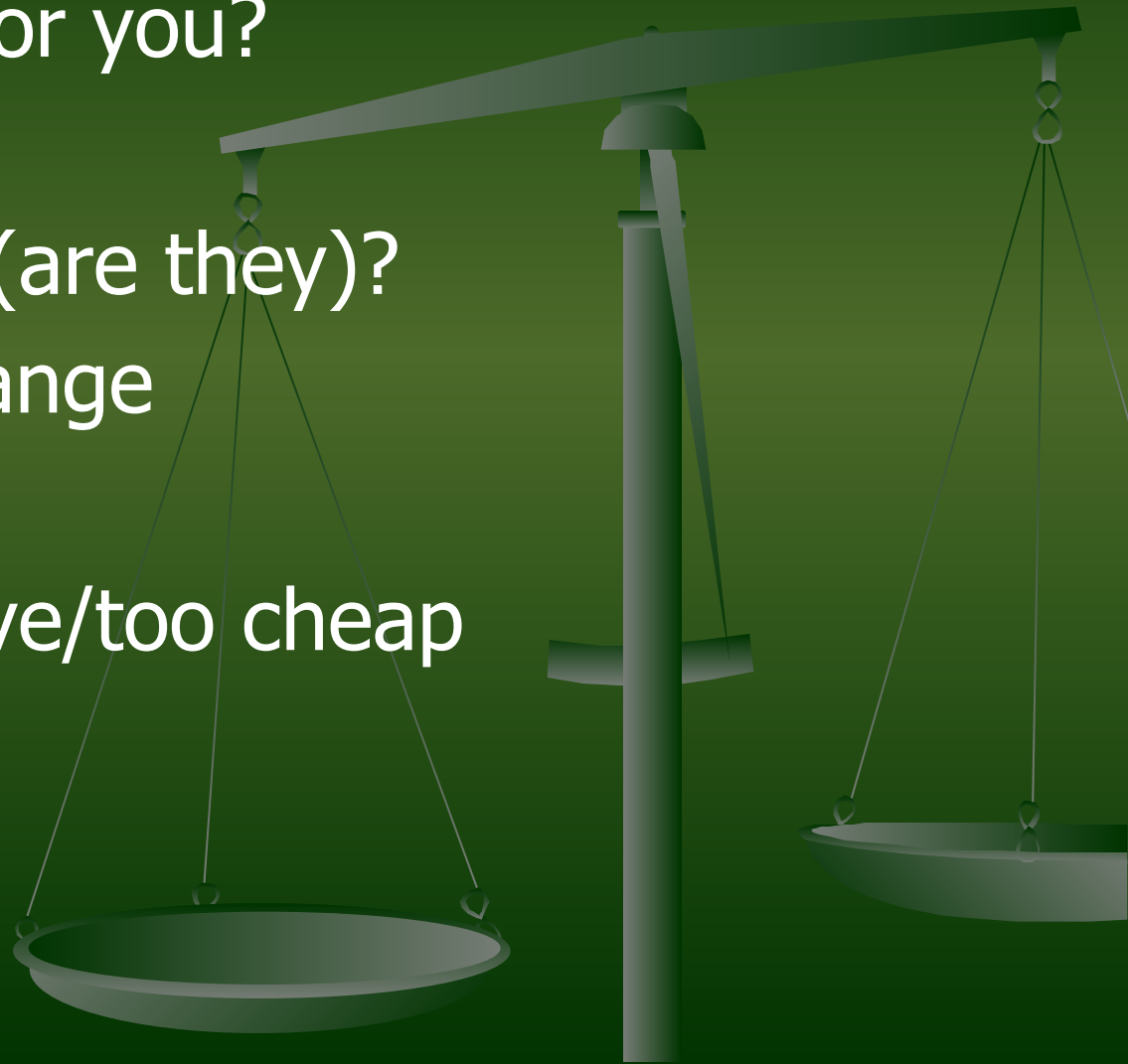


- That's a bit too much to pay for...
