Treat?».

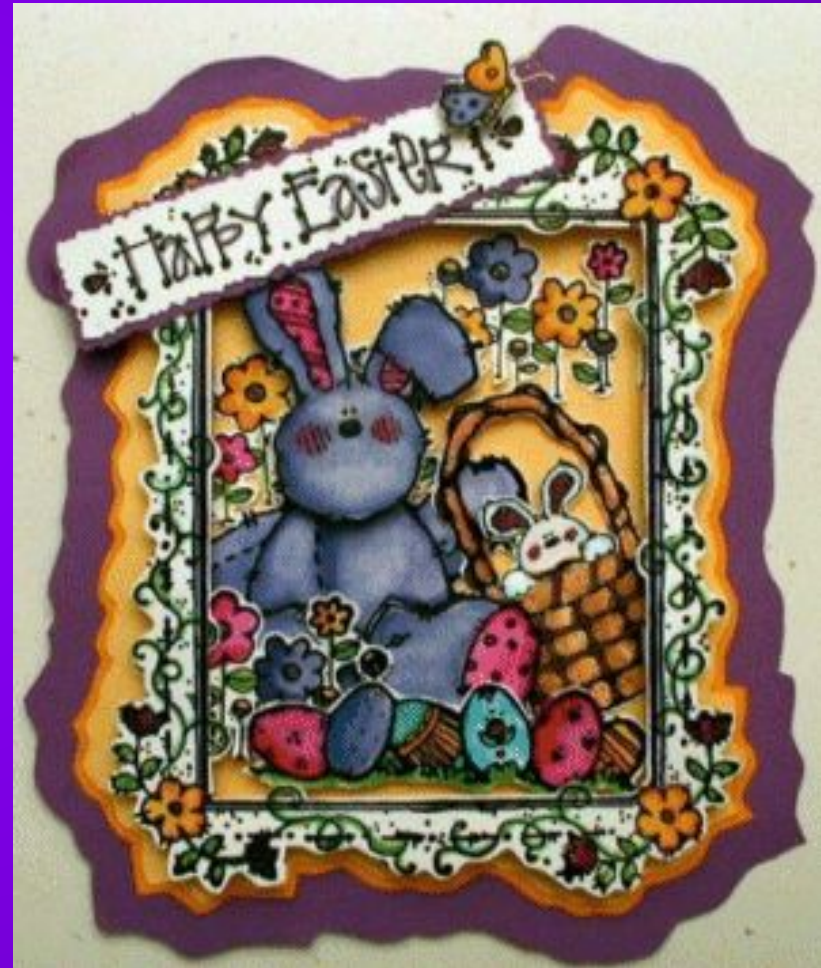
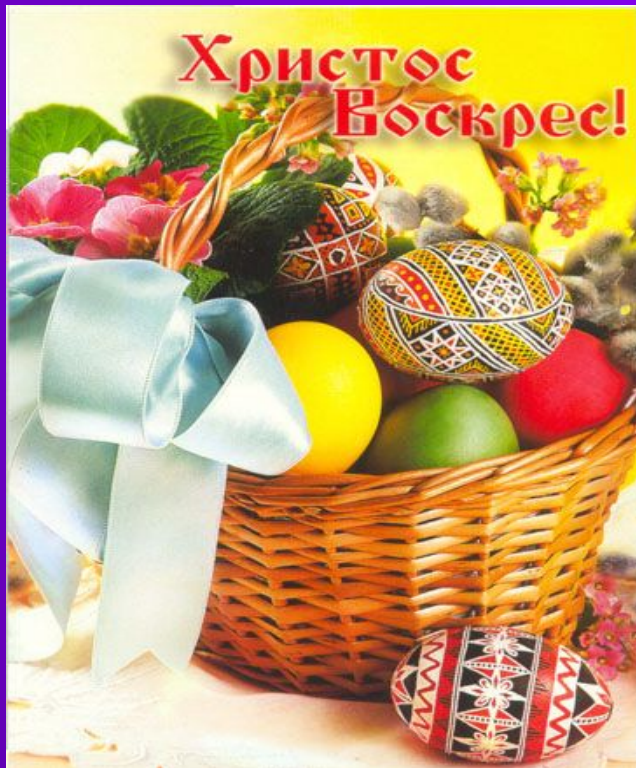

Father's Day

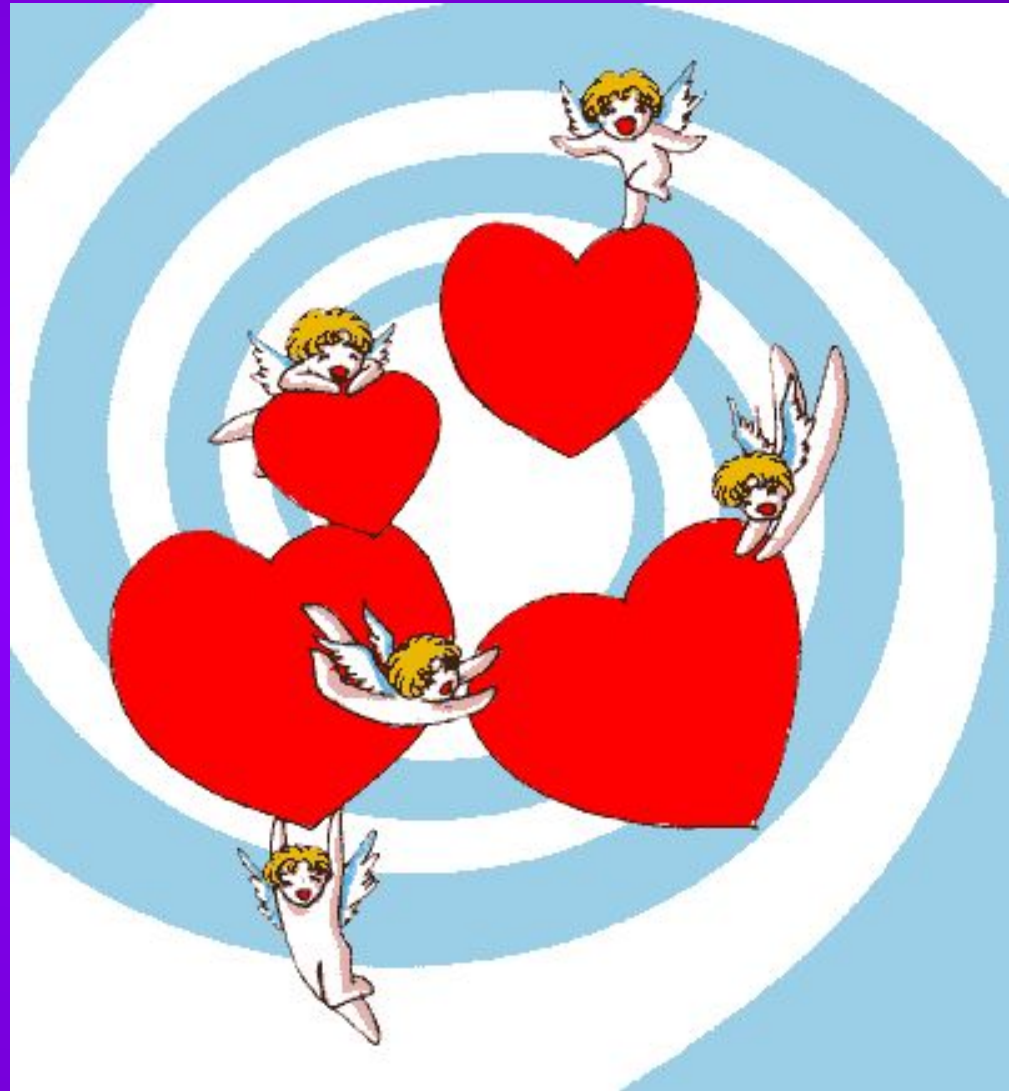
Father's Day is celebrated in June. On Father's Day children send their fathers and grandfathers and great – grandfathers cards or presents. Children say : Happy Father's Day.
