<u>Сопоставление русских и английских</u> <u>времен</u>

Настоящее время:

• <u>Я читаю газеты каждый</u> день.

(обычное действие)

- <u>Я читаю газету сейчас</u>. (длительное действие, совершается в момент речи)
- Я читаю газету уже час.

(длительное действие, совершается в момент речи, с указанием, как долго оно совершается) I <u>read</u> newspapers every day. (
 Present indefinite)

Often, usually, seldom, always, sometimes, every week (month, year)

I <u>am reading</u> a newspaper <u>now</u>.
 (Present Continuous)

Now, at this moment.

 I have been reading a newspaper for an hour.

(Present Perfect Continuous)

For, since. How long...?

<u>Сопоставление русских и</u> английских <u>времен</u> Прошедшее время:

- Я уже прочитал эту книгу. (прошедшее время результат которого налицо в настоящем времени или только что завершившееся действие)
- Я читал прочитал эту статью вчера. (действие, совершившееся в истекшем отрезке времени)
- Я прочитал эту статью, до того как он пришел. (действие, совершившееся до определенного момента в прошлом)
- Я читал газету, когда он пришел. (длительное действие, совершавшееся в определенный момент в прошлом)
- Я читал газету уже час когда он пришел (длительное действие, совершавшееся в определенный момент в прошлом, с указанием, как долго оно совершалось)

• I <u>have already read</u> the book. (Present Perfect)

Just, already, yet, ever, never, this week (year, month), today.

• I <u>read</u> the article <u>yesterday</u>. (Past Indefinite)

Last week (year, month), in 1996, a week (year, month, moment) ago, yesterday.

 I <u>had read</u> the article <u>before</u> he came. (Past Perfect)

By 6 o'clock yesterday, by the end of last week

I was reading the newspaper when he came. (Past Continuous)

At that moment, at 6 o'clock yesterday.

 I <u>had been reading</u> the newspaper for an hour when he came. (Past Perfect Continuous)

For, since. How long...?

<u>Сопоставление русских и английских времен</u> Будущее время:

- Я буду читать (прочитаю) эту статью завтра. (действие, которое совершиться в будущем)
- <u>Я буду читать эту статью, когда он придет</u>. (длительное действие, которое будет совершаться в определенный момент в будущем)
- Я уже прочитаю эту статью, когда он придет. (действие, которое совершиться до определенного момента в будущем)
- <u>К твоему приходу я буду читать</u> <u>статью уже 3 часа</u>.(будущее длительное действие с указанием, как долго оно будет длиться)

• I <u>shall read</u> the article tomorrow. (Future Indefinite)

In a week (year, month), next week (year, month), in 2011, in future.

I <u>shall be reading</u> the article when he comes (Future Continuous)

At 6 o'clock tomorrow, at this time tomorrow.

 I <u>shall already have read</u> the article when he comes. (Future Perfect)

By 6 o'clock tomorrow, by the end of the next week

 By your coming I <u>shall have been reading</u> the article for 3 hours (Future Perfect Continuous)

For, since. How long...?
