

Tag-questions

(разделительные вопросы)



Разделительные вопросы нужны для поддержания беседы, а не для получения информации. Говорящий использует их, чтобы пригласить собеседника согласиться с ним или исправить его. Такие предложения есть и в русском языке. У нас эти предложения обычно заканчиваются словами: «не правда ли?», «не так ли?», «разве нет?», «хорошо?», «же», «ведь».

*He **goes** to school, **doesn't** he?*
Он учится в школе, не правда ли?



*This girl **is not** your classmate, **is** she?*
Эта девочка – не твоя одноклассница, так ведь?



Как задавать вопросы с «хвостиком»?

Если предложение утвердительное, «хвостик» состоит из глагола, частицы **not** и местоимения.

*The Beatles **are** good musicians, **are not they?***

Битлз – хорошие музыканты, не правда ли?



Если предложение отрицательное, «хвостик» состоит из глагола и местоимения.



*The robot **didn't** talk, **did he?***

Робот не разговаривал, ведь так?



Как задавать вопросы с «хвостиком»?

Если предложение утвердительное, «хвостик» отрицательный и наоборот.



She is ten, isn't she?
Ей 10 лет, не правда ли?

She is not eleven, is she?
Ей не 11 лет, не правда ли?



Как задавать вопросы с «хвостиком»?

В «хвостик» выносятся глаголы
is, are, was, were, will, would, can, could, must,
have, has, had,
если они есть в предложении.



*Linda **can** roller-skate, **can't** she?*

Линда умеет кататься на роликах, не так ли?

*Mary **has** got a globe, **hasn't** she?*

У Мэри есть глобус, не правда ли?



Как задавать вопросы с «хвостиком»?

В «хвостик» выносятся глаголы
do, does (настоящее время),
did (прошедшее время),
если вышеуказанных глаголов в
утвердительном предложении нет.



*The students go to school by bus, **don't** they?*
Ученики ездят в школу на автобусе, не так ли?

*Pete didn't listen to the teacher, **did** he?*
Петя не слушал учителя, не правда ли?
