



The All-Union Agricultural Exhibition

I want to talk about the All-Union Agricultural Exhibition. It is located in the Russian capital, Moscow.

First this huge exhibition complex (its current name - VVD) was established in 1939 as All-Union Agricultural Exhibition, abbreviated - VSHV. More than 200 hectares of land near the village near Moscow Alekseevskogo were drained, ennobled, planted with trees and lined with exhibition halls. Until 1941, here exhibited their achievements and shared experiences collective and state farms from all over the USSR.





In the center of the complex was erected a huge fountain "Friendship of Peoples", whose details and sculptures were covered with natural gold.

In the 1990s, most of the pavilions were rented to various kinds of traders. They turned violent trade. Under pressure from its thematic pavilions became empty: from "Horse Breeding" disappeared in an unknown direction horses of "Porcine" - pigs
