My pleasure. It was nothing.

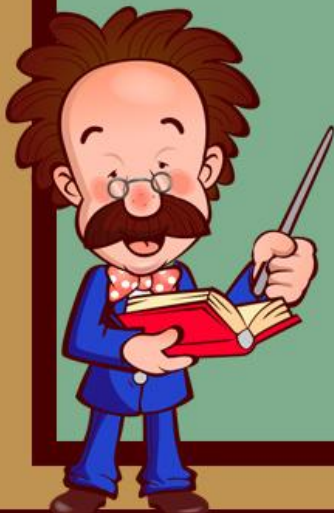

Use a comma.

signature.
