The Magic Barber

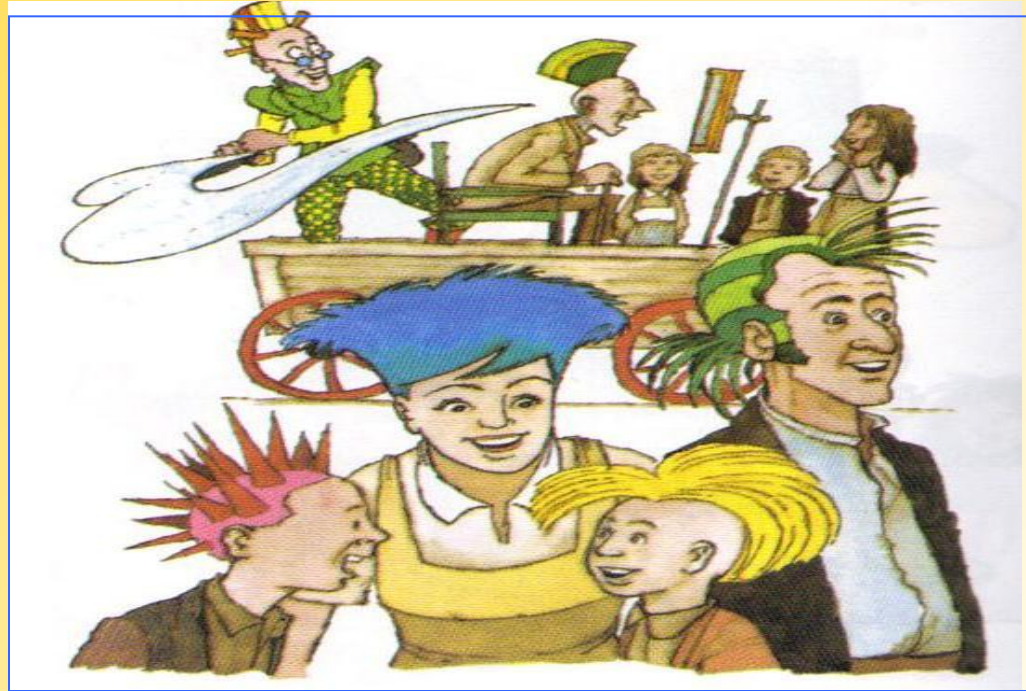

Dangerous Journey

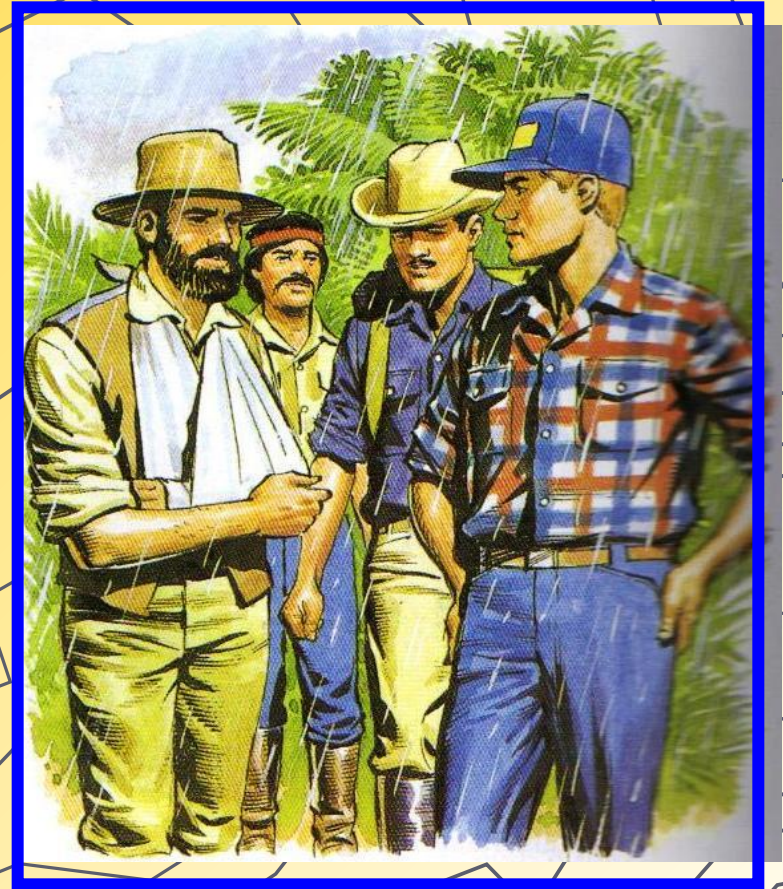

It's important to have friends

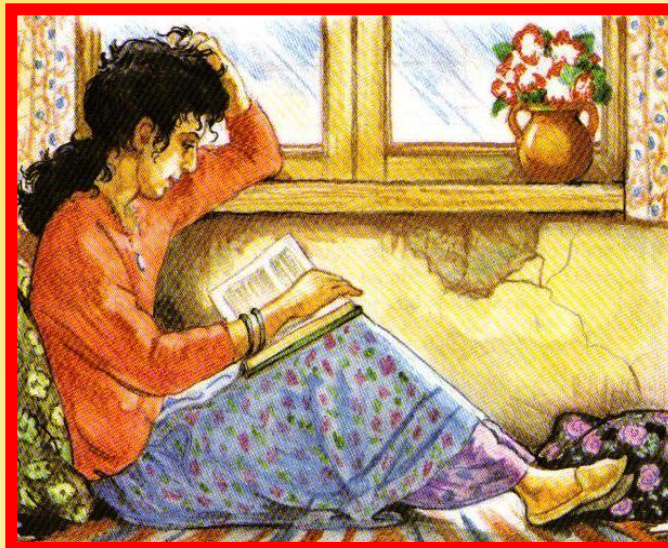
