

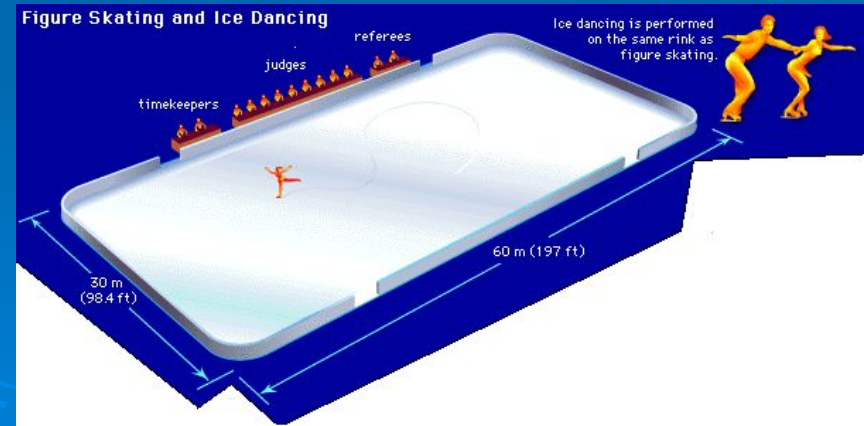
Jackson Haines



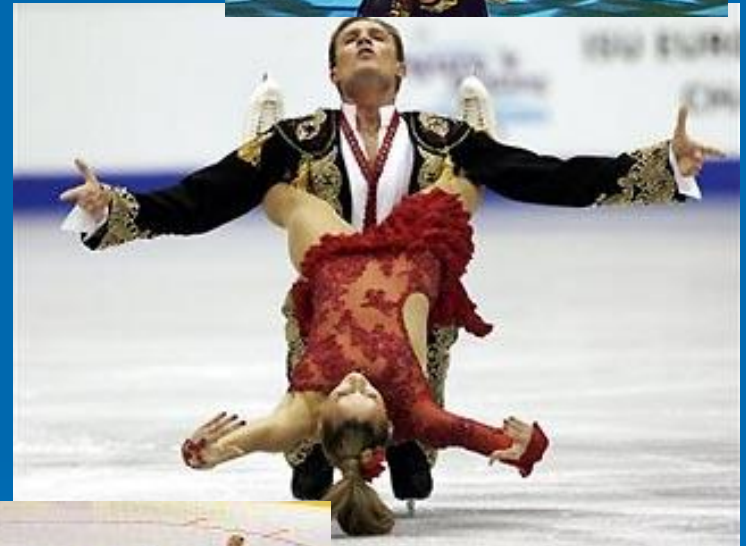
Modern figure skating was developed by Jackson Haines, an American skater. He introduced an "international style."

The first Olympic champion in a *special figures* event was a Russian man Nikolay Panin.

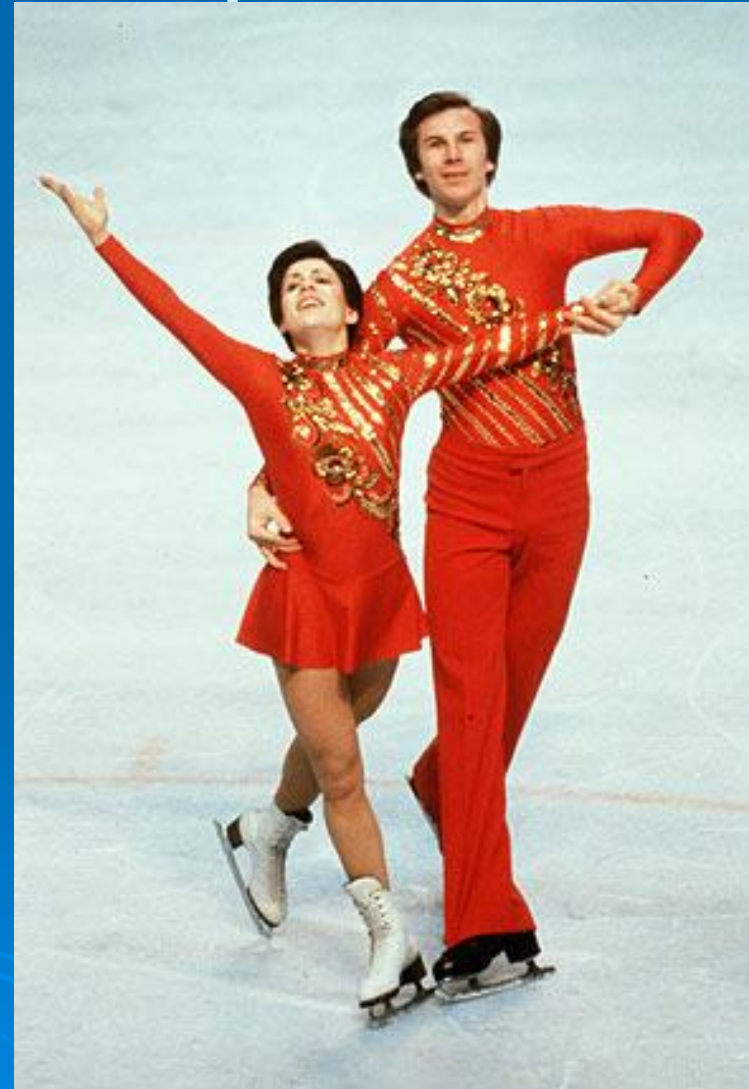

Sonja Henie



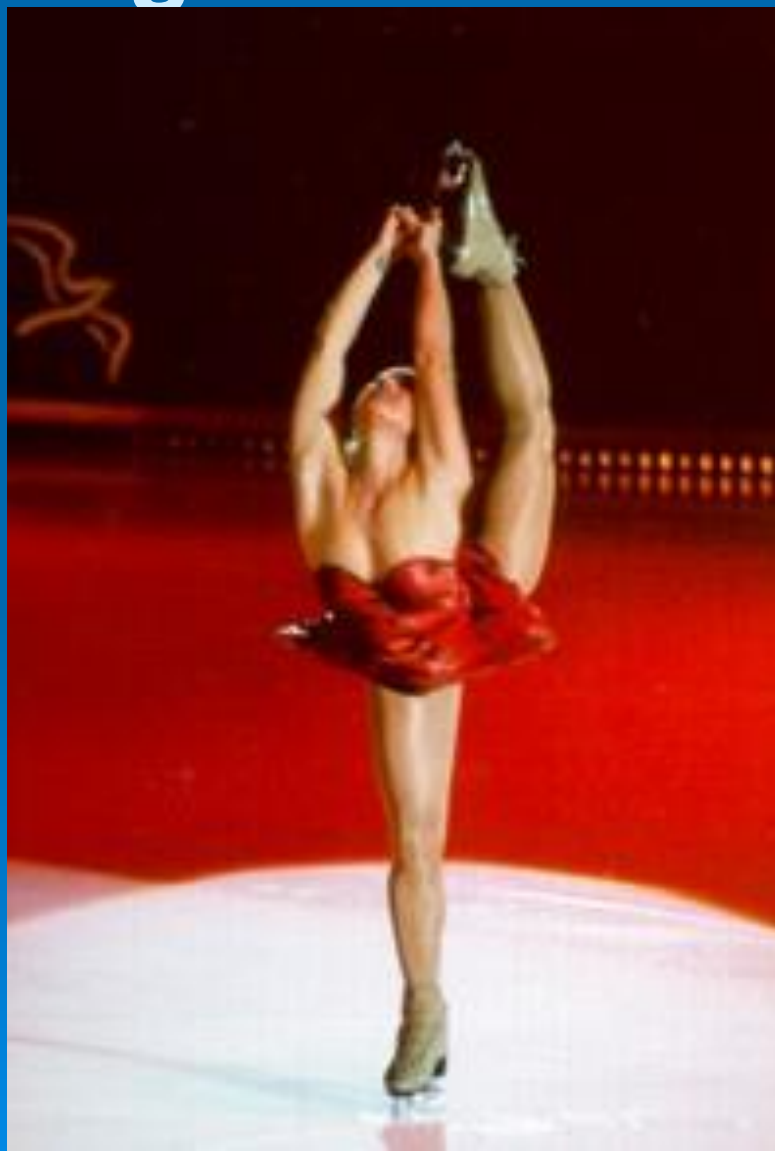
- Sonja Henie was the first figure skater, who wore the short skirt costume in figure skating, and used dance choreography.

Jane Torvill and Christopher Dean

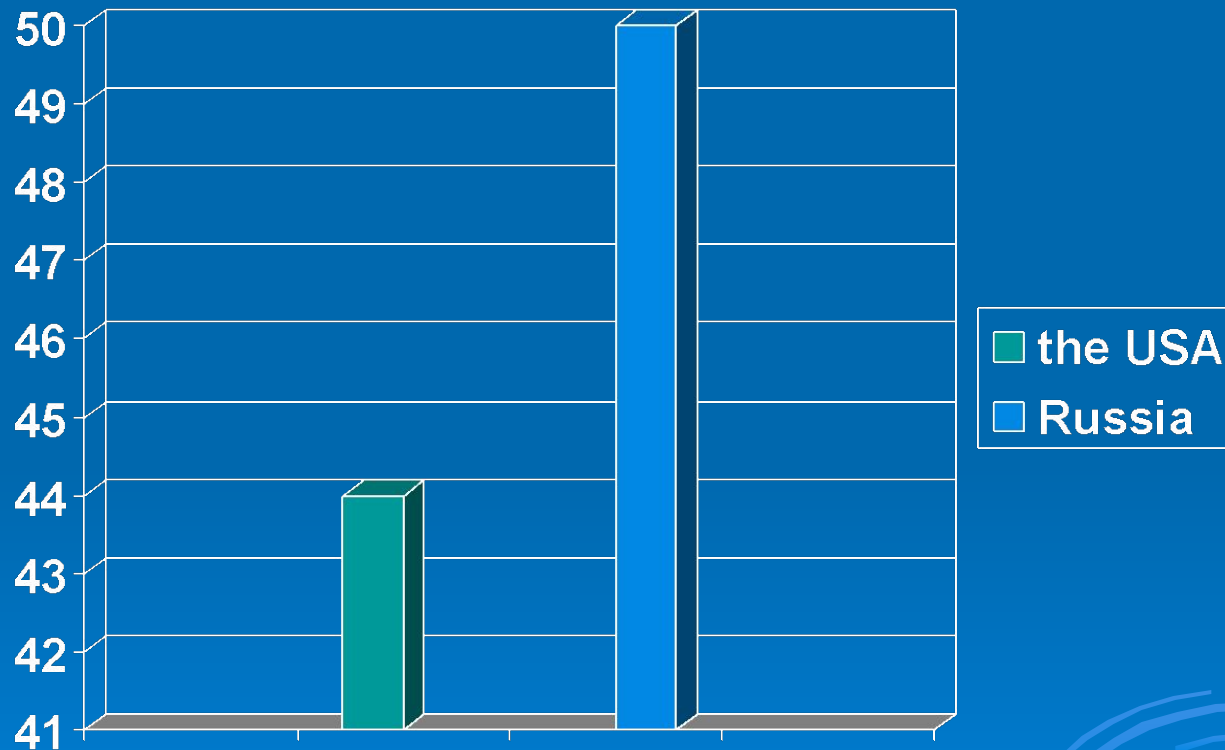


- Jane Torvill and Christopher Dean had perfect technique and synchronization.
- They introduced inventive lifts and other unique moves.

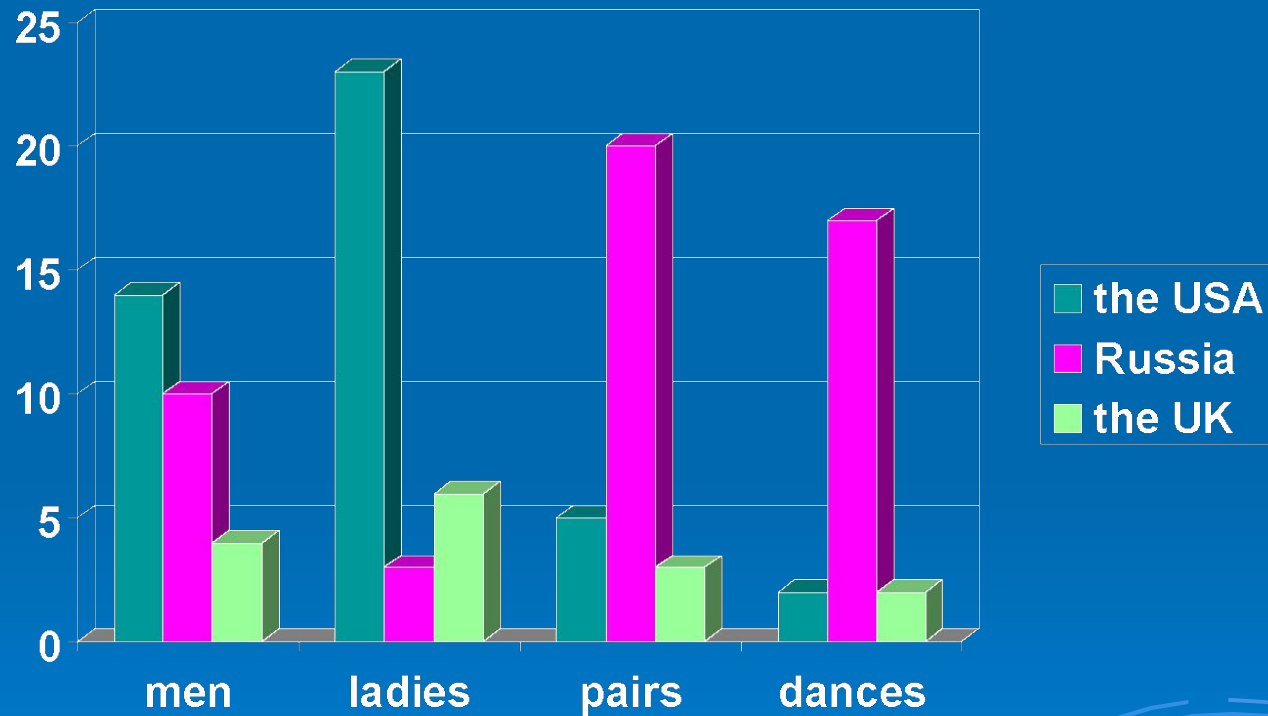
Elements Named after Famous Figure Skaters



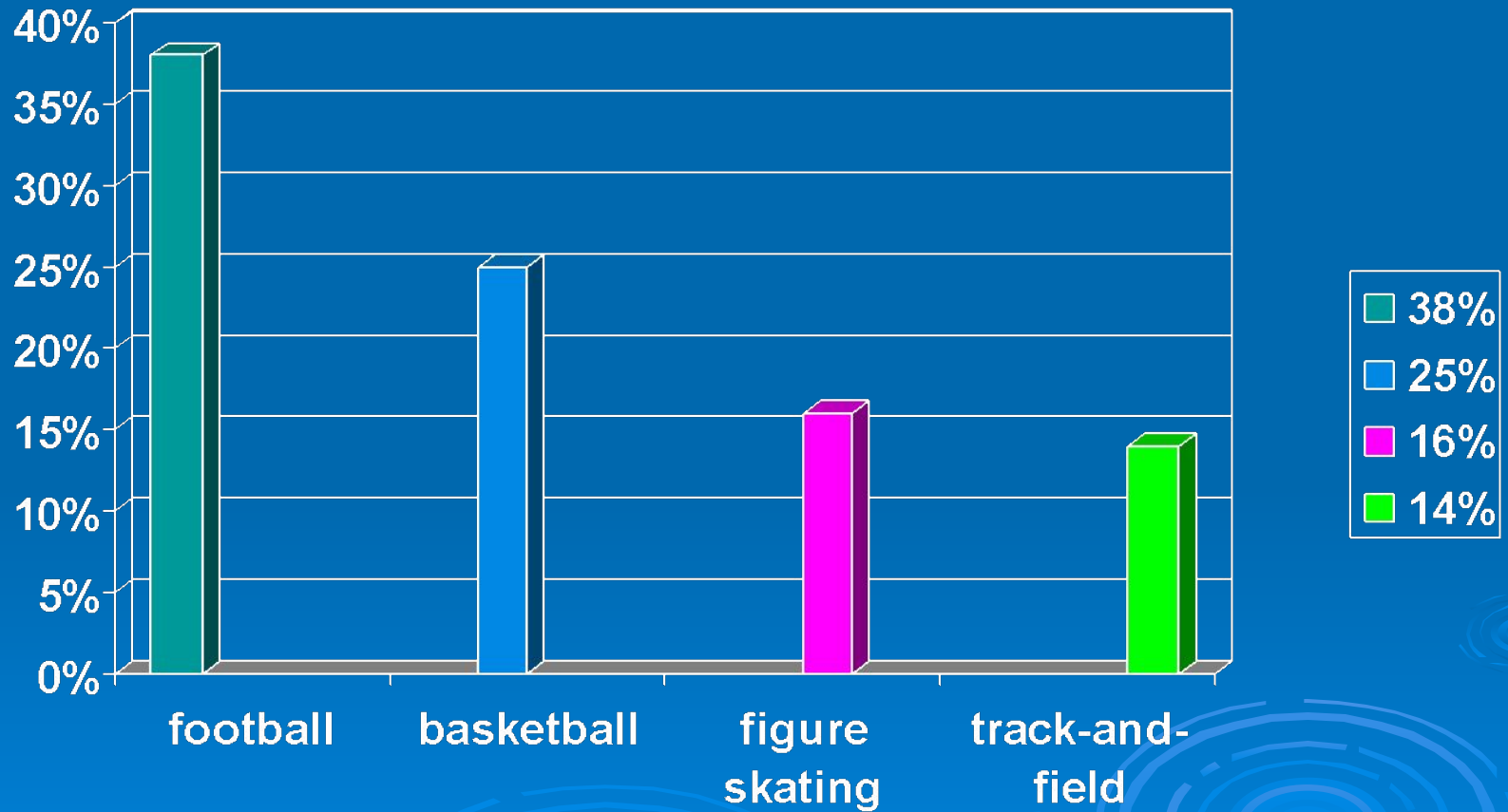
The Number of Winners at All Winter Olympiads



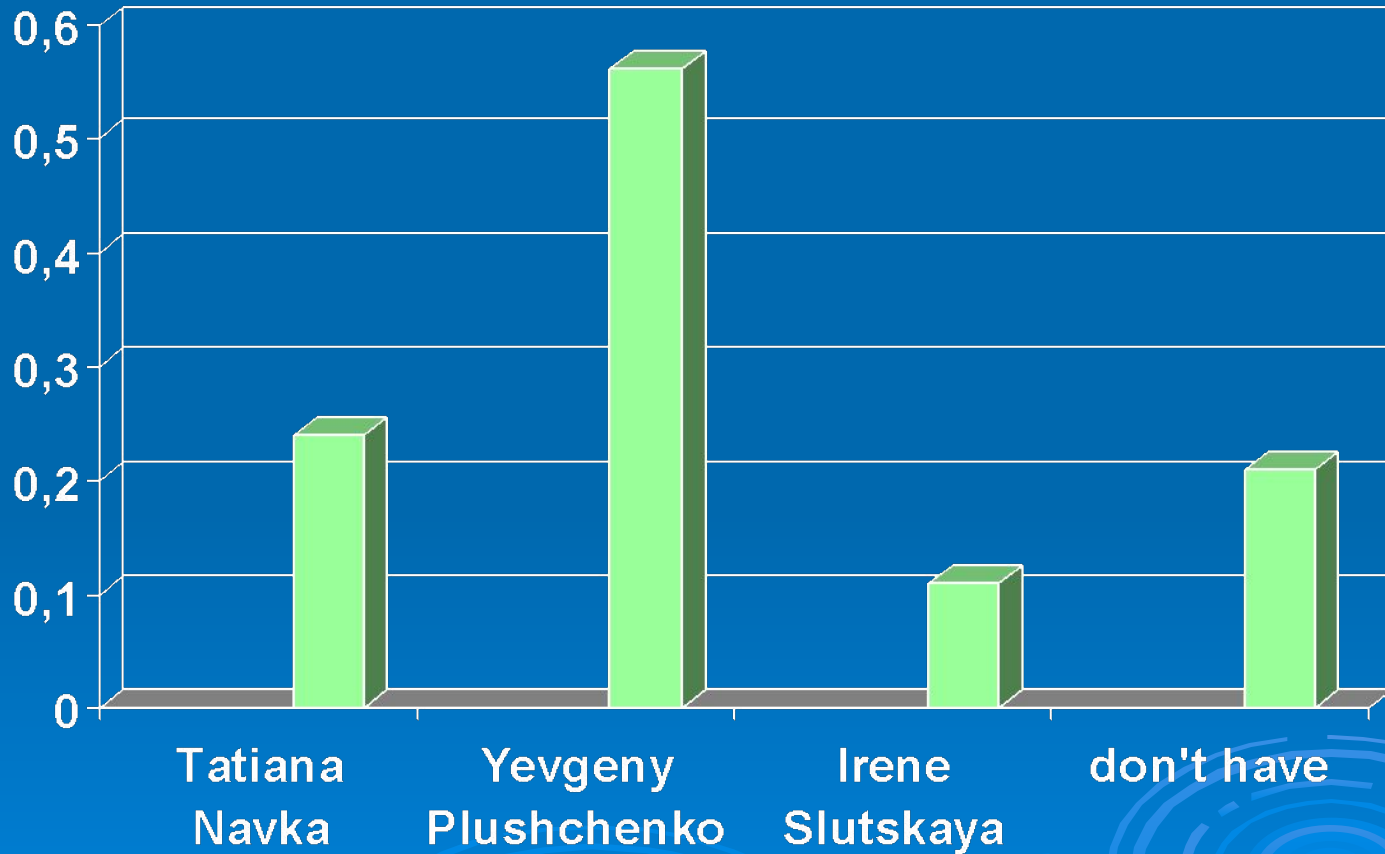
