The largest city is Omaha.

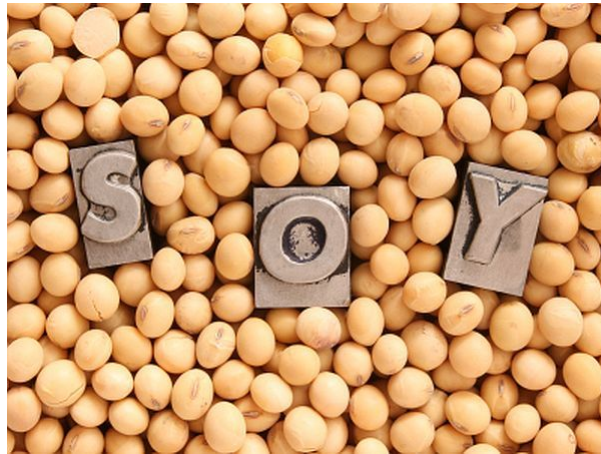
There are two major climatic zones in Nebraska: the eastern half of the state has a humid continental climate, and the western half, a semi-arid climate.

Economy

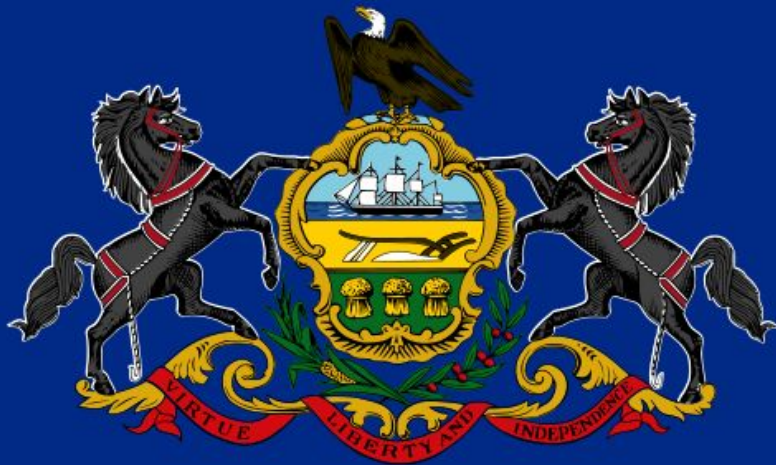
