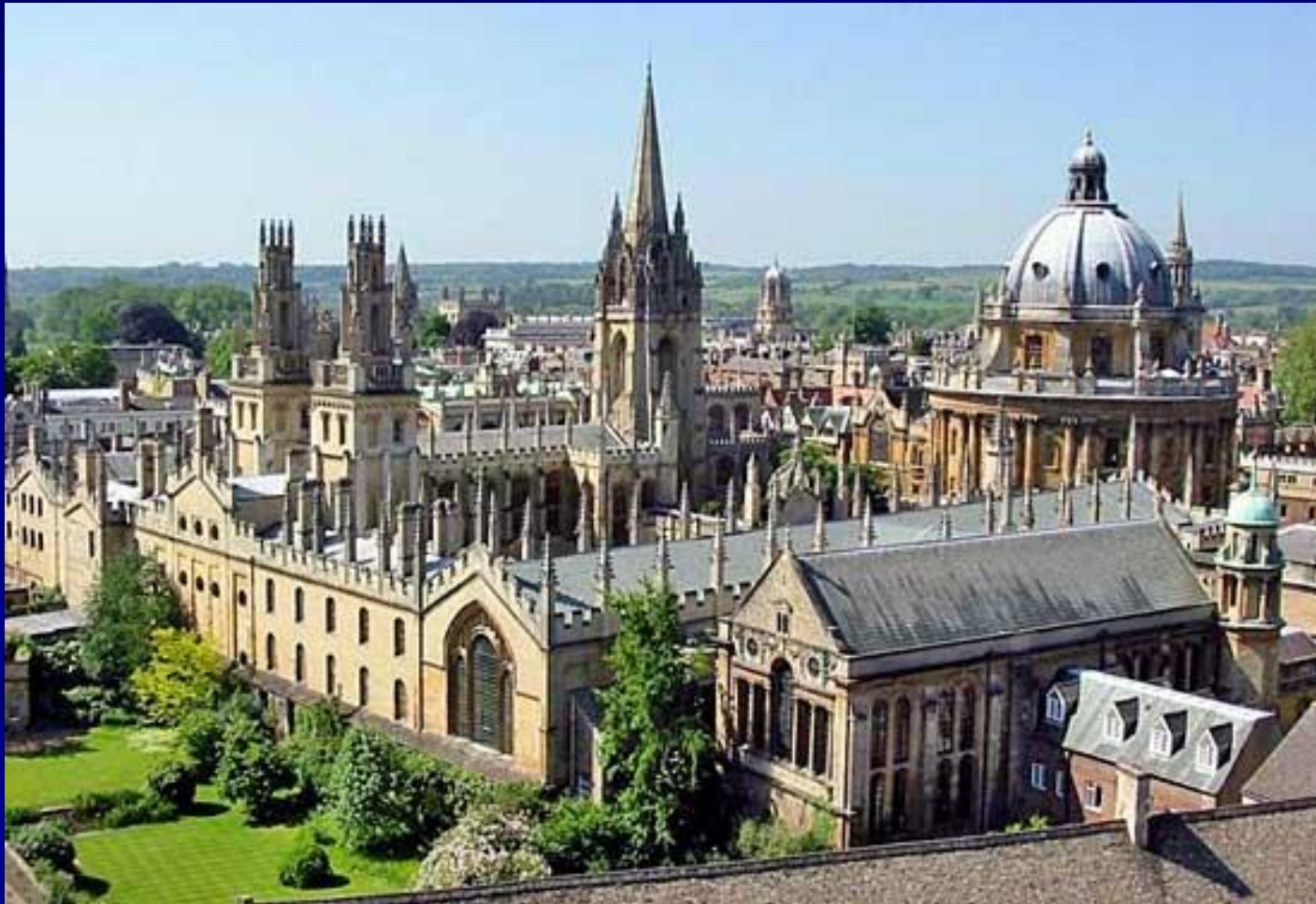


# The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

- It occupies the British Isles, which lie off the north-west coast of Europe.



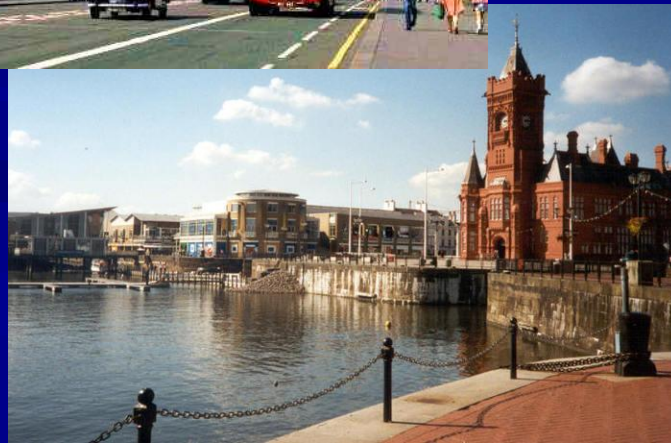
- The total area of the country is 244 thousand sq km.
